

USB to Parallel Adapter



Setting Up the Printer Device

Follow the steps below to configure your printer to the USB to Parallel Bi-Directional Cable for communication with your computer.

For an Installed Printer

- If you have already installed a printer device before, click Start > Settings > Printers (and Faxes). Right-click the printer that is connected using your parallel cable and click on Properties. The Properties dialog box of the installed printer will appear on your screen.
- Click the Ports or Details tab and change the printer port to LPT2: (USB to Parallel Port) or USB001 (Virtual Printer port for USB).



For a New Printer

- If you do not have a printer installed yet, click on Start > Settings > Printers (and Faxes) > Add a printer. The Add Printer Wizard will start and assist you in installing a new printer device. Follow the on-screen prompts to proceed.
- When prompted which port the printer will use, click LPT2: (USB to Parallel Port) or USB001 (Virtual Printer port for USB).



3. Follow the succeeding instructions to complete the installation and also run **Print Test Page** to see if it can print without problem.
