




Rack Mounting

This section describes how to install the TAG appliance into a rack.


Rack mount options include:

- Front mount
- Front mount and mid-mount

Front Mount

Figure 2-1 shows the appliance front panel being attached to the rack.

Rack Mounting—Front Mount




Mid-Mount

The appliance ships with a mid-mount accessory kit. Figure 2-2 shows the appliance installed in a rack, with the front mount attached, and a mid-mount placement example.

To attach the appliance to the rack, perform the following steps:

- 1. Use the two mounting holes closest to the center of the appliance for more balanced mounting position.
- 2. Use the M4 screws (2 screws for each side) to secure the center mounting bracket to the appliance. When securing the appliance to the rack, use the M5 screws to secure the chassis to the post of the rack.

Configuration

Once a TAG appliance is physically installed into a rack, you need to connect a monitor and a USB keyboard, connect the power cord and network cable, and power it on (see Figure 1-1 and Figure 1-2). Then, you must go through the initial configuration process described in this chapter.

This chapter also includes information on how to change your appliance settings following your initial configuration, Changing Trusted Access Gateway Settings on page 3-3.

Pre-Configuration Tasks

The following information is needed prior to executing any of the steps in this chapter:

- Appliance Hostname, IP address, and netmask
- Gateway IP address
- Management Server IP address

Configure the Appliance



Note: To upgrade the pre-installed software, go to the Enterasys Networks web site to download the latest version of the Enterasys Sentinel Trusted Access Gateway image. For instructions, refer to Chapter 4, Upgrading Trusted Access Gateway Software.

To configure the appliance to run the Trusted Access Gateway software:

- 1. Login as **root**, with no password, and then press **Enter**. You will receive a warning that there is no root password detected, and be asked if you would like to set a root password.
- 2. Highlight **Yes**, and press **Enter**.
- Enter the new password, re-enter the password, and press **Enter**.



Note: Enterasys recommends that all passwords be at least eight characters in length.

The CONFIGURE NETWORK screen appears.

- 4. Highlight **Yes** to configure your network, and press **Enter**. The ENTER HOSTNAME screen appears.
- 5. Enter the hostname for the appliance, then highlight **OK** and press **Enter**. The SETUP IP ADDRESS FOR "your host name" screen appears.

- 6. Select from the following, highlight **OK**, and press **Enter**.
 - static IP: uses a static IP address to configure Ethernet
 - **DCHP**: uses a DHCP server to configure Ethernet
 - **loopback**: used to set up a loopback connection (modem or no net)



Note: Static IP is recommended; however, you must evaluate your network environment.

The ENTER IP ADDRESS FOR "your host name" screen appears.

- 7. Enter the appliance IP address, highlight **OK**, and press **Enter**. The ENTER NETMASK FOR LOCAL NETWORK screen appears.
- 8. Enter the appliance netmask, highlight **OK**, and press **Enter**. The ENTER GATEWAY ADDRESS screen appears.
- 9. Enter the gateway address for your network, highlight **OK**, and press **Enter**.



Note: If you do not have a gateway on your network, leave the field blank and press Enter.

The USE A NAME SERVER screen appears.

- 10. If you will be accessing a name server, highlight **Yes** and press **Enter**.
 - The SELECT NAME SERVER screen appears.
- 11. Enter the primary name server IP address, highlight **OK**, and press **Enter**.
 - The CONFIRM NETWORK SETUP screen appears.
- 12. Verify your information, highlight ACCEPT, and press Enter. Press Enter again in the second verification screen to accept.
 - Basic network configuration is complete. The ENTER MANAGEMENT SERVER IP screen appears.
- 13. Enter the IP address of the management server, highlight **OK**, and press **Enter**. The HW CLOCK screen appears.
- 14. Select the hardware clock setting, and then the timezone configuration. Highlight **OK** and press Enter.
 - The ENABLE SNMP DAEMON screen appears.
- 15. To monitor the appliance using an SNMP node manager, highlight YES and press Enter. The ENTER SYSTEM CONTACT and the ENTER SYSTEM LOCATION screens appear.
- 16. Enter the system contact and the system location. Highlight **OK** and press **Enter** for each screen.
 - The READ COMMUNITY STRING, WRITE COMMUNITY STRING, SNMP TRAP DESTINATION, and the TRAP COMMUNITY screens appear.
- 17. Enter the read community string, write community string, SNMP trap destination, and the trap community string. Highlight **OK** and press **Enter** for each screen.
- 18. Configuration is complete. Reboot the appliance.

