


- 1. This appliance is for outdoor use only, and shall NOT be used in a building, garage, or any other endosed area.
- 2. Do NOT use this outdoor re pitfor indoor heating.TOXIC carbon monoxide fumes can accumulate and cause asphyxiation.
- 3. This outdoor repitis NOT for commercial use.
- 4. This outdoor repitis NOT to be operated by children.
- 5. This outdoor repit is NOT to be used in or on boats or recreational
- 6. Always use in accordance with all applicable local, state and national codes. Contact your local re department for details on outdoor
- 7. When using this outdoor repit, exercise the same precautions you would with any open re.
- 8. The use of alcohol, prescription or non-prescription drugs may impair the consumers ability to properly assemble or safely operate this outdoor re pit.
- 9. Do NOT use this outdoor re pitwithout reading the entire "Owners
- 10. This outdoor repitis for use with dry, seasoned hardwood. It will burn hotter, more completely and create less smoke.
- 11. Do NOT burncharcoal briquets, lump charcoal, manufactured logs, driftwood, trash, leaves, paper, cardboard, plywood, painted or stained or pressure treated wood. Avoid using soft woods such as pineor cedar that can throw sparks.
- 12. Do NOT alter this outdoor repitin any manner
- 13. Do NOT use this outdoor repituntil it is COMPLETELY assembled and all parts are securely fastened and tightened.
- 14. Do NOT store or use gasoline or other ammable vapors or liquids in the vicinity of this or any other appliance.
- 15. Do NOT store or use an LP gas cylinder within 10 feet (3.05 m) of this outdoor re pitwhile it is in operation.
- 16. Do NOT use this outdoor repit near automobiles, trucks, vans or recreational vehicles.
- 17. Do NOT use in an explosive atmosphere. Keep outdoor re pit area clear and free from combustible materials, gasoline and other ammable liquids.
- 18. Do NOT use this outdoor re pitunder any overhead or near any unprotected combustible constructions. Avoid using near or under overhanging trees and shrubs.
- 19. Always empty this outdoor repit before each use. Leave a thin layer of ash to protect the bottom.


- 20. Do NOT wear ammable or loose clothing when operating this
- 21. Do NOT use in windy conditions.
- 22. Do NOT use this outdoor re pitunless spark guards are securely
- 23. Do NOT use gasoline, kerosene, diesel fuel, lighter uid or alcohol to lightor relight res.
- 24. Keep all electrical cords awayfrom a hot re pit.
- 25. All surfaces of this outdoor repitare hot when in operation. To avoid burns, do NOT touch re pit until it has completely cooled unless you are wearing protective gear (Potholders, gloves, BBQ mittens, hot pads & etc.). Never touch ashes or coals to see if they are hot.
- 26. Do NOT leave a lit outdoor re pitunattended especially around children and pets.
- 27. Do NOT attempt to move or store this outdoor re pituntil all ashes and coals are completely extinguished.
- 28. Do NOT remove ashes or coals until they are completely and fully extinguished.
- 29. Use heat-resistant gloves or hot pads when contacting handles.
- 30. Use long, sturdy repittools when adding or moving logs.
- 31. Do NOT place wood directly into bottom of the outdoor repit. Place wood only on the wood grid.
- 32. Do NOT overload the repit. Do not add additional rewood until the reburns down. NOTICE: If any portion of the bowl, lid or spark guard of this outdoor repitare glowing red it is overloaded.
- 33. Do NOT lean over this outdoor repitwhen lighting or when in use.
- 34. Do NOT place a hot spark guardor hot repittools onto combustible surfaces such as grass, deck or furniture.
- 35. Avoid breathing smoke from the reand avoid getting it into your eyes.
- 36. This outdoor repitshould be thoroughly inspected and cleaned on a regular basis.
- 37. After a period of storage and/or non-use, check for signs of damage and creosote build-up. Do NOT operate until necessary repairs and/or clean up are executed.
- 38. Death, serious injury or damage to property may occur if the above is not followed exactly

CAUTION: It is not recommended to use this fire pit (fire place) on a wooden or other combustible surface or any surface that is not entirely resistant to high heat. However, if you intend to use this item on a wooden deck other combustible surface or any surface that is not entirely resistant to high heat, you must use a non-flammable and heat resistant material such as concrete pavers, brick or stone between the fire pit (fire place) and the surface.




