

# installing batteries

Your weather station comes with two 'CR2032' batteries. Replacements are available at RadioShack or online at www.radioshack.com

2. Arrange the batteries in the compartment with both positive (+) ends facing up.



### alarms

## view alarm settings

Press **ALARM**. The alarm Time and ( (•) ) appear.

## setting the alarm

- 1. Press **ALARM** to switch to alarm mode.
- Press and hold **ALARM** for 2 seconds. The hour digit blinks.
- 3. Press **ALARM** again to select minute. Press + or to change settings. Press **ALARM** to confirm.

#### activating the alarm

Press the bell key at the back of the weather station to activate or deactivate the alarm. A bell icon appears in the clock/alarm area when the alarm is activated.

## silencing the alarm

- When the alarm sounds, it will continue to sound for two minutes while the bell icon blinks. Then it will sound again after eight minutes if you do not press any buttons.
- Press SNZ to snooze. The bell will blink and the alarm will sound again after eight minutes.
- Press the bell key on the back of the weather station to turn the alarm off.
- Press any button on the weather station (except for SNZ or the lock button) to silence the alarm for 24 hours.



The blinking bell icon means the alarm will sound again after eight minutes.

# weather forecast

Your Weather Station forecasts the next 12 to 24 hours of weather within a 30 to 50 km (19 - 31 mile) radius with 70 to 75 percent accuracy. The weather forecast is always displayed.

### clock

## setting the clock

- Press and hold MODE for 2 seconds. The time zone option blinks.
   Press MODE repeatedly to select the time zone, hour,
- minute, year, month, day, and language. Press + or to change the setting. Press MODE to confirm.

  Language options are (E) English, (D) German, (F) French, (I) Italian, and (S) Spanish.

  Time zone options are (PA) Pacific Time, (MO) Mountain Time, (CE) Central Time, and (EA) Eastern Time.

# temperature and humidity

Your Weather Station can display current, minimum, and maximum temperatures and humidity percentage information.

## select temperature unit

Remove the battery compartment cover and slide the °C/°F switch into the desired location.

#### minimum and maximum records

Press **MEM** to toggle between current, maximum (**MAX**) and minimum (**MIN**) records. To clear the records, press and hold **MEM** for 2 seconds. A beep will sound to confirm that the memory has been cleared.

#### barometer

Your Weather Station tracks barometric pressure changes over a 24 hour period to provide the weather forecast and a trend line showing the direction of barometric change.

- 2. Press + or to view the moon phase for the next or previous day. Press and hold + or to scan quickly through the years (2001 to 2099).

### features

# backlight

Press SNZ to activate the backlight for 8 seconds.

### key lock

Lock the buttons to avoid accidental changes. Press and hold **LOCK** for two seconds until the lock icon appears on the LCD. Repeat to unlock buttons.

## belt clip or table stand

You can wear the belt clip on your belt or use it as a stand.

To use the belt clip as a stand, remove the belt clip from the back of the monitor. Insert the left or right side of the clip into the lower part of the slot. Then snap the other side of the clip into the other lower slot.

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# caring for your weather station

- Keep your weather station dry; if it gets wet, wipe it dry immediately. Use and store your weather station only in room temperature environments. Handle your weather station carefully; do not drop it. Keep your weather station away from dust and dirt, and wipe it with a damp cloth occasionally to keep it looking new.
- When the sound becomes weak or distorted, the display dims, or the weather station stops operating properly, replace the batteries. If the weather station continues to operate improperly, consult your local RadioShack store.
- If the weather station stops operating properly, you might need to reset it. Press the RESET button inside of the battery compartment.
