Preparation

Connect as shown.



■ Do not use any handset other than Panasonic handset made for the model KX-T2322A/KX-T2342A.

Replace all the batteries once a year, or misoperation may occur.

Do not use Nickel-Cadmium or Alkaline batteries.

If the batteries are not installed, programming, and speakerphone or monitor operation can not be done.

1 Dialing Mode Selector: Set to "TONE".

DIALING MODE



If dialing can not be done, set to "PULSE".

2 Ringer Volume Selector: Set to "HIGH".



LOW: The ringing sound will be low. **OFF:** The telephone will not ring.

3 Recall Selector: Set to "E RE" or "T BR".

■ Redialing



• The unit will redial the last dialed phone number once.

Automatic Dialing

- There are 20 memory stations, each station is capable of storing 16 digits.
- There are 6 Direct Call buttons, each capable of storing 16 digits. Each Dialing button serves as a memory station.








 Phone numbers can be stored into memory stations 0 1 to 2 0 following the same procedure.



Storing and Dialing

Correcting an Error while Storing

1 if you notice an error.

2 Repeat all the steps of "Storing Phone Numbers" on the page 5 to reprogram.

Cofirming a Stored Number

- 1 Repeat storing the same number into the same station.
- When the Auto button is pushed, the Memory indicator will flash and a beep will be heard.
 - twice:

The entry is the same as what was previously stored.

• once:

The entry is different from the one that was previously stored. Repeat the procedure of storing.

Erasing a Stored Number

Example:

To erase the number in memory station 0 2:

Be sure the handset is on the cradle and the SP-PHONE or Monitor button is off.



Storing the Last Dialed Number (Redial Memory Transfer)

The last number manual dialed can be stored into the memory station or the Direct Call button.

Example: To store into memory station 0 1.

Be sure the handset is on the cradle and the SP-PHONE or Monitor button is off.



NOTE:

Up to 30 digits will be dialed when using the redial function.

When storing the last dialed number into memory, the maximum amount of digits can not exceed 16 digits.

Storing and Dialing (cont.)

Saved Number Redial

The last dialed number can be stored into the Save button before hanging up (e.g. ... when the line is busy).

This number will be saved until another number is stored again, and can be redialed any time by pushing the Save button.

 This function is useful to store the phone number which you wish to redial after dialing another number.

Storing during a Conversation (Memo Dial)

While having a conversation, another telephone number can be stored into the Memo button.


So you can dial this number by pushing the Memo button any time you like.

Mute Operation

Use when you do not want your voice to be heard by the other party.

- 1 Push MUTE
 - The Mute Indicator will light.
- 2 To resume the conversation, push the again.

Combination Dialing

Any combination of dialing methods can be done.

- Automatic and Manual Dialing
- Pulse and Tone Dialing
- Plural Memory Stations

Tone Button Usage

If you want to change from pulse mode into tone mode during dialing, the Tone () button can be used instead of changing the Dialing Mode selector.

When you hang up, the dialing mode will be automatically returned to pulse mode.

Pause usage

The Pause button function is needed for an outside line access number or a computer accessed line.

- Especially in manual dialing, a pause is required for the redialing.
- To wait for a dial tone (PBX)

One pause is required. (3.5-second pause)

■ To wait for a computer tone

Two pauses are required. (7-second pause)

Recall Button

To access an outside line using the PBX recall facility, press the Recall Button. Depending on type of switching equipment to which Easa-Phone is connected, various functions, such as transfer, recall and hold can be initiated.

Helpful Hints for Hands-free

If the other party finds it difficult to hear your voice:

Lower the sound level using the Volume Control or speak louder.

Absorbing echo

Use in a room that has curtains or carpeting.

■ Effective Talking

If some part of conversation is lost while talking, speak alternately.

Monitor Operation (KX-T2322A only)

During Monitor operation, the Incoming voice can be monitored, but the Outgoing voice will not be heard by the other party.

For Monitor Operation

Dial the phone number with the handset on-hook.

- The handset can be put in the cradle.
- The other party's voice will be heard through the monitor speaker.
- Your voice will not be heard by the other party.

To Cancel Monitor Operation

- You can talk to the other party through the handset.
- The Monitor Indicator will go out.
- When the handset is off-hook:





- 2-way conversations through the handset will be resumed.
- The Monitor Indicator will go out.

Others

- If there is any trouble, disconnect the unit from the telephone line and connect a known working telephone. If the known working telephone operates properly return your unit to your supplier for repair, if the known working telephone does not operate properly, consult with a telephone company.
- Keep the unit away from heating appliances and electrical noise generating devices such as fluorescent lamps and motors.
- The unit should be kept free of dust,
 moisture and vibration, and should not be exposed to direct sunlight.
- Do not use benzine, thinner, or the like, or any abrasive powder to clean the cabinet. Wipe it with a soft cloth.





Wall Mounting


This unit can be mounted on the wall utilizing the template and screws provided.

1. Turn over the handset guide.









- 4. Place the template on the wall.

- Mount the unit on the wall so that the screw heads insert into the slots on the bottom, and then slide the unit down to hook it securely, as shown.

Troubleshooting Guide



Problem

The unit does not ring.

Cause & Remedy

Ringer Volume Selector is set to "OFF". Set to "HIGH" or "LOW".

The caller suddenly can not hear my voice during a conversation.

I suddenly can not hear caller's voice during a conversation.

Look at the Memory Indicator. If it is blinking slowly, push the Hold button to resume the conversation.

When the Mute Indicator lights, push the Mute button.

Redialing or Programming Operation does not function.


Hands-free operation does not function after pushing the SP-Phone button. (KX-T2342A only)


Monitor operation does not function after pushing the Monitor button. (KX-T2322A only)

Batteries have become weak. Replace all the batteries.

Battery Installation

Three AAA size batteries (UM-4, R03) serve as the power source to retain the stored telephone numbers in memory, and to activate a speakerphone or monitor operation.





- To prevent loss of the stored telephone numbers, replace the batteries within 10 minutes after removing the old ones.
- Disconnect the telephone cord before opening the battery compartment cover.
- Replace all the batteries once a year, or misoperation may occur.
- Do not use Nickel-Cadmium or Alkaline batteries.

■ Battery Precautions

The batteries should be used correctly, otherwise, the unit may be damaged due to battery leakage.

 Do not mix different types of batteries.
