The Mazda Tribute is targeted at career-minded professionals in their late twenties to early thirties.





Key Feature:Dealer-Installed Accessories

Part of the joy of owning a new Mazda Tribute is personalizing it. And the best way to enhance its appearance or function is with Genuine Mazda Accessories. Here are guidelines for selling accessories:

Know what sells in your market

Accessory sales often vary from market to market, so it is important to know what sells in your market. Find out by talking with the people in your dealership's Parts Department.

Introduce accessories early in the conversation

Lay a foundation for later sales by mentioning the availability of accessories early in the conversation. Say something like, "As part of the full service that our dealership offers, we can help you to customize your new Tribute with a wide range of Genuine Mazda Accessories."

Listen for customer needs

During the sales conversation, listen and look for customer needs that could be met with accessories. For example, a customer who comments on the fine finish of the Mazda Tribute might be interested in protecting that finish with a car cover, front mask, or car care products. A customer with children may appreciate a cargo net, organizer, or tray or side step tubes. One with a dog might need a cargo divider.

Show customers how they can afford accessories

Accessory sales can be more successful when they are made as part of the overall purchase decision rather than added on to an already-agreed purchase price. Break down the total cost of an accessory into a per-month cost based on the length of vehicle loan or lease. Customers may be more willing to purchase a particular accessory when they see how few dollars per month the accessory would cost.

Like all Mazda cars and trucks, the Mazda Tribute has its own laminated accessory selling guides that list available accessories and shows photographs of many of those accessories. Use these guides to structure your sales conversation with customers.

Give each customer an accessory brochure

Each Mazda car and truck also has its own pocket-sized brochure with photographs and descriptions of the most popular Mazda accessories. Hand each Mazda Tribute customer a copy of the appropriate brochure during the sales conversation. That way, your customer can consider what to buy now and what to add on in the future.

Show accessories that are already installed

Customers often do not value certain accessories until they see them on a model that is similar to the one they wish to purchase. Display a Mazda Tribute with installed accessories and make a point of showing it to your customers.

Build value with Genuine Mazda Accessories

Engineered specifically for Mazda vehicles and manufactured to Mazda's highest quality standards for a precise fit, Genuine Mazda Accessories are available with the same 48-month/50,000-mile new vehicle limited warranty. Refer to the Mazda Parts & Accessory Limited Warranty brochure for details.

- 1. Driver's Side
- 2. Front End
- 3. Interior

- 4. Trunk/Rear Area
- 5. MSRP Window Sticker

Use these guides to help build an organized and focused product presentation on the features and benefits that appeal most to vour Mazda Tribute customer. This may mean that you do not cover all five points of a walkaround presentation, or that you cover them in a different order from that found in the Purchase Motivation Walkaround Guide.



When a customer offers an objection or challenges you with competitive information, you can revive many sales with the CPR method—Clarify, Paraphrase, and Respond.

First, ask questions to clarify the customer's specific concern. Next, paraphrase the concern to show that you understand. Then, respond by focusing on relevant features and benefits of the Mazda Tribute.

For example...

Customer: I'm leaning toward the Hyundai Santa Fe.

Consultant: What is it about the Santa Fe that you like?

Customer: Hyundai says they have "America's Best Warranty" and I don't want to be without my vehicle.

Consultant: So dependability and convenience are very important to you.

Customer: Yes, they are.

Consultant: While the 60-month/60,000-mile basic warranty of the Korean-made Santa Fe provides some

additional coverage over the 48-month/50,000-mile basic warranty of the Tribute, both the Tribute and its cousin the Ford Escape are built at Ford's Kansas City Assembly Plant. No other manufacturer has as much experience at building SUVs as Ford. And the Mazda Tribute comes

with a free loaner vehicle during warranty service.

The Ford Escape is available in three trim levels:


Link customer comments and emotions with vehicle engineering.

Mazda Test Drive Experience

Stage 1: Warm-Up

Warm-Up ensures that vehicles are ready for test drives any time a customer is ready.

- ☐ Have the keys readily accessible
- ☐ Ensure the vehicle is clean inside and out
- ☐ Check the fuel level
- ☐ Measure the tire pressure for optimal driving experience
- ☐ Position the vehicle facing out, signaling ready to go
- ☐ Check road and traffic conditions for your test drive route



Stage 2: Visioning

Visioning sets expectations for what the customer will notice and feel while driving a Mazda.

You are painting a mental picture of the experience. By doing this, you focus the customer's attention on the details that promote an emotional connection between car and driver.



There are three steps in visioning: introduction, communication, and invitation.

Introduction

- Differentiate the Mazda Test Drive Experience from other demonstration drives
- Provide an overview of the experience, that is, its duration and objective
- State that all Mazda vehicles are designed to be sporty and energetic

Communication

- State how a Mazda communicates directly with the driver through the steering wheel, pedals, and seat of the pants
- · Review the test drive route using the corresponding map

Invitation

• Invite the customer to go on the test drive

Stage 3: Experience It


Experience It allows the customer to make an emotional connection with the vehicle and truly feel the Mazda.


Drive It

- 7. Rough and uneven roads






Own It

With each element, key questions to ask customers can help them evaluate their driving experience.

The Sales Consultant drives first to demonstrate the assertive (but not aggressive) desired driving technique. The customer then takes over at a designated point on your Mazda Test Drive Experience route.



Freeway On-Ramp

Drive It (What You'll Say)

Enter the ramp and accelerate to freeway speeds. Merge into traffic.

Feel It (Driving Dynamics They'll Feel) Acceleration

- · Does the gas pedal feel firm when you push on it?
- Do you feel that the acceleration is responsive in proportion to the amount of pressure you apply?

Drive It (What You'll Say)

Now that you're driving at freeway speed, try changing lanes.

Feel It (Driving Dynamics They'll Feel)



- Does the engine respond in proportion to the amount of effort you apply?
- Does the body feel rigid and firm when changing lanes?
- Do you feel a sense of stability and control?

Steering Handling

- Does the steering feel weighty and firm?
- Does the vehicle react precisely to your steering inputs?
- Does the vehicle react as if it were an extension of your body?




Pay attention to how the steering wheel feels on these curves.

- Does it feel "sporty" to you?

While exiting, slow to a complete stop from freeway speeds.

Feel It (Driving Dynamics They'll Feel)

Braking Handling

- Are the brakes quick and do they give you precise control when slowing down the vehicle?
- Is the vehicle stable when you stop or do you feel a nosedive?

Drive It (What You'll Say)

On surface streets with frequent stop signs and traffic lights, you'll experience Mazda's braking and acceleration.

Feel It (Driving Dynamics They'll Feel)



- When maintaining a safe distance from cars in front of you, do the brakes and acceleration feel precise?

Feel It (Driving Dynamics They'll Feel)

Ride Steering

- Is the ride firm or is it sloppy?
- Does the vehicle feel like it's firmly planted and connected to the road?
- Does the steering hold steady or does it sway with the bumps?

Stage 4: Reinforce It

Reinforce It occurs after the test drive and links customer comments and emotions with vehicle engineering.

Maintain emotional engagement


- · Remember that people justify decisions with fact, but they buy on emotion
- Reinforce the emotions lived during the test drive

Build on the test drive

- Determine which driving dynamics the customer connected with best
- Identify the engineering principles supporting that driving dynamic
- Make the connection for the customer between inspired engineering and driving dynamics

Bring it full circle

• Make the connection between always the soul of a sports car, inspired engineering, superior driving dynamics, and exhilarating experience



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
