- Place your rechargeable battery pack into the Wii[™] remote battery compartment. The battery pack fits only one way.




Insert battery pack directly into the charging dock.

2 Plug in AC Adapter

Connect the AC power adapter to the DC 5V INPUT jack and to an AC outlet.

Lithium Battery Notes

Handling and Disposal

- Do not burn or bury batteries. Do not puncture or crush. Do not disassemble.
- Use only fresh batteries of the required size and recommended type.
- Do not use batteries of different types, capacities, or chemistry.
- Recycle lithium batteries. Do not dispose of in the trash.
- Remove the batteries if you do not plan to use the product for an extended time.
