- Install this player in a position where the driver is completely unaffected from any distractions.




Nextar's Car DVD system comes with a 7" inch TFT LCD (16:9/4:3) color monitor. The DVD player can play your pre packaged DVD's, and these formats as well; Super VCD/Video CD/ Audio CD/MP3/JPEG/CD-R/CD-R/W/WMA. Please use 12V for the best performance results. The screen is a high horizontal definition up to 500 lines, using MPEG2 coding. It has the ability to zoom out of the picture by 1 or 2 times to enjoy a more detailed picture. The DVD content can display English, Chinese, and Japanese. The language for dialogue can be displayed in more than 32 languages. This player usually takes the place of your dome light, which is why reading lamps are on your player.

The player comes equipped with Dolby Digital system developed by Dolby Laboratories. DTS Digital surround sound developed by Digital Theater Systems, Inc. Simulative audio output enables the player to connect to any other amplifier equipment. Video input and output, enables the player to input video signal or output video signal to other display equipment.

Special functions enable you to use this player easily. You are able to fast forward, fast backward, slow play, repeat play, and program play while disc is being viewed. This will help you find or rewind the media being played or viewed. A great feature this player has the Memory play. It can memorize the point which the media stopped and upon start up it will continue from your last viewing point.



In this section we will identify the buttons and some of the functions that are associated with the screen and player. Please look over this section to get familiar with your entire unit.



LCD Panel


- 1. TFT LCD 7" Panel
- 2. Power Powers up the screen only.
- 3. 16:9 / 4:3 Changes the view ration on the screen.
- 4. Left
- 5. Right
- 6. Menu Use for panel settings. Press this button once and the LCD panel will show Brightness, Color, Contrast, AV1/AV2, and 16:9/4:3. Use the LEFT and RIGHT buttons to make your selection.




DVD Player

- 7. Panel Open Push this to unlock the DVD player. Once the screen releases push back to desired adjustment.
- 8. DVD Power Powers up the player only.
- 9. Open Press this to open the door to the player and load a disc.

 Makes sure the disc is clean before loading. Do not touch the lens of the player




- 10. Play/ Pause Plays the disc or holds it until you want to continue.




Remote Control


- 1. Power ON/OFF –Press this to power the DVD.
- Menu/ PBC (Play Back Control) –
 When playing a disc and the system is
 setup to repeat it will carry out the set
 PBC. If the PBC is turned off use the
 menu operation buttons to select your
 setting.
- Title Press this button to enter into DVD, VCD, OSD menu, use the Menu Operation arrows to select your settings.
- AV-IN Press this button to switch between Video/Audio Internal and External.
- 5. Number pad The number pad can be used in the OSD menu. This function can be used when PBC function is off.
- 6. Repeat A-B When playing a disc, press this button once to set point A, continue through the program and press this button again to set point B. The player will replay between your settings.
- 7. PIC Press this button to show the Brightness Menu, in press up or down arrows to switch between Color, Brightness, and Contrast adjustments. Press right or left arrows to increase or decrease the Color, Brightness, and Contrast.
- 8. Subtitle Press Subtitle button to switch this function on or off. This function is only available on the discs that have multi-language options and you're able to select more than 32 kind.
- 9. Slow Press this button to slow down the speed of playing. Normal, 1/8, 1/16, 1/32.
- 10. Program The detail is subject to the program.

- 12. Audio Switch Press this button to transform between Left, Right, and Stereo sound.
- 13. Mute Press this button to disable sound.
- 14. Repeat Press this button to repeat the program, disc title, or a whole chapter.
- 15. Set up Setup for DVD system includes language, audio, video, lock, and other functions.
- 16. Zoom Mode for zooming out of the picture. Press the arrow buttons to make adjustments.
- 17. Play/Pause Play will allow player to view the disc and pause will hold until released.
- 18. Menu Operation Arrows Up, Down, Left, Right, and Enter. Give direction and confirmation.
- 19. Stop Press once to pre-stop, press again to stop playing, press three times to enter into display memory.
- 20. Console –
- A. Use this button when working out the title, chapter, angle, time, language, caption; sound track will be displayed on the screen. Set up will be available according to the functions mentioned. (Use Menu Operation Arrows to setup.)
- B. Display. Press this button to show the display time of the current disc. Press up or down arrows to shift the cursor. _ _: _ _: _ _ (Hour/ Minute/ Seconds) will display when the cursor is on the time title.
- C. Angle. Press this button to select different angle positions.
- D. Picture. Press left and right arrows to switch.
- E. Search. Press this button to skip to appointed times on the disc playing. Press up and down arrows to enter into submenu. When the cursor is on "Time Searching" title, input the time as per __: __: __ (Hour/ Minute/ Seconds)



