

2. Intended Use of Product



- For indoor use only, this product is not designed for hospital/ medical use.
- Use the product only for its intended use described in the manual.
- Recommended for: Cold hands in winter time.

3. Safety Instruction

All below information serves to protect health of user and the health of other person. Also protects the product from any damage while using.



- Do not operate the product with wet hands.
- Do not use in or around water.
- Do not place or store this product where it might fall into a tub, sink, or toilet.
- Do not reach for product that has fallen into water. Unplug immediately.
- Do not damage, break, rework, bend forcibly, pull or bundle the power cord. Protect it from being placed under heavy objects or caught between objects while moving the product. A damaged cord may lead to fire or electric shock.

- Do not pull USB cable to unplug this product to avoid wire damage.
 Make sure to grasp the USB plug.
- Avoid dropping this product, as it is not shock resistant.
- Avoid contact with sharp edges or pointed objects, which might cut or puncture the fabric.
- Choking hazard!! Please keep this product out of reach of children or babies.
- Close supervision is necessary when this appliance is used by, on or near children or those with limited dexterity or mobility.

5. Scope of Delivery (Accessories)

- ▶ A pair of warming gloves with carbon fiber heating elements
- ▶ USB cable connecter for indoor use, cable length 160 cm
- User's manual



AC 110V-230V to DC 5V, 2A USB adapter is not included.

6. Appliance Description & Operation



- 1. Connect the USB Cable to the gloves and insert the cable into USB port on laptop, PC or proper AC110V-230V to DC 5V, 2A USB adapter (not part of scope of delivery) the gloves will automatically warm up.
- 2. Put your hands inside.
- 3. Disconnect the USB cable to turn off.



Remove any other accessories (e.g. rings or bracelets) from your fingers or wrist.



Please do not wrap power cord around the product. Do not hang the product by power cord.

9. Care & Storage Instruction



- In the unlikely event of product malfunction, turn off power and stop using immediately. Please contact the local dealer for repair. Any tampering voids warranty.
- Unplug the USB and allow the unit to cool before cleaning.
- Do not use abrasive or chemical cleaners.
- Gloves are not washable, only surface wipe (clean water only) with damp cloth, and only use the gloves when it is completely dry.
- Let the product cool down completely before folding and storage.
- Do not fold it too tight.
- Store the product in its box or a clean and dry place.
- Keep the product out of reach and sight of children.
- Keep this product and its USB cable away from heat, moisture, and direct sunlight.

10. Disposal
