

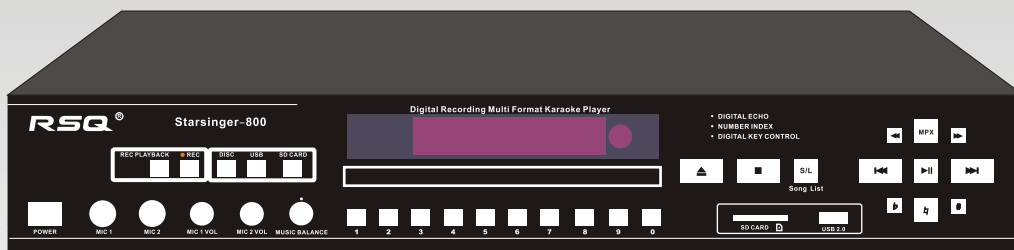

14. Grounding and Polarization

This product is equipped with a polarized alternating-current line plug (a plug having one blade wider than the other). This plug will fit into the power outlet only one way. This is a safety feature. If you are unable to insert the plug fully into the outlet, try reversing the plug. If the plug should still fail to fit, contact your electrician to replace your obsolete outlet. Do not defeat the safety purpose of the polarized plug.

15. Power Lines

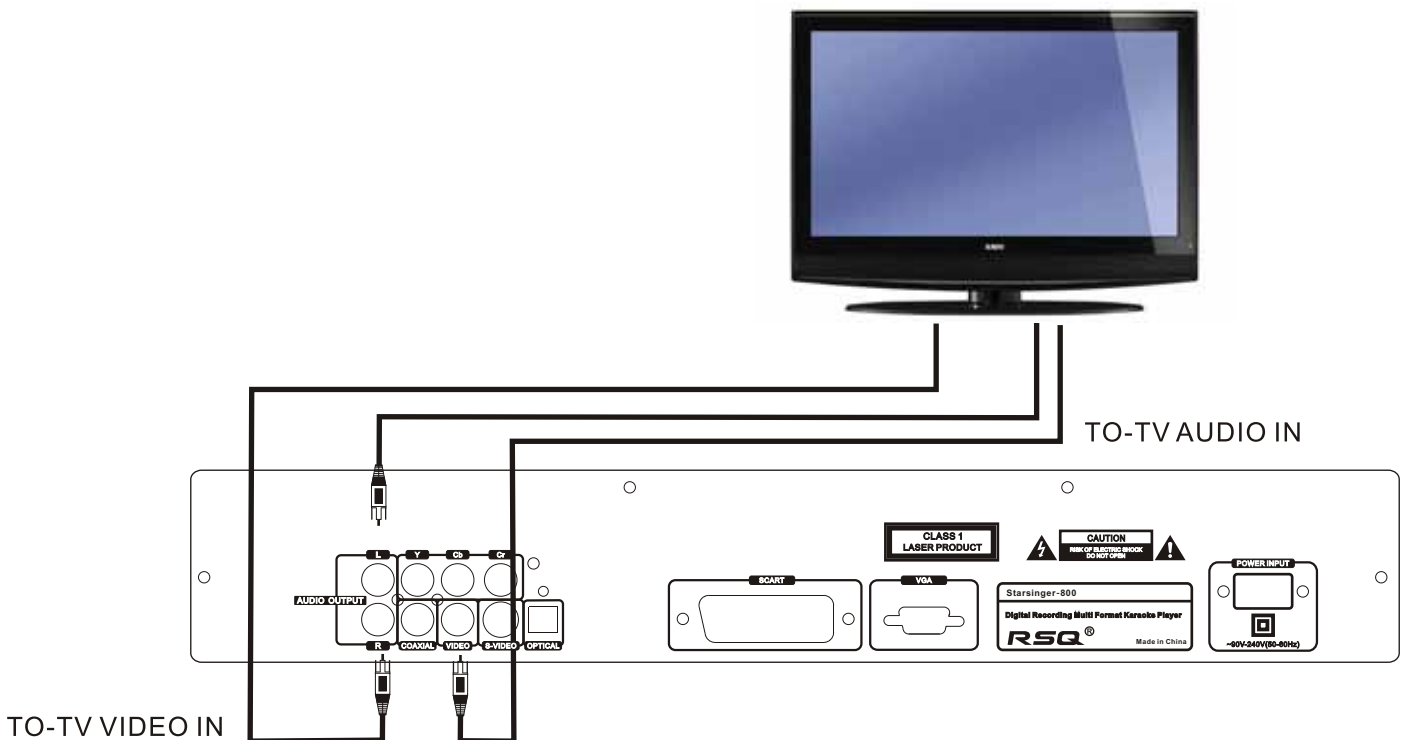
NOTE: Check applicable voltage (110V/240V).

