To operate the unit correctly, please read the owner's manual carefully before using the unit. Keep these instructions and retain this booklet for future reference.

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Notes on installation

- The unit is designed for 12V DC, negative ground operation system only. Before installing the unit,
- make sure your vehicle is connected to DC 12V negative ground electrical system.
- The negative battery terminal must be disconnected before making connections, which can reduce damaging the unit due to short circuit.
- Be sure to connect the color coded leads correctly according to the diagram. Incorrect connections may cause the unit malfunction or damage the vehicle's electrical system.
- Be sure to connect the speaker (-)

 leads to the speaker (-) terminal.

 Never connect the left and right

 channel speaker cables each other

 or to the vehicle body.
- panels. Blocking them will cause heat to build up inside and may result in fire.

After the completion of the installation and begin to play the unit (including replacing the battery), please press the RESET button on the front panel with pointed objects (such as ball-point pen) to set the unit to initial status.

 - ——Handle the disc by its edge to keep the disc clean, and do not touch the surface.








Wiring Diagram



1. Power ON/OFF control

Press the button to the power "ON"or "OFF"

2. Mute control

Press and keep pressed the button to mute volume control and "MUTE ON" will appear on the display. Press mute button again to return to the previous volume level. "MUTE off" will appear on display.



3. Mode control

Press this button to select Radio (TUNER), DVD/VCD/CD/MP3(S-CDP) & USB (USB--DRIV)mode.



4. Band selector

Each time this button is pressed, the radio band is changed. The indication "Fm1" "FM2" "FM3" "MW1" or "MW2" will appear on the display according to your selection.



5. Setting P-EQ

While listening to the popular music, classic musec and rock music, you can adjust the sound quality to make it perfect by pressing (P-EQ) button. The procedure is as follows:

★ POP mode is selected when (P-EQ) button is first pressed and "POP" appears in the display.

★ ROCK mode is selected when pressing (P-EQ) button at the second time, and "ROCK" appears on the LCD.





- ★ Press [5] (P-EQ) button at the forth time to turn off the P-EQ system.
 - ★ Note: Bass mode and Treble mode rerurn to initial settings when P-EQ system is on, "BASS" and "TREBLE" disappear.
- 6. ST Selector (L/R)

Press and keep pressed 6(ST) button to select MONO mode or STEREO mode.

Stereo reception is charged when "ST" appears in the LCD . And "@" appears in the display.

It is switched to MONO mode when "ST" disappears.

During the player mode, press the button to switch left speaker/right speaker/stereo.

7. Loudness Button

Press the button to increase the low frequency. This can improve the sensitivity for your ears. And "LOUD" appears in the LCD when the loudness mode is activated. Press it once more to shut down the LOU function.

8. Volume control

Press the "VOL+" to increase volume level ,Press "VOL-" to decrease it:



9. Open/close button / Detaching panel button

Press this button to show the disc slot in the main panel.

 To detach the front panel, press this button so that the panel slide down from vertical to horizontal position. Use thumb hold near the preset button between 3 and 4, and use other finger to hold the corrugated release button at the back of the front panel while pulling.

 To re-attach the panel, put the front panel to the slide down metal frame by clipping it into place.

10.Remote Control Receptor

Receptor for the card remote commander.

★ Note: This window is used for the unit with remote control function Without this function, you should ignore the operation contents about remote control function.

11. Tuning/Selecting Tracks

Manual Tuning: Press ■ (+) or (4 -) button continuously to select a station upward or downward respectively.

Automatic Tuning: Press and hold **■** (+) or **★** or button for more than 3 seconds, the radio automatically searches a station upward or down ward respectively and plays when it finds a station.

12. Reset Button

Operating the unit for the first time or after replacing the car battery, you must reset the unit. Press [2] (RES) button with a pointed object (such as a ballpoint pen) to set the unit to initial procedure.

★ Note: When some errors occur in the LCD display, you can press RESET button to resume to normal. And it will erase the clock setting and some memorized functions.

13, Eject Button

Press the eject button will eject the disc.

14. Setting the Sound Characteristics

Audio level control (when pushing one after another)

Press the button shortly one after another to show "VOL/BAS/TRE/BAL/FAD" control.

 VOLUME-press this button once, then rotate anti-clockwise to decrease, or clockwise to increase volume level.



 BASS -press this button twice, then rotate anti-clockwise to decrease, or clockwise to increase bass level.



 TREBLE - press this button 3 times, then rotate anti-clockwise to decrease, or clockwise to increase treble level.

 BALANCE -press this button 4 times, then rotate anti-clockwise or clockwise to level balance of speaker right and left.



 FADER -press this button 5 times, then rotate anti-clockwise or clockwise to level fader of speaker front and rear.



 BRIGHTNESS-press this button6 times, then rotate anti-clockwise to decrease, or clockwise to increase BRIGHTNESS level.



