1 Introducing the Camera

Read this section to learn about the features and functions of this digital video camcorder. This chapter also covers system requirements, package contents, and the camera views.

1.1 System requirements

This camera requires a host PC with the following specifications:

- Windows® XP, 2000, ME, 98SE operating system
- Intel® Pentium III 1 GHz CPU or higher
- At least 256 MB of RAM or higher
- Standard USB 1.1 port or higher
- 4x speed CD-ROM drive or higher
- At least 200 MB of available disk space

A USB 1.1 port will enable you to transfer files to and from the host PC, but transfer speeds will be much faster with a USB 2.0 port.





Note: To avoid damaging the LCD monitor, do not rotate the LCD monitor in the wrong direction!


2 Getting Started

2.1 Charging


2.1.1 Replacing battery

This camera is designed to use a rechargeable Lithium Ion battery.




2.1.2 Charging

Use the USB cable in the package to connect the digital video camcorder to your PC and the battery charging process will start.



You can also use the AC adapter to charge your camera. Plug the AC adapter into the wall outlet and connect the other end to your camera to charge.




2.2 SD card

An SD card can be inserted into this digital video camcorder to provide additional storage space.

To install an SD Card:


- 1. Open the battery door.
- 2. Insert an SD card as shown. Make sure the gold contacts are facing down as shown.
- 3. Close the battery door.



2.3 Turning on/off the Camera

There are two ways to turn on/off the camera:

- 1. Open or close the LCD monitor.
- 2. Press and hold the Power button.



3 Using the digital video camcorder

Read this section to learn how to use the basic setup menu of this digital video camcorder.

3.1 Using the LCD display

Use the LCD display to compose and review your pictures and videos stored in memory, and navigate the OSD (On Screen Display) menu.

Icons displayed on the LCD display also show the current configuration.

3.3 Setup menu

The setup menu includes a number of settings to configure your camera.

To access the **Setup** menu:

- 1. Turn the camera on.
- Press the **Menu** button and press the joystick down to enter **Setup** menu.



To exit the Setup menu while configuring the camera, press the **Menu** button again to exit the **Setup** menu.

3.3.1 Sound effect

Use this option to turn on or off the sound effect of the unit.

Press the joystick up or down to highlight the Sound

effect option.

2. Press the joystick left or right to select between **On** or **Off**.

3. Press (in) the center of the joystick to confirm, and press the **Menu** button to exit the menu.



3.3.2 USB mode

Use this option when the camera is connected as a USB device. Press the joystick up or down to highlight the **USB mode** option.

3.3.2.1 Mass storage

Press the joystick left or right to select the **Mass storage**.

Connect the camera to the PC with the USB cable. Now the camera will be presented as a removable disk.



While in **Mass storage** mode, you can copy files from your PC to the camera, including music files that can be played in music mode.

For music mode operation, please refer to "8.4 Music" for detailed information.

3.3.2.2 PC Camera

Note: Before connecting the camera as a PC-Camera, please install the driver on the CD-ROM first. Please refer to "9 Installing the Applications" for detailed information.

Press the joystick left or right to select the PC camera.

Connect the camera to the PC with the USB cable, and then the camera can be used as a PC camera, use in Netmeeting or any on-line communication tool.

3.3.4 Welcome picture

Use this option to set a welcome screen when turning the camera on.

1. Press the joystick up or down to highlight the **Welcome** picture option.

- Select Flash to use the factory default flash as the welcome screen.
- Select **Picture** to use the factory default picture as the welcome screen
- Select Customized photo to use a photo as the welcome picture.
- 3. Press in the joystick to confirm, and press the **Menu** button to exit the menu.

3.3.5 Auto power off

Use this option to set a period of inactivity after which the camera will switch itself off. This function can save the battery consumption.

1. Press the joystick up or down to highlight the **Auto power**



- Press the joystick left or right to select from Never, 1 minute or 3 minutes.
- 3. Press in the joystick to confirm, and press the **Menu** button to exit the menu.

3.3.6 LCD brightness

Use this option to set the brightness of the LCD.

- Press the joystick up or down to highlight the LCD brightness option.
- Press the joystick left or right to select from Darkest, Darker, Normal, Brighter or Brightest.



