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

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



INSTALLATION

POWER SUPPLY SETTING

- Check that the type plate on the rear of your player indicates the correct supply voltage.
- If your mains supply voltage is different, consult your dealer or our Service Organisation.

Certain versions of this player are equipped with a voltage selector (3), which enables you to set the player to the correct mains voltage yourself. When changing the voltage setting, it is also necessary to change the mains fuse to one of the correct rating: 200 mA (slow blow fuse) for 110/127 V and 100 mA (slow blow fuse) for 220/240 V.

CONNECTIONS (Fig. 1)

- 1 Mains fuse holder (not all versions) See 'Power supply setting'.
- 2 Mains socket
- Insert the plug of the mains lead (supplied) into the mains socket.
- Connect the other end to your mains supply.
- The mains supply is now switched on.
- 3 Voltage selector (not all versions) See 'Power supply setting'.

4 ANALOGUE OUTPUT

For the connecting cable to the amplifier.
