- Refer to the drawing, take the back cover of the remote control off and remove the empty battery receptacle.
- Prior to shipping, a separating film was applied to the battery. Remove this film.
- Insert the battery into the receptacle and insert the receptacle into the remote.
- For the best results, aim the remote towards at the player, sreceiving window. Stay within 15 feet and angles of 60 degrees or less.
- Under normal use the battery will last for one year.
- Remove battery during storage or when you are not using the DVD player for a long time.

Digital Teletext

If the program you are watching broadcasts digital teletext, the DVB-T player can display teletext. The content of digital teletext varies according to the program provider. It could be pictures and sound for the program, pages of information on the programs, the weather, the news or other options.

Press (Teletext) < Teletext> button, the teletext window appear on the screen.

Favorite PR (Favorite Program)

There are some channels that you tend to watch more often and some only occasionally. Favorite PR allows the most-watched channels to access more easily, leaving less watched channels acces-sible but out of way.

Press FAV < Favorite PR>

Fav on appears on the screen, and the favorite program is activated; by pressing PRO+ button / PRO- button, you can only step through the favorite programs. Other programs can still be accessed by entering the program number.

If you press^(lust ok) <List ok> button after the favorite program is activated, TV Favorite List will appear on the screen.

*To exitfrom Favorite Program

---Press (FAV) < Favorite PR-button until Fav off appears on the screen.

Music mode

The DVB-T player provides you the convenient function to listen to the digital radio.

1 Press (Rodio) <TV/Radio> button to switch between TV channel and Music channel.

Handling the unit

When shipping the unit

Please save the original shipping carton and packing materials. If you need to ship the unit, for maximum protection, re-pack the unit as it was originally packed at the factory.

Keeping the exterior surfaces clean

Do not use volatile liquids such as insecticide spray near the unit. Do not leave rubber or plastic products in contact with the unit for a long period of time. since they leave marks on the surface.

Cleaning the unit

Toclean the player, use a soft, dry cloth. If the surfaces are extremely dirty, use a soft cloth lightly moistened with a mild detergent solution.

Do not use strong solvents such as alcohol, benzine, or thinner, as these might damage the surface of the Unit.

Troubleshooting tips(Common)

Before calling for service, you can check the following items on symptoms and solutions

No sound or distorted sound:

Ensure that the equipment is connected properly. Ensure that the input settings for the TV and stereo system are proper.

No picture:

Ensure that the equipment is connected properly. Ensure that the input setting for the TV is "video". Ensure that the LCD is on.

No remote control:

Check the batteries are installed with the correct polarities(+&-). The batteries are depleted: replace them with new ones. Point the remote control unit at the remote control sensor and operate.

Remove the obstacles between the remote control unit and the remote control sensor.

Operate the remote control unit at a distance of not more than 8 meters from the remote control sensor.

No key operation(by the unit and/or the remote control) is effective:

Turn the unit off and then back to on. Alternatively, turn off the unit, disconnect the AC power cord and the re-connect it. (The player may not be operating properly due to lightning, static electricity or some other external factor.)

Battery does not work

check whether the battery is out of power or in proper connection.