3. Press in the joystick to confirm, and press the **Menu** button to exit the menu.


3.3.7 Language

Use the option to set a language for the OSD menu of the camera.

- 1. Press the joystick up or down to highlight the **Language** option.
- 2. Press the joystick left or right to select from the languages.
- 3. Press in the joystick to confirm, and press the **Menu** button to exit the menu.

3.3.8 TV system

Use this option to set the camera video output to match the TV system in your area.





2. Press the joystick left or right to select between **NTSC** and **PAL**.



3. Press in the joystick to confirm, and press the **Menu** button to exit the menu.

3.3.9 Format

Use this option to format the data stored on the memory card or in the internal memory.

- 1. Press the joystick up or down to highlight the **Format** option.
- 2. Press in the joystick to confirm and proceed.




Note: When this function is used, all stored data (including photos and videos) will be erased and cannot be recovered. Make sure you backup all data before formatting.

3.3.10 Default

Use the option to reset all settings to the factory default.

- 1. Press the joystick up or down to highlight the **Default** option.
- 2. Press in the joystick to confirm.



3.4 Setting menu

The setting menu includes both Video and Photo Mode settings.

To access the **Setup** menu:

- 1. Turn the camera on.
- Press the Menu button and press the joystick left or right to choose between Video Mode and Photo Mode.

To leave the **Setting** menu while configuring the camera, press the **Menu** button to exit the **Setting** menu.

3.4.1 Video mode

Read this section to configure the settings in **DV** mode.

To access the Video mode:

- Turn the camera on and press the Menu button.
- 2. Press the joystick left or right to highlight **Video Mode**.
- 3. Press the joystick up to enter the **Video mode** setting menu.



Use this option to set the resolution for each video shoot.

- Press the joystick up or down to highlight the Resolution option.
- Press the joystick left or right to select from QVGA,
 D1 or VGA.
- 3. Press in the joystick to confirm, and press the **Menu** button to exit the menu.

3.4.1.2 *EV adjust*

Use this option to change the exposure for your video. Usually this value would be set to **0.0**, but you might want to increase the

exposure to light up a subject with dark lighting, or decrease the exposure if you are shooting a video in a very bright area.

To adjust the EV adjust:

1. Press the joystick up or down

3.4.1.3 Digital filter

Use this option to convert a video image to different color areas.

To set the **Digital filter**:

- Press the joystick up or down to highlight the **Digital** filter option.
- 2. Press the joystick left or right to select from Normal, Sepia, Black/White, Red, Pink, Purple, Blue, Green, Yellow, Solarize or Negative.

3. Press in the joystick to confirm and press **Menu** again to exit the menu.

3.4.1.4 Stabilization

Use this option to counteract camera shaking and help you to shoot clearer videos.

To set the **Stabilization**:

- Press the joystick up or down to highlight the Stabilization option.

- 3. Press in the joystick to confirm and press **Menu** again to exit the menu.

3.4.1.5 Monitor Video

Use this option to have your camera not to start shooting a video until the image within the focusing area is moving.

To set the **Monitor Video**:

- 1. Press the joystick up or down to highlight the **Monitor Video** option.
- Press the joystick left or right to select between on and off.



When you select **on**, the camera will automatically start to shoot a video when the image within the focusing area is moving.

Press in the joystick to confirm and press the **Menu** button to exit the menu.

3.4.2 Photo mode

Read this section to configure the settings in **Capture** mode.

To access the **Photo mode**:

- 1. Turn the camera on and press the **Menu** button.
- 2. Press the joystick left or right to highlight the **Photo Mode.**
- 3. Press the joystick up to enter the **Photo Mode** setting menu.

3.4.2.1 Scene

Use this option to select a proper scene mode to take a picture.

To set a **Scene**:



1. Press the joystick up or down to highlight the **Scene**

option.

2. Press the joystick left or right to select from Auto, Portrait, Landscape, Night, Sport, Night Portrait, Sunset, Beach Autumn, Natural, Backlight, Sky or Party.

3.4.2.2 Resolution

Use this option to determine the resolution

of the picture that is going to be taken. A larger resolution will

occupy more memory storage space.