- 21. VOL (–) Decreases the volume.
- 22. VOL (+) Increases the volume
- 23. Backward Press it to go back in 2, 4, 16, or 100 times of normal speed.
- 24. Fast Forward Press this button to go forward in 2, 4, 16, 100 times of normal speed.
- 25. Last Program Press this button to play back one chapter.
- 26. Next Program Press this button to play next chapter.



In this section we will go over the connections and set up of the DVD unit.

Language Setup

The system of this DVD player is composed of Language, Picture, Audio, Lockup, and other functions. Press the key Setup to enter into the system interface. The first item is Language setting. To select the next item use the left or right arrow buttons.

- 1. Menu Language when the cursor is in the language menu, access the submenu by pressing the down key. Now you can select the language in the submenus one by one using the up or down key. Pressing the right key will decide the submenu. After entering the submenu the items are displayed on the screen. The menu can be switched into English, Chinese, and Japanese if it's available on the disc. Once you have made your decision press enter to confirm.
- 2. *Disc Audio* Enter the audio submenu of the disc and the following choices will be displayed.
 - A. Original disc will play in default mode.
 - B. English, Spanish, German, Italian, Portugal, Greek, French, Chinese When any of these items are selected audio will playback in this language if available on the disc. Audio will play back in original format if not available on the disc.
 - C. Other Languages When the cursor is at this item, you may key in 4 digits to enter an audio system of another country. The numbers keyed in will display from right to left. If a fifth number is keyed in the first four numbers will be deleted and the fifth on will be left on the screen. If there is no audio options available on the DVD playback will go to default.



- 3. Disc Text These are the following options available for the disc text.
 - A. Original disc will display text in default mode.
 - B. English, Spanish, German, Italian, Portugal, Greek, French, Chinese When any of these items are selected text will display in this language if available on the disc. Text will display in original format if not available on the disc.
 - C. Other Languages When the cursor is at this item, you may key in 4 digits to enter a text system of another country. The numbers keyed in will display from right to left. If a fifth number is keyed in the first four numbers will be deleted and the fifth on will be left on the screen. If there is no text options available on the DVD will be displayed at default.



Picture Setup

Select Picture in the main menu and press the down key to enter into the submenu. There are two options in this submenu TV Landscape (16:9) and TV output (NTSC).

Lockup Setup

Select Picture in the main menu and press the down key to enter into the submenu.

- 1. Grading Press setup to enter the main menu press key right arrow to go to lock up menu. Press down arrow and the cursor will move to the submenu, press the right arrow again. A bar for new password will appear, key in a four digit number and press enter, a password confirmation will display, type in the new password and press enter to confirm it. If they are not matched the password confirmation will remain open on the screen. If matched a lower grade option appears press up or down arrows to select grades, press enter to confirm. Use the left arrow key to exit.
- 2. *Password* Use down arrow to select password, press right arrow key to call out the password bar, input the original password and press confirm. Then you get a new password bar, input your new password and press enter, enter the password a second tie to confirm. Press left arrow to exit.
- 3. National Code Press right arrow key to select National Code menu. If password has been set up, input the password and open the national code page. (Please refer to appendix.)




Other Options

Enter the main menu to select other settings.

- A. Move BC cursor to the main menu, press the PBC setup. Move the cursor to open /close and enter. When it is open the Menu/PBC button on the remote control has the function of PBC fly backward. When the disc menu displays, you may select the chapter of songs or DVD markers. When it is closed, remote control PBC has no fly backward function, but is able to select chapters for playback.
- B. Auto Playback –move the cursor to the to submenu open, press enter to finish the setup. When this is open the player will playback when the operation is complete. When auto playback is closed the player will stop operation and not playback unless you press play.
- C. B.LE Select the B.LE submenu by pressing the arrow keys, B.LE is the extension. Setting the B.LE to open will make the image dark grey. Setting it to close will make the image standard grey.
- D. Reset will resume back to the factory settings.
- E. Screensaver Move the cursor to screen saver and press right arrow key and select open or close. Then press enter to finish the setting. When the screensaver is set to open the screen saver will run if the player has no disk and is idle for three minutes. If set to close the screen saver will not run at all.
- F. Memory Playback Select memory playback by using the arrows in the main menu and then press right arrow to move the cursor to the open position. Press the arrow up or down to move the cursor to the close position. Press enter to confirm and enter again to close the memory playback.