Unplug the power cord if stop using for a long time.

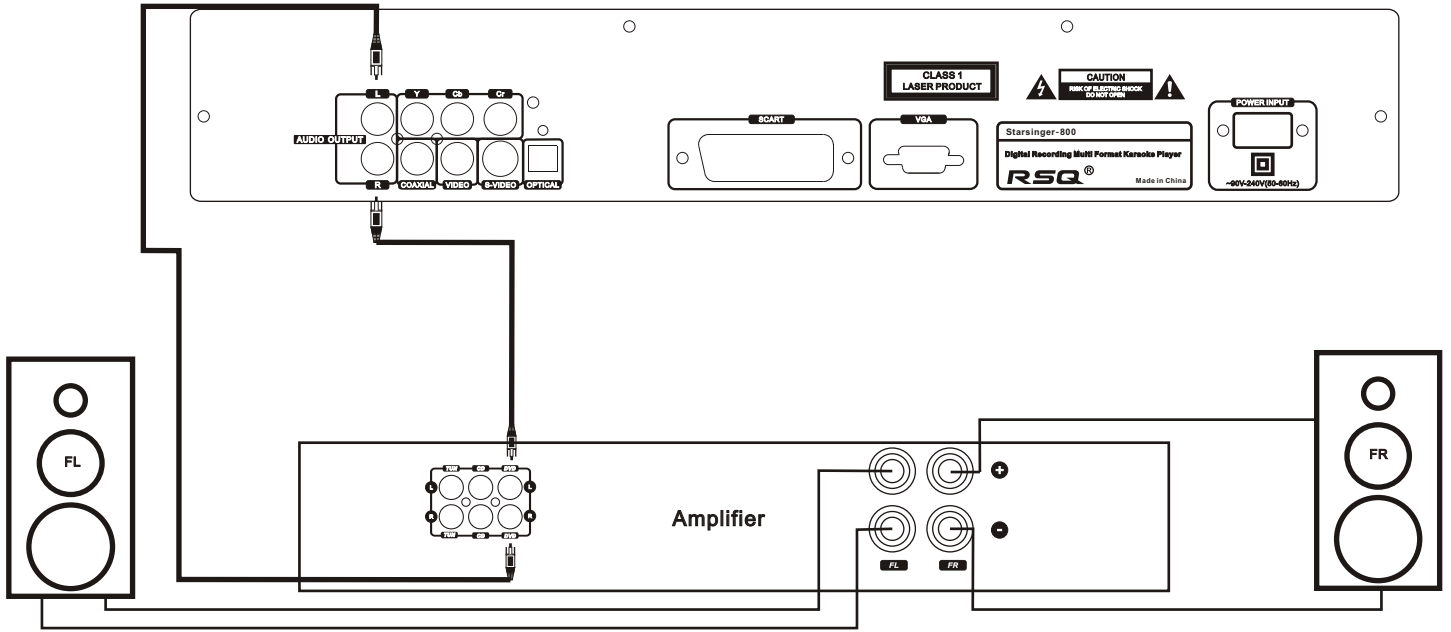


Audio and Video Output To TV

Connect cable plug (yellow end) to the VIDEO OUTPUT jack on the player, connect the other end of the cable to VIDEO IN jack on the TV.
Connect a pair of cable plugs (red end and white end) to the AUDIO OUTPUT jacks (ML, MR) on the player, plug the other set to the AUDIO IN jack on the TV.

