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1.5 Esquema del QTA Tracer System

El Sistema QTA Tracer consiste de un ordenador con la aplicación QTA Tracer System instalado, un transmisor Bluetooth 4.0, un escaner de código de barras y QTA Tracers. Para la funcionalidad completa del sistema también se incluye Nodos QTA Check-in, QTA Readers y el Portal de WEB QTA .




Figura 1 El Sistema QTA Tracer

1.6 Funcionalidad del nodo QTA Check-in

El propósito del nodo QTA Check-in es leer la información (usando una conexión Bluetooth de baja energía) de todos los QTA Tracers en el área y subir la información al QTA Web Portal. Esta información se usa en el portal para mostrar el estado de la bolsa de sangre y donde esta ubicado el QTA Tracer.

Visite Apple App Store para descargar e instalar la aplicación gratuita "QTA Check-in"





3 Funcionalidad

Registrar el Nodo QTA Check-in (Sólo para administradores de sistema)

Para registrar el Nodo QTA Check-in siga los siguientes pasos:

- 1. En el iPad pulse "Settings"
- 2. Seleccione "QTA Check-in Node"
- Asegurese de que" Server location" es correcto (http://www.qtatracersystem.com)
- 4. Copie CIN UUID(si el campo está vacio, abra primeramente la aplicación Checkin en el iPad)




Figura 1 QTA Check-in Node - Configuración

- 6. Copie el CIN UUID a la ventana de "Node unique id"
- 7. Pulsar el botón "Search and Edit"

8. Rellene la ventana. Asegurese de que la descripción y localización sea fácilmente reconocidos en el Portal.





Figure 2 QTA Web Portal – Ventana de nodo

3.2 Operación



En el iPad pulse el icono

La aplicación tiene que estar visible en pantalla para funcionar. No puede operar en segundo plano u ocultado.



Información presentada en el nodo Check-in:

- Identidad del Tracer
- Nivel de batería
- Tiempo desde que se registro el trazador
- Estado de subida de datos al portal







- Estado de la sangre
- Dado de baja de cuarantena

La información es subida automáticamente al Portal del web donde se mostrará la fecha de caducidad y localización del nodo – junto con la información arriba de la bolsa sanguínea.
