

POWER SWITCHES

There are two slide switches that turn your vehicle ON and OFF.
Your **CHUCK MY TALKING TRUCK** wehicle is packaged in "TRY ME" mode. To activate the full range of play features:




Move to the ON position to play.


Move to the ON position for Sound Activation.

PLAY FEATURES MY TALKING TRUCKTM vehicle in

Your **CHUCK MY TALKING TRUCK[™]** vehicle has 4 sensors. When a sensor is activated, he makes a sound, says a phrase, wiggles his dump bed and moves his front bumper.



SOUND ACTIVATION



Turn **ON** the sound activation switch . When you call to your **CHUCK MY TALKING TRUCK**[™] vehicle or make a loud sound, he will honk his horn, and then drive forward.

Unintentional loud sounds from televisions, radios and people in close proximity to the vehicle may cause the vehicle to respond.

Turn **OFF** the sound activation feature by sliding switch to **OFF**.

If your vehicle bumps into something while in Sound Activation mode, he will stop moving and make a noise.

If you stop playing with your vehicle for 20 seconds, he will say "bye" and turn off. Activate any of his sensors to turn him back on.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If your **CHUCK MY TALKING TRUCK™** vehicle does not respond, move power switches to OFF, then ON.

Or, replace the batteries.



X3 | BATTERIES INCLUDED

Replace with 3 x 1.5V "C" or LR14 size alkaline batteries Phillips/cross head screwdriver (not included) needed to replace batteries.

Use a Phillips/cross head screwdriver (not included) to loosen screws in battery compartment cover (screws remain attached to cover). Remove cover. Remove and discard old batteries. Replace with 3 x 1.5V "C" or LRI4 size alkaline batteries. Replace cover and tighten screws.

IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

A CAUTION:

- 1. Always follow the instructions carefully. Use only batteries specified and be sure to insert them correctly by matching the + and polarity markings.
- 2. Do not mix old batteries and new batteries, or standard (carbon-zinc) with alkaline batteries.
- 3. Remove exhausted or dead batteries from the product.
- 4. Remove batteries if product is not to be played with for a long time.
- 5. Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