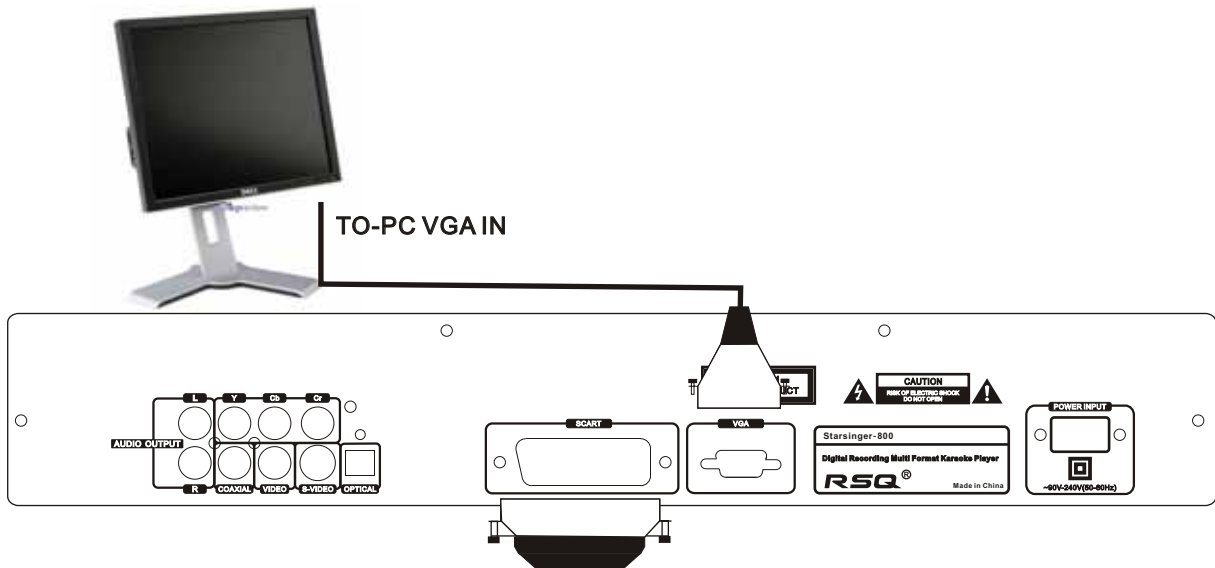

VGA Connection

Use a VGA cable to connect the VGA jack on the player and your TV/MONITOR. You will get a better picture from this progressive scan function.



SCART Connection

This is for TV with SCART jack. You need a scart cable and you will get audio and video output. Connect one end of cable to the SCART OUTPUT jack on the player. Plug the other end of cable to the SCART IN jack on the TV. The TV should be set in SCART mode.