Assembly Instructions

For Easiest Assembly:


- To avoid losing any small components or hardware, assemble your product on a hard level surface that does not have cracks or openings.
- Clear an area large enough to layout all components and hardware.
- When applicable, tighten all hardware connections by hand first. Once the step is completed go back and fully tighten all hardware.
- Follow all steps in order to properly assemble your product.

Assemble legs Attach legs to hearth using 16 sets of hex screws (B) and lock washers (E).




Attach bowl support

Attach bowl support to legs using 4 hex screws (B).




Assemble bottom bowl

Attach ash receiver to bottom bowl using 3 sets of screw (A) and small nut (C).




Insert bottom bowl

Insert bottom bowl onto bowl support.



Step Insert wood grate

Insert wood grate into bottom bowl.




Assemble spark arrestor

Attach the handle to spark arrestor using large nut (D).

Step Place spark arrestor

A. Place spark arrestor onto bottom bowl.

B. Use fire tool to remove and replace spark arrestor.




Outdoor Fire Pit Fire Seven

Operating Instructions



WARNING

FOR YOUR SAFETY

Before using this outdoor fire pit, make sure you have read, understand and are following all information provided in the Important Safeguards presented on page 1. Failure to follow those instructions can cause death, serious injury or property damage.

Lighting

- 1. Make sure there is only a small amount of ash in the bottom of the bowl.
- 2. Place a layer of dry kindling or a natural firestarter such as Fatwood™ onto the center of
- 3. Place above that a layer of dry seasoned hardwood that is cut to lengths no more than 3/4 the diameter of the bowl
- 4. Use a match to light kindling or firestarter.
- 5. Replace spark arrestor by using the fire tool once the kindling or firestarter is lit.

Tending the Fire

You may need to shift and/or add logs for an ideal experience.

Reminders:

- · Always wear protective gloves or a pot holder when tending a fire.
- Wait until glowing coals have developed before adding any additional wood.
- · Do NOT add gasoline, kerosene, diesel fuel, lighter fluid or alcohol to relight or enhance an existing fire.
- 1. Carefully remove spark arrestor by using the fire tool.
- 2. While using a long handled fireplace tool, shift coals and logs to allow additional airflow.
- 3. If additional wood is required, place wood on top coals. Be careful not to shift ashes.
- 4. Replace spark arrestor by using the fire tool.

Extinguishing

- 1. Allow fire to burn itself out.
- 2. Do NOT use water to extinguish as this is dangerous and can cause damage to this outdoor fire pit.

Cleaning & Care

Inspecting

This outdoor fire pit should be inspected on a regular basis to ensure product safety and

Do NOT attempt to inspect this outdoor fire pit until the fire is COMPLETELY out.

- 1. Check handles to make sure they are secure.
- 2. Check components for any signs of damage or rust.
- 3. If damage to any component is detected, do NOT operate until repairs are executed.

Cleaning

This outdoor fire pit should be cleaned on a regular basis to promote safer experiences and longer product life.

Note: After repeated use, a slight discoloration of the finish may occur.

Do NOT attempt to clean this outdoor fire pit until the fire is COMPLETELY out.

Do NOT use oven cleaner or abrasive cleaners as they will damage this product.

Do NOT clean any part of this outdoor fire pit in a self cleaning oven as it may

- 1. Wipe exterior surfaces with a mild dishwashing detergent or baking soda.
- 2. For stubborn surfaces use a citrus based degreaser and a nylon scrubbing brush.
- 4. Remove built-up creosote from components with a chimney cleaning product.

Storage

Do NOT move or store this outdoor fire pit until the fire is COMPLETELY out.

- 1. Once the fire is out, coals are cold and outdoor fire pit is cool to the touch, remove ashes and properly dispose.
- 2. Cover outdoor fireplace with a durable vinyl cover designed to fit this unit.
- 3. Store assembled in a location away from children and pets.

Note: If you do not use a cover, store this outdoor fire pit in a dry location to maximize product life.