To set the **Resolution**:

- Press the joystick up or down to highlight the Resolution option.
- 2. Press the joystick left or right to select from VGA, 1.3M, 3.0M, 5.0M, 7.0M or 12.0M.

3. Press in the joystick to confirm and press the **Menu** button again to exit the menu.

3.4.2.3 Image quality

Use this option to set the image quality for the picture you're going to capture. A high quality picture occupies more memory space.

To set the **Image quality**:

1. Press the joystick up or down



to highlight the **Image quality** option.


- 2. Press the joystick left or right to select from **Basic**, **Better**, or **Best**.
- 3. Press in the joystick to confirm and press the **Menu** button again to exit the menu.

3.4.2.4 Continuous shots

Three pictures will be taken continuously when this function is activated. Use this function to take continuous pictures with a short delay between each.

To set **Continuous shots** mode:

- Press the joystick up or down to highlight the Continuous shot option.
- 2. Press the joystick left or right to select between **off** and **on.**



3.4.2.5 *Couple shot*

Use this option to combine two different images in one photo.

To use the Couple shot:

- 1. Press the joystick up or down to highlight the **Couple** shot option.
- 2. Press the joystick left or right to select between **off** and

on, and press in the joystick to confirm.

3. Use the LCD screen to frame the first image you want to shoot, and press the **Capture** button. The first image will

- appear on the left side of the LCD screen.
- 4. Use the LCD screen to frame the second image you want to shot, and press the **Capture** button. The second image will appear on the right of the LCD screen.

Now you can combine two different images in one photo.

3.4.2.6 Date stamp

Use this option to set the date stamp to be shown on the images.

To set the **Date stamp**:

1. Press the joystick up or down to highlight the **Date stamp**

option.

 Press the joystick left or right to select from No stamp,
 Only date, Only time, or
 Date and time.

3. Press in the joystick to confirm and press the **Menu** button again to exit the menu.



3.4.2.7 Picture frame

Use this option to add a picture frame to your pictures when they are taken. There are 16 picture frames to choose from.

To set a **Picture frame**:


1. Press the joystick up or down to highlight the **Picture** frame option.

2. Press the joystick left or right to select between **Off** and

3. Highlight the **On** option and press in the joystick, and then you can browse the frames.

4. Press the joystick left, right,



up or down to select a frame from the 16 picture frames.

5. Press in the joystick to confirm and exit the menu.

3.4.2.8 *EV adjust*

Use this option to change the exposure for your photo. Usually this value would be set to **0.0**, but you might want to increase the exposure to light up a subject with black lighting, or decrease the exposure if taking a video in a very bright area.

To adjust the **EV adjust**:

- Press the joystick up or down to highlight the EV adjust option.
- 2. Press the joystick left or right to select from **-2.0** ~ **0.0** ~ **+2.0**.



3. Press in the joystick to confirm, and press the Menu button to exit the menu.

3.4.2.9 ISO

ISO (Sensitivity) settings control the camera's sensitivity to light. The lower the sensitivity, higher exposure value is needed. When you increase the sensitivity, the shutter speed will be faster and exposure value will be reduced. There might be noises on the images.

To set the ISO:

- 1. Press the joystick up or down to highlight the **ISO** option.
- 2. Press the joystick left or right to select from **Auto**, **50**, **100** or **200**. (100 is equivalent to the ISO 100 film, and so on.)
- 3. Press in the joystick to confirm and press **Menu**





3.4.2.10 Digital filter

Use this option to convert images to different color areas.

To set the **Digital filter**:

- 4. Press the joystick up or down to highlight the **Digital filter** option.
- 5. Press the joystick left or right to select from Normal, Sepia, Black & white, Red, Pink, Purple, Blue, Green, Yellow, Solarize or Negative.

3.4.2.11 *Metering*

This camera provides 3 metering modes (Matrix, Center-weighted

and **Spot**) to support you with taking photos in different situations.

To set the **Metering** mode:

- Press the joystick up or down to highlight the Metering option.
- Press the joystick left or right to select from Matrix, Center-weighted or Spot.
- 3. Press in the joystick to confirm and press **Menu** again to exit the menu.