 CONTRAST-press this button 7 times, then rotate anti-clockwise to decrease, or clockwise to increase CONTRAST level.



 COLOR-press this button 8 times, then rotate anti-clockwise to decrease, or clockwise to increase COLOR level.



SHARP-press this button 9 times, then rotate anti-clockwise to decrease, or clockwise to increase SHARP level.

 HUE-press this button 10 times, then rotate anti-clockwise to decrease, or clock wise to increase HUE lever.



15. Number Buttons

Number buttons can help you store your favorite station by pressing any one of the number buttons. You can follow the steps as below:

Press and hold any **number button** [5] (1~6) until "CH" appears in the LCD display when receiving a station. And now the station is already stored in the corresponding number button.

Holding the disc to insert into the disc slot. The disc mechanism will automatically engage into DVD/VCD/CD/MP3 play mode.

18 Preset Stations/AMS

AMS RADIO OPERATION


Press (AMS) button to scan each stored station 10 seconds respectively which stored in (1~6) number buttons. When AMS mode is carried out. "INT" appears on display. You also can press the corresponding number button or AMS button when your desired station is charged. It starts playing that station.

- ★ Press and hold (AMS) button for more than 3 seconds to activate automatically memory storing function. The radio automatically selects a station and has it stored in any one of the number buttons (1~6).
- * Note: The unit can be stored up to 6 stations for each band. Regarding the function of number buttons, refer to sumber buttons for details.


19 SD Socket

The unit can be connected to a USB flash memory (B) for playing MP3 songs through the USB cable (A) (provided together with radio).




22. LOC



Replacing the Battery


- ★ When the range of the operation of the card remote control becomes short or no functions while operating. Replace the battery with a new button cell. Make sure the battery polarity before replace.
- Pull out the Battery Holder while pressing the Stopper ①



Put the button-type battery(+) mark upward into the Battery Holder.



Insert the Battery Holder into the Remote Control.



* Random Playing

-- During the playing mode, press

(RDM) button to play any track at random. (Viz. The unit plays tracks out of turn.)



Note: RDM is not functional in DVD mode.

* Number Buttons

-- During radio mode, you can select one of the 6 stored stations on each hand by pressing any one of the number button 14

—— During the playing mode, you can select any track directly by using 14 number button (0~10+). For example, if you need the fifteenth track, you can first press button 10+ and then press button 5, the corresponding tarck (15) th. will be played.



* Left/Right/Stereo Selector

Note: There are 5 grades surrounding effect in surround mode. During VCD mode you can see the different pictures indicating different effects on the television.



* Playing PBC (menu)


—— During VCD mode only, when pressing [6] (PBC) button at the first time, PBC playback starts and the menu of entire disc appears on the television. And then you can select your favorite track by using number button [4] (0-10+) When a track is playing, you can press

(STOP/RETURN) button to return to the menu if you want to stop to select other tracks. To cancel PBC playing, press (PBC) button again.



* Subtitle Selector

——During DVD mode, press 17 (SUB-T) button to switch the menu to English, French, China, Thai and Italian

* MULT-ANGLE KEY

-- In DVD playing mode, press

(ANGLE) key, you can watch the DVD content from different angle.

Note: In VCD, MP3 and CD, it is not the function, this function depends on the disc inserted

* SLOW REVERSE/ SLOW ADVANCE KEY

— In DVD playing mode, press (SLOW) key once for 1/2 slow adwance, twice for 1/3 slow advance, third for 1/4 slow advance, fouthly

The password option is initialized locked, and you cannot set the ratings limit or change the password. In order for the Ratings feature work, the password mode must be turned on. If you want to set the ratings limit, you will need to enter the default password, which is 0000, then press Enter to confirm. To change the password, you will be prompted for the old password, then be prompted for a new. Enter a 4-digit number (this is your password).




DETACHING THE FRONT PANEL

Simple Troubleshooting Guide

Problem	Cause/Solution
No power	★ Check and make sure whether the fuse is blown replace with the proper value if necessary.
Some errors occur in the LCD or no function when pressing the button.	★ Press the RESET button.
Unable to receive stations,	★ Check and make sure whether the antenna is inserted or the antenna is properly connected. if so. insert the antenna or connect it properly.
Poor effect on receiving a station.	 ★ Antenna may not be the proper length. Make sure the antenna is fully extended or broken: if broken. Replace the antenna with a new one. ★ The broadcasting signal is too weak. ★ The antenna is poorly grounded, check and make sure the antenna is properly grounded at its mounting location.
ACDs cannot be loaded.	★ ACDs is loaded in the mechanism.
The stereo indicator " " is flashing.	 ★ Tune in the frequency accurately. ★ The broadcasting signal is too weak. (Set to the MONO mode) (page 12)
No picture.	★ The Video line from main unit to the TV is not connected properly.
The picture noise appears.	 ★ Improper setting of the color system. Set the color system to" PAL" or "SECAM". according to the connected television. ★ The CDs is dirty or damaged
