ASSEMBLY



• "Snap" the peg on the backpack into the socket in the tool arm.

LIGHTING THE WAY TO RESCUE!



• Press plunger on the backpack to see the drill spin and glow!

BATTERY REPLACEMENT



- Locate the battery compartment door on the tool arm.
- Loosen the screw in the battery compartment door with a Phillips screwdriver. Remove the battery compartment door.
- Insert three, new, button cell (LR44) **alkaline** batteries.

Hint: We recommend using alkaline batteries for longer battery life.

- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screw with a Phillips screwdriver. Do not over-tighten.
- When lights or motions become faint or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries!



- Wipe the toy with a clean cloth dampened with a mild soap and water solution.
- Do not immerse the toy.