You are now ready to use Trusted Access Manager to manage your Trusted Access Gateway appliance. If this is your initial commissioning of the appliance, you can launch Trusted Access Manager and select **Getting Started** from the Trusted Access Manager **Help** pull-down menu for information on using Trusted Access Manager to configure and manage your TAG appliance.

If you are upgrading your Trusted Access Gateway software, be sure to enforce the TAG appliance (via Trusted Access Manager) following the upgrade operation. Enforcing writes your Trusted Access Manager Security Domain information to the appliance.

Changing Trusted Access Gateway Settings

Use these steps if you need to change your TAG appliance settings following your initial appliance configuration.

Changing Basic Network Configuration

To change basic network configuration settings such as hostname and appliance IP address, enter the following command at the appliance CLI:

```
/opt/tag/dnetconfig
```

This will start the network configuration script and allow you to make the required changes. You must reboot the appliance for the new settings to take effect.

Changing the Management Server IP Address

To change the IP address of the management server, enter the following command at the appliance CLI:

```
/opt/tag/configMgmtIP <IP address>
```

Then, start using the new management server by typing:

tagctl restart

Enabling the SNMP Daemon

To enable the SNMP daemon, enter the following command at the appliance CLI:

```
/usr/postinstall/snmpconfig
```

Follow the configuration instructions.

Then, start the SNMP daemon by entering:

```
/etc/rc.d/rc.net-snmp restart
```

If you reboot the appliance, the SNMP daemon will start automatically.

Changing SNMP Passwords

To change SNMP passwords, enter the following commands at the appliance CLI:

```
vi/etc/snmp/snmpd.conf
/etc/rc.d/rc.net-snmp restart
```

Upgrading Trusted Access Gateway Software

This chapter describes the procedure to upgrade the Trusted Access Gateway software on the TAG appliance. You will need to connect a monitor and a USB keyboard to the TAG appliance prior to performing these steps.

- Go to the Enterasys Networks web site to download the TAG.zip file to your system: http://www.enterasys.com/products/management/downloads
- 2. Extract the **TAG.zip** file to a directory on your system.
- 3. Insert the USB flash drive that came with the TAG appliance into the USB port on your system and note the drive letter it is assigned.
- Open a command prompt window and cd to the directory where you extracted the TAG.zip
- 5. Type make disk.bat <drive letter>: and press Enter. The files will be copied to the USB flash drive. When the copy is complete you will see the message "Successfully installed into <drive letter>: Press any key to continue."
- 6. Remove the USB flash drive from your system.
- 7. Insert the USB flash drive into either USB port (see Figure 1-1) on the TAG appliance.
- 8. Press the power button, and then press **F2** to go to the BIOS setup.
- 9. Use the arrow keys to navigate to **BOOT** option.
- 10. Ensure that the USB flash drive is listed as Priority 1. If it is not, move it to Priority 1.
- 11. Press **Save** to exit.
- 12. The appliance starts booting from the USB flash drive.
- 13. When the boot is complete, the Appliance Installation screen appears. Select the appliance type, and press **Enter**. The installation begins.
- 14. After the installation completes, reboot the appliance and then remove the USB flash drive.
- 15. Proceed to Chapter 3, Configure the Appliance, and follow the instructions for configuring the TAG appliance.
- 16. If you are upgrading your Trusted Access Gateway software, be sure to enforce the TAG appliance (using Trusted Access Manager) following the upgrade operation. Enforcing writes your Trusted Access Manager Security Domain information to the appliance.