External Video and Audio connection

- 7. Video output




DVD Video/Audio external connections and display.

VCD/MP3/WMA/Audio CD. Press setup to enter into the main menu. Press Program to get to the program menu move the cursor and select chapters by using the up and down arrows. Press right arrow to ADD, once completed press enter and the selected chapters will be

added to the programming list. When there are chapters selected in the programming list you may delete one at a time or delete all. When completed press enter or play to playback your programmed chapters.




Photo Show (Applicable to JPEG's) – You can enjoy high quality images that are placed on a disc. Insert a photo disk and set the DVD player to Auto Playback.

When the cursor is at the JPG

file icon you will be able to preview the thumbnail on the right side. You may select pictures you want to view by moving the cursor with the up and down arrow keys. Press play/enter to begin the picture show. If a chapter list is available press enter to switch the playing path.

When the cursor is at presentation edition zone, "Presentation Projection" displays in the right corner of the screen. You have the ability to change the projecting speeds and functionality menu. SPEECL button. When the cursor is at the SPEECL button you can change the projecting speed by pressing the right and left arrows. They are classified by four levels Stand by, Slow, Medium, and Fast.



1. Power Supply

- If there is no power, please check the power cord connections.
- Check DVD player signal cables if the connection is sound or not.
- Replace the video cable if they are damaged.
- Make sure connection at the video input port on DVD Player is good.
- Make sure the power supply in normal.
- Make sure the selection of video input mode of TV SET is correct.

2. No Sound

- Check connection the DVD Player, TV Set or amplifier to see if it is connected.
- When connecting the DVD Player to amplifier, make sure the amplifier is open and setting is proper.
- If the audio cables are damaged, replace it with new ones.
- If DVD Player is set as standby or slow playback, press PLAY to resume normal Playback Mode.
- When DVD Player is fast forwarding or rewinding back, press PLAY to resume normal Playback Mode.
- If DVD Player is at state of System Setup, programming playback Menu, press system setup button and programming playback button to start programmed playback. Or you press PLAY to resume normal Playback Mode.
- Check if DVD Player is at mode of "MUTE", press "MUTE" to resume sound.
- Check if DVD Player is at mode of digital output "Closed"
- While DVD Player is playing back SVCD that has no sound track2 and SOUND 5.1 mode is selected, but there is no sound is playing, please activate the console menu, and select SOUND 5.1 and play back the SVCD.
- 3. No Stereo When Playing Back Video CD or CD.
 - Make sure all connections are proper
 - Make sure the sound track is set as "stereo playback".

- 4. Operation Remote Controller Unavailable
 - Clean or move the obstacle between remote controller and the player.
 - Close up to player to operate the remote controller.
 - Aim the remote controller at the sensor of remote controller
 - Re-install with new battery.

5. No Disk

- When "No Disk" display on screen, please put in the disk firstly.
- Make sure put the right side on the tray.
- · Clean the disk.
- If Player is moist, the right way is to take out the disk and meanwhile connecting with power for 30 minutes till the player do not have any humidity.
- Select program-operation, random play, repeat play, and select the correspond ing method to eliminate (Reference to the operation instruction foregoing).
- Title menu or DVD menu will appear on the screen automatically when playing DVD. Menu picture appears on the screen when play the video CD with PBC function.

6. Stop Display Automatically

• Some of disk recorded the pause signal; the player will stop to play in the point or segment.

7. Note

• The player should be cleaned after unplug, and weep cover. PBC board or controller with soft cloth with neutral detergent, other methods is prohibited.

8. Cautions

- Dew will coagulate on the glass in the unit under the following conditions *transfer the unit from warm place to cold place suddenly, or use the unit in a moist place.
- Use the unit in the room where the air-conditioner is turn on just now, or the unit face to the cool air of the air-conditioner.
- In hot summer, transfer the unit from the room with air condition to a moist and high-temperature. Player is unavailable if it has the dew, please take out the disk and connect the power, keep it there for 2 hours to vaporize the dew.