3.4.2.12 *Histogram*

Use this option to show a graph that displays how light is distributed in your picture.

To set the **Histogram** mode:

- Press the joystick up or down to highlight the Histogram option.
- 2. Press the joystick left or right to select between **Off** and **On**.
- 3. Press in the joystick to confirm and press **Menu** again to exit the menu.





3.4.2.13 Icon

Use this option to turn on or off all of the icons on the LCD.

To set the **Icon** mode:

- 1. Press the joystick up or down to highlight the **Icon** option.
- 2. Press the joystick left or right to select between **Off** and **On**.



4.2 Using the self-timer function

Use the self-timer function to set a delay between the moment you press the shutter and the moment the picture is captured. A delay of **3** or **10** seconds can be set. This function can be used in both capture and record mode.

To set the **Self-timer**:

- 1. Turn the camera on.
- 2. Press the **joystick** up to select from **Off**, **3 sec**, or **10 sec**. The selected timer will be shown on the center of the LCD screen.
- Press the Capture or Video record button to start counting down.



4.3 Setting the Flash mode

When you start to take a picture, press the **joystick** left to switch between **Flash** modes.

See the table below for a detailed description and symbol of each **Flash** mode.

Note: This function will be activated only when you are taking a picture.

4.4 White balance

Use this option to correct color for different lighting conditions.

Turn on the camera and then press the joystick right to select from **Auto**, **Daylight**, **Cloudy**, **Tungsten**, or **Fluorescent**. (Each press will just change the mode one at a time.)

4.5 Using the zoom function

This function works in both Capture and Video modes.

To control the zoom function press the **T** (**Zoom in**) button which gets closer to the subject, or **W** (**Zoom out**) button which moves away from the subject.

The zoom bar on the LCD screen indicates the zoom status.

Video button

To shoot a video:

- 1. Turn on the camera.
- 2. Use the **focus area** on the LCD screen to frame the picture.
- 3. Press the **Video** button to shoot the video.

The video clip will be saved either on the SD card or in the internal memory with a unique file name.

8.5 Games

9 Installing the Applications

9.1 Drivers

After installing the camera driver, you can use the camera as a "Mass Storage device" on the PC.

9.1.1 Camera Driver


This camera offers a Mass Storage function as a card reader device.

When the driver has been installed and the camera is connected, the camera memory and any installed mini SD card will appear as a **Mass Storage Device** in Windows Explorer. Files can be dragged and dropped in the same way as on an ordinary disk.

Before connecting the camera to the PC as a **PC camera**, follow the following instructions to finish the driver installation.

Please follow the instructions below:

- 1. Insert the supplied CD-ROM in the CD-ROM drive.
- 2. Use Windows Explorer to execute the **Setup.exe** file in the root directory.
- 3. The installation is configuring the window settings.



Note: Please install the XviD on your system, or else you may not be able to play the recorded videos on the PC.

10 Connect to a TV


10.1 View photos and videos on the TV

You can connect the camera to a TV and use the TV screen to review your images and play back your video clips. In addition, you can also use this camera to record your favorite TV programs.

Before using the feature, you need to make sure that the output mode is correct. Please refer to "3.3.8 TV system "on page 17 to set the TV output mode.

To view photos and videos on the TV, please follow these instructions:

- 1. Turn on the camera, and press the **Playback** button to enter **Playback** menu.
- 2. Select a photo or video in **Photo** or **Video** playback mode, and press in the joystick to play.




- 3. Connect the TV out jack on your camera to the audio / video input ports on your TV using the AV cable provided. The LCD screen turns off.
- 4. Follow the procedures described in "8.1.1 Viewing photos" on page 35 or "8.2.1 Viewing videos" on page 40 to play the files in your camera.

10.2 Recording TV programs

You can connect the camera to a TV to record your favorite TV program.

First, make sure that the AV cable has been connected with the TV

properly.



Note: You can't hear the voice of the program when you are recording the TV program. But you can still hear the voice when playing back the recorded video file.

To record TV programs, please follow the procedure:


- Connect the AV jack on your camera to the audio / video input ports on your TV using the AV cable provided.

The video clip will be saved either on the SD card or in the internal memory with a unique file name.
