

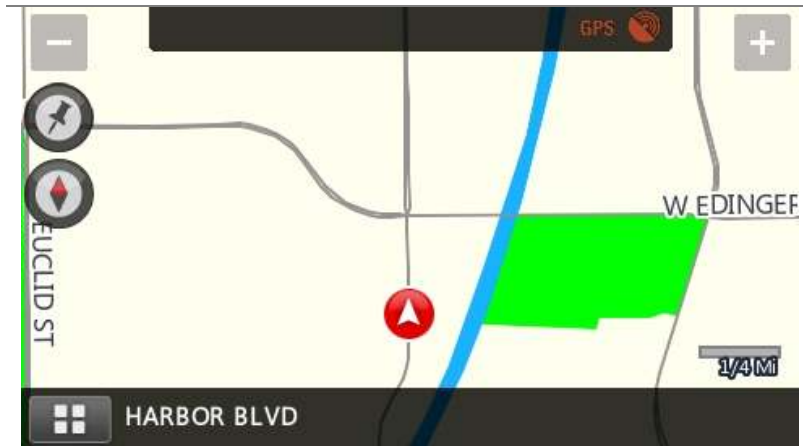

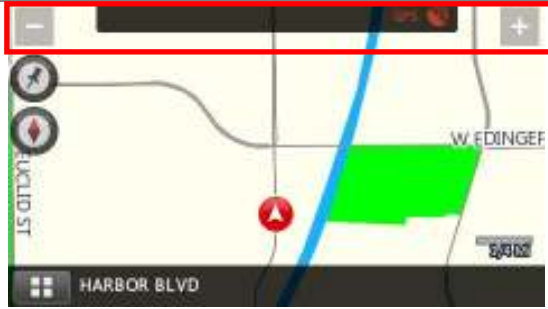

MY POINT

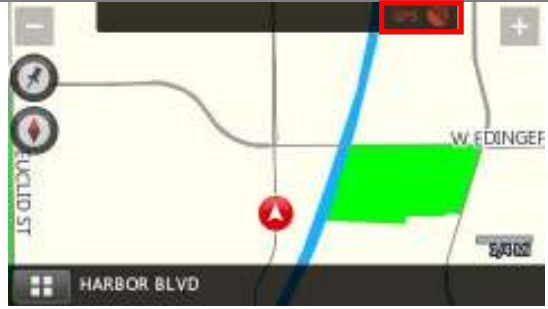
