

## Safety Notes:

The DVD video display of the in-dash unit will not operate while the vehicle is moving. This is a safety feature to prevent driver distraction. In-dash DVD video functions will only operate when vehicle is in Park and the parking brake is engaged. It is illegal in most states for the driver to view video while the vehicle is in motion.




TYPICAL FRONT-LOAD DIN MOUNTING METHOD

### Control Locations



- 1. Release
- 2. Power/Open-Press to turn on the unit. When the unit is on, short press to open or close. Long press to turn unit off.
- 3. Mode-When in playback, press to select mode.
- 4. Volume/Talk-Turn the knob to increase or decrease the volume. In Bluetooth mode press this knob to receive the incoming phone call.
- Eject -Press to eject disc.
- 6. Auxiliary A/V Input
- 7. Band
- 8. USB
- 9. Track Up/Down
- 10. Mute/End Call-Press to mute the audio output. In Bluetooth mode, press to end a phone call.
- 11. Reset Press and hold to switch back to the original factory settings. This will erase all preset radio stations.

#### **Pairing and Connecting**

Before you can use a Bluetooth device, it must be paired and connected. The XDVD110BT broadcasts the pairing signal constantly when no devices are currently connected. Complete the pairing sequence from your Bluetooth device. The device name is "Dual BT". The Bluetooth passcode "1234". Once pairing is complete, most Bluetooth will connect automatically if the device is in range when the XDVD110BT is powered-on.

## Dialing a Number

## Making and Ending a Call

Press \(^\) to connect a call, and press \(^\) to end a call.

## **Accessing Recent Call List**

Press 😯 to access the recent call list and view/select numbers from recent Received, Dialed or Missed calls.

## **Streaming Audio**