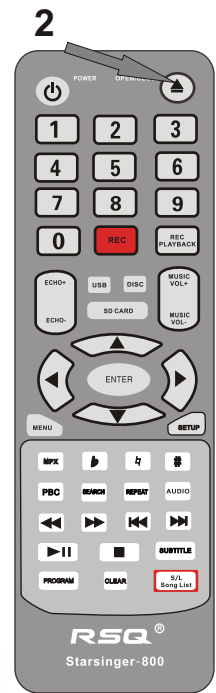
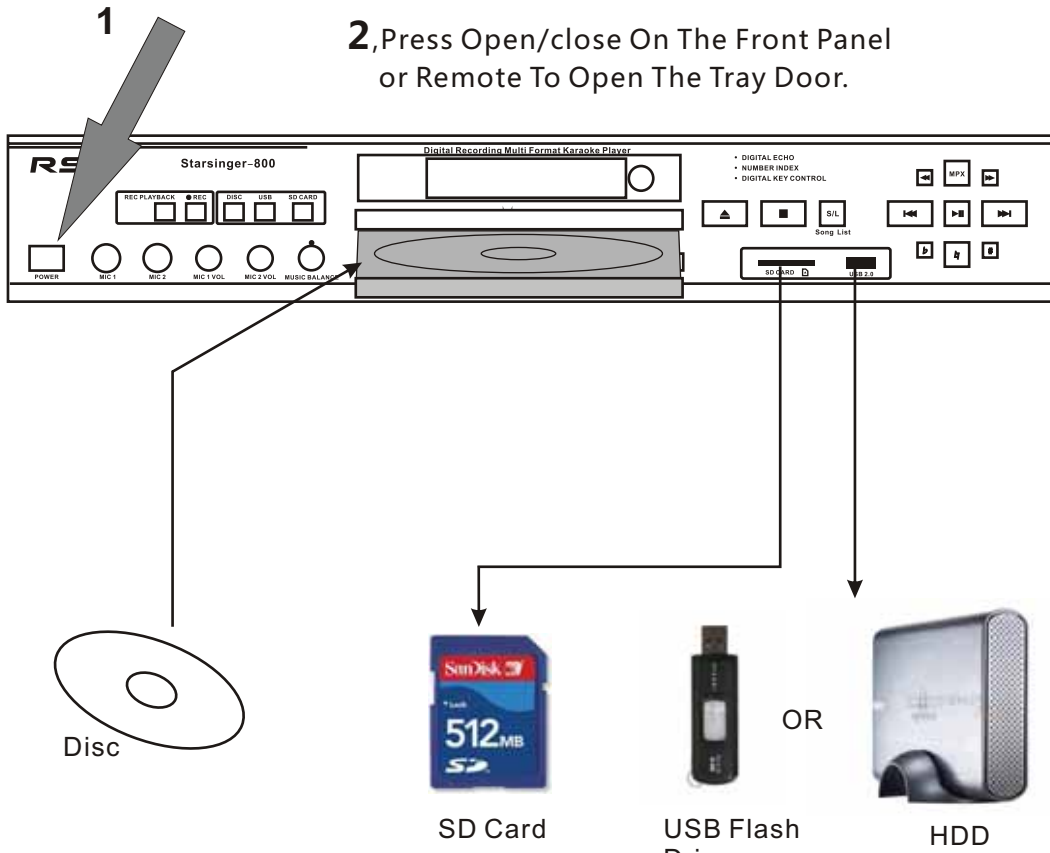

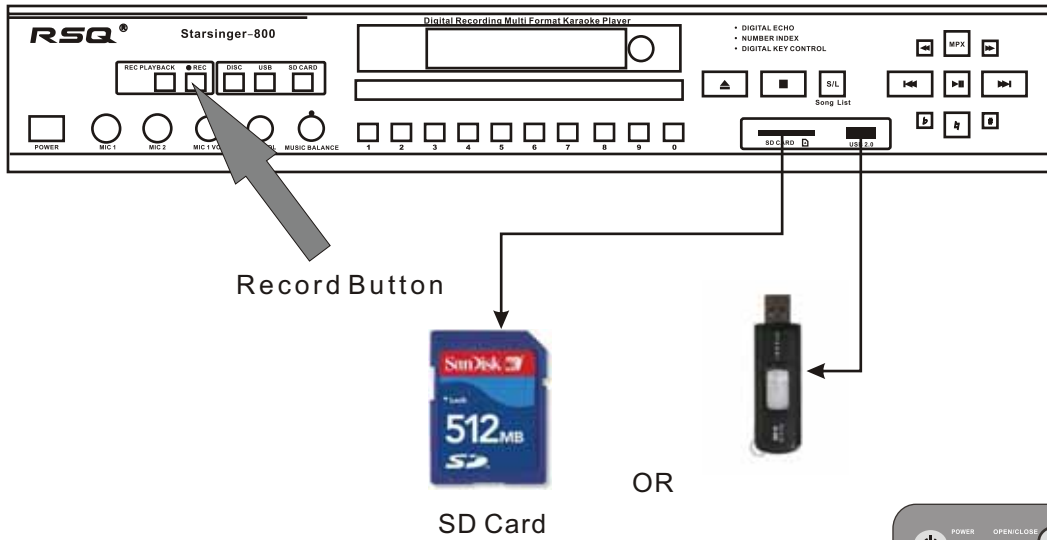
If you want to burn a CD, go to Record folder in USB drive or SD card to get your recorded performances.

