


Computer

You need a computer with the following

- Pentium III 800MHz processor or higher
- 512 MB RAM
- 500MB hard disk space
- Internet connection
- Windows® Internet Explorer 6.0 or later
- CD-ROM drive
- USB port


# Overview of the controls and connections



<b>A</b>		display
<b>B</b>	 / 	press: scroll up/down press and hold: scroll up/down at high speed
<b>C</b>	<b>-VOL +</b>	press: increase/decrease the volume press and hold: increase/decrease fast
<b>D</b>	<b>OPTIONS</b>	view available options
<b>E</b>	 / 	press: skip to next/previous press and hold: scroll back/forward at high speed
<b>F</b>	<b>MIC</b>	microphone
<b>G</b>		press: play/pause
<b>H</b>		press: back one level press and hold: return to main menu
<b>I</b>		headphone jack
<b>J</b>		USB connection jack
<b>K</b>	<b>RESET</b>	press: reset GoGear Ariaz
<b>L</b>		slide and hold: turn GoGear Ariaz on/off
		slide: lock/unlock all buttons except <b>-VOL +</b>

# Connect and charge

- 1 Connect the USB plug of the supplied USB cable to a spare USB port on your computer.
- 2 Connect the small USB plug of the USB cable to the small USB jack on GoGear Ariaz.
- 3 Turn on your computer.  
> *GoGear Ariaz* charges.



## Note

- For first-time use, allow GoGear Ariaz to charge for 3 hours.
- The charging animation stops and the  icon is displayed when the charging process is completed.

- 1 Connect GoGear Ariaz to your computer.
- 2 Insert the CD that comes with GoGear Ariaz into the CD-ROM drive of your computer.
- 3 Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the installation of the software.

If the installation program fails to start automatically:

- 1 Browse the CD contents with Windows Explorer.
- 2 Double click on the file ending with '.exe'.

# Install software

GoGear Ariaz comes with the following software:

- Philips Device Manager (helps you get firmware updates for GoGear Ariaz)
- Media Converter for Philips (helps you convert and transfer video files for GoGear Ariaz)
- Windows Media Player (helps you convert and transfer music files for GoGear Ariaz)

## **Important**

- Remember to install the software provided in the supplied CD-ROM for music and/or video transfer.
- Before installing the software, check that your computer meets the requirements.

# Turn GoGear Ariaz on

- 1 To toggle between modes on and off, slide and hold  for approximately 2 seconds.

GoGear Ariaz has a lock switch to prevent accidental operation:

- 1 To lock the buttons when you play, move the slider to position  .
  - > *All buttons except the volume keys are locked and the display shows a lock icon.*
- 2 To unlock the buttons again, move the slider to the center position.

# Navigate and play

- 1 From the main menu, select  /  / , press  /  to browse music / videos / pictures.
- 2 Press  to select music / video / picture.
  - Mode  / : Press  to toggle between pause and play music / video.
  - Mode : Press  to start slideshow.
- 3 Press **OPTIONS** to view available options.

**Tip** You can find more detailed information on these features in the user manual.

# Transfer and organize

You can install the **Windows Media Player** to organize and facilitate locating your files.

- 1 With GoGear Ariaz connected to the USB port of the computer, open **Windows® Explorer**.
- 2 Create folders in the mass storage of GoGear Ariaz.
- 3 Use drag and drop actions to sort your music into the folders.

**MediaConverter™** for Philips enables you to

- download videos from the Internet to your PC at the click of a button.
- convert video files (that are compatible with **Windows Media Player**) on your PC to the correct screen size of GoGear Ariaz.
- transfer converted videos from your PC to GoGear Ariaz.

**Note** Video conversion and transfer can take a long time, depending on your PC configuration.

# Napster

The Napster To Go online music service offers a variety of purchase and subscription models.

The Napster Software supplied with GoGear Ariaz helps you

- search Napster for music by name
  - purchase Napster music
  - play unlimited Napster music on your computer
  - transfer your Napster music to your GoGear Ariaz
  - browse the Napster catalogue
- 1 Download and launch the Napster software on your computer.
  - 2 Connect GoGear Ariaz to your computer.
  - 3 Use drag and drop action to transfer music to GoGear Ariaz.

**Note** The download of Napster subscription tracks requires Computer activation. For more detailed instructions on Napster To Go, refer to the user manual. You can also launch Napster To Go, select 'Help' from the pull-down menu and click on 'Tutorial' or 'User Guide' to learn more.

# Audiobooks

GoGear Ariaz supports books in audio format. The use of this feature requires that you download the **AudibleManager** from [audible.com](http://audible.com). With the **AudibleManager** you can manage the digital contents of your audiobooks.

Visit [audible.com](http://audible.com) and register. The onscreen instructions guide you through the **AudibleManager** software download process.

While you listen to an audiobook, you can navigate the same way as you would in any other audio file.

# Listen to radio

- 1 From the main menu, select .
- 2 To search for the next stronger signal, press and hold ▲ / ▼.
- 3 To fine tune the frequency, briefly press ▲ / ▼.

**Tip** You can find more information on presets and auto-tuning in the user manual.

# Settings

This is how you navigate and customize the **Settings**.

- 1 Press ▲ / ▼ to select an option.
- 2 Press ►|| to confirm a selection and go to the next level (when available).
- 3 Press ↶ to return to the previous level.
- 4 Press and hold ↶ to exit the **Settings** menu.

# Update GoGear Ariaz

- 1 Ensure that your computer is connected to the Internet.
- 2 Connect GoGear Ariaz to the computer (see section **Connect and charge** for instructions).
- 3 On your computer, click **Start > Programs > Philips Digital Audio Player > Ariaz Device Manager** to launch **Philips Device Manager**.
- 4 Click **Update**.
  - > *Philips GoGear Ariaz Device Manager* checks for updates and installs new firmware from the Internet, if available.
- 5 When the display shows **Update completed**, click **OK**.
- 6 Disconnect GoGear Ariaz from the computer.
  - > *GoGear Ariaz* restarts after the firmware is updated and is ready for use again.