- 1, When SD card and USB Flash Drive are inserted in the player at the same time, the recorded file will be saved in to USB Flash Drive other than SD card.
- 2, Recording feature works for CD+G/MP3+G/VCD /CD/MP3 format disc only.
- 3, Singer's vocals can be recorded when the player is playing disc.

Program



Step 1

Press PROGRAM on the remote control, the program menu appears on the TV screen.

Step 2

Use the navigation BUTTONS to select track NUMBER for VCD/CD/CDG and press ENTER BUTTON, the track NUMBER is added in the program play list.

Step 3

Repeat the above steps to add more tracks NUMBER in the program list.

Step 4

Press PLAY/PAUSE or highlight the PLAY on the screen and press ENTER BUTTON to start programmed playback. Programmed Play automatically stops at the end of the last programmed track. Highlight the CLEAR on screen and press CLEAR BUTTON to delete the last track NUMBER in the program list.

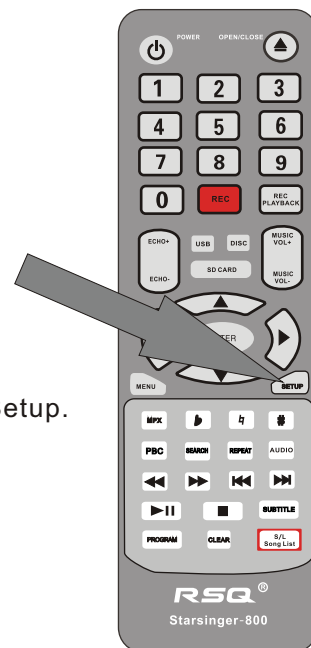
NOTE: In playing back the VCD with PBC, you cannot set Program playback. The program WILL BE cancelled when you open disc tray or turn OFF power.

- 2, Highlight Restore And Press Enter Button To Restore Default Setup.



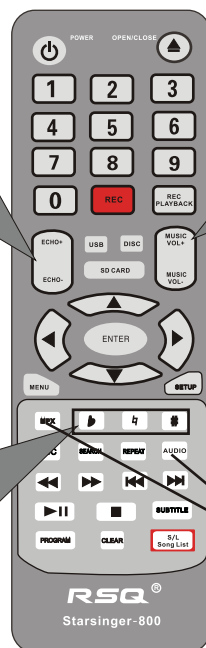

Echo Control

Echo is what makes the vocals on records and on the radio have that professional sound. It's a very popular effect with singers. It gives the vocals a very ambient quality. A little Echo is definitely a great effect on most vocals, but not necessary for all occasions.

Music Volume Up & Down

To adjust the volume of all music.



Digital Key Control

It works only under karaoke mode to adjust total 14 steps key level of music. Press # button to raise key and press b button to lower and press h to reset.

A Digital Key Controller allows the singer to transpose the Karaoke Music into their desired key without effecting the tempo.

L/R and AUDIO Tracks

Selects Left/Right, Mono, And Stereo Audio Output For Audio Tracks. If You Want To Cancel Original Vocals, Select Left Or Right Audio Output.
