USER'S MANUAL

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IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTION

Please read following information carefully before starting your operation!

- Please turn off power before changing connections between this unit and other related equipments (e.g. TV).
 - Do not unplug signal and AV cables when the unit is on.
 - Please unplug power cord from power outlet when the unit is not in use for a long time.
 - When suddenly move the unit from a hot environment to a cold environment, or vice versa, turn off power and turn it on after 1 to 2 hours.
 - Keep the unit away from rain or any other liquid. Object with liquid inside should not be
 placed on top of the unit. If there is liquid flowing into the unit, pull out power cord
 immediately to avoid fire or electric shock.
 - Do not cover ventilation holes with newspaper, tablecloth, curtain or other items in order to ensure good ventilation.
 - Do not put any heavy object on top of the unit.
 - Please disconnect power cord from power outlet before cleaning the unit. Gently wipe the outer surface with a dry cloth. Do not let liquids, aerosols, etc. flow into the unit and cause serious damage.

Installation environment

- Good ventilation (keep more than 10cm spacing around the unit)
- No heat-producing object or device nearby (e.g. candle, radiator, heater, stove, amplifier)
- Moderate temperature
- No high humidity (e.g. bathroom, kitchen room)
- No direct sunlight
- No strong vibration

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Notes for power outlet and power cord

- Make sure power outlet is near the unit and well-grounded.
- Do not touch power cord with wet hands.
- In order to avoid fire or electric shock caused by short circuit, which may endanger personal safety or property damage, do not use a damaged power cord, and please contact your local operator for replacement.

Instructions on remote control unit and battery

- Put batteries into the battery compartment with polarity consistent with polarity symbols identified inside the battery compartment.
- If the unit is not in use for a long time, please remove batteries to avoid battery leakage, which may corrode components inside remote control unit.
- Replace batteries if there is no enough power. Do not discard waste batteries carelessly and pollute environment.

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


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




Install digital TV smart card and CI module

- ② Insert the CI module into the slot horizontally.





Digital TV smart card and CI module are provided by your Connect ANT IN port on the receiver to terrestrial antenna






A. Connect HDMI port on the receiver to HDMI port on T with an HDMI cable.

Note: Make sure your TV is set to HDMI input mode.




B. Connect VIDEO/R-AUDIO/L-AUDIO ports on the receiver to corresponding ports on TV with an AV cable.


Note: Make sure your TV is set to AV input mode.




C. Connect RF OUT port on the receiver to corresponding port on TV with an RF cable.

- Make sure your TV is set to TV input mode.
- You can also connect RF IN port on the receiver to analog signal source with an RF cable to input analog signal.






If you need to connect audio equipment, connect R-AUDIO/L-AUDIO ports on the receiver to corresponding ports on audio equipment with an audio cable, or connect S/P DIF port on the receiver to corresponding port on audio equipment with an S/P DIF cable, or connect D-AUDIO port on the receiver to corresponding port on audio equipment with a D-Audio cable. If you need to loop output RF signal to another receiver, please connect LOOP OUT port on the receiver to ANT IN port on another receiver with an RF cable.

MENU OPERATION GUIDE

- Please press MENU key to display main menu whenever you want to use menu system. In the main menu, press ← > keys to select a sub-menu, press ♦ ♦ keys to select an item and press → key to enter or press ◆ heys to switch options.
- The default system password is "oooooo", which you should remember after modification.
- Shortcut keys are more useful when you watch programs, and their meanings are indicated on remote control unit.

1. Program

Program Edit: You can lock channels. System password is required to watch programs of these channels. In addition, you can move, skip, delete and rename channels, and set favorite channels. You can easily select favorite channels in favorite channel list.

EPG: You can browse program information in a week and schedule to play or record future programs. All the schedules are displayed in schedule window. You can add, edit and delete schedules.

Note: System will remind you near the airtime of the scheduled programs. Sort: You can set channel sort mode.

LCN: You can switch on/off LCN.

2. Picture

Aspect Ratio/Resolution/TV Format: You can view and modify aspect ratio/resolution/TV format

RF Setting: If TV is connected to your receiver with RF cable, please set RF audio mode and RF channel.

3. Channel Search

Auto Search: You can search channels automatically without more operation. **Manual Search:** You can search channels by specifying frequency channel. **Country:** Before searching, please select your country of residence.

Antenna Power: You can enable antenna power if an external active antenna is

Notes:

- If you are not sure about parameter values, you can search channels according to defaults.
- Do not turn off the receiver during searching.

4. Time

Time Offset: You can set GMT offset adjustment method.

Country Region: If "Time Offset" is set to "Auto", you can set country region. **Note:** Options vary with the country you selected.

Time Zone: If "Time Offset" is set to "Manual", you can set local time zone.

Sleep: You can set sleep timer, so that when there is no operation within the set time, the receiver will switch to standby mode automatically.

Power on/off: You can set timer to switch the receiver to standby mode or operation mode at a set time automatically.

5. Option

OSD Language: You can view and modify OSD language. Subtitle Language: You can set preferred Subtitle language.

Audio Language: You set preferred audio language. If the set language is not available, the default program language will be used. Digital Audio: You can set digital audio output type.

Audio Description: You can adjust voice-over volume.

Parental Guidance: You can view and modify parental control age. System password is required to view programs beyond the set age.

Set Password: You can modify system password.

Restore Factory Default: This function will restore system settings to factory default and erase all channels. Please use this function carefully!

Information: You can view model number, software version and hardware

Software Update: OAD and USB upgrade are provided for software update. Please follow instruction displayed on screen to perform update when you

Note: Do not turn off the receiver during updating.

Cl Information: You can view information about Cl (Common Interface).

Multimedia: You can play music, browse photos, play movies and playback recorded files on USB device. In addition, you can delete and rename recorded

Photo Configure: You can view and modify photo configuration parameters, such as slide time, slide mode, etc.

Movie Configure: You can view and modify movie configuration parameters, such as Subtitle background color, Subtitle font color, etc.

PVR Configure: You can select recording device. In addition, you can format USB device, and all files will be deleted.

CHANNEL LIST

Press OK key to display channel list in non-menu mode. You can browse channels of different classes, such as All TV List, All Radio List, etc., and select a channel to play it in full screen.

G. PAUSE OR MOSAIC IMAGE.

H. PROGRAM CANNOT BE PLAYED.

- Smart card or CI module is inserted incorrectly. Insert the smart card and CI module correctly. Press MUTE key to resume volume if the unit is in mute
 - Smart card cannot decrypt this kind of program.
- Press → key to turn up volume if volume is set to You have not subscribed to the selected channel. Please contact your local operator.

. THE UNIT STOPS WORKING SUDDENLY

· Poor ventilation, or heat-producing object or device is nearby. Put the unit in a cool and well-ventilated place.

J. REMOTE CONTROL FAILURE.

- Make sure your remote control unit is aimed at the remote control signal receiver on the front panel.
- No enough power in batteries of remote control unit. Please replace batteries.

If you cannot solve the problem after referring to above trouble shooting, please contact your local operator. To reduce the risk of electric shock, do not remove the cover. Equipment service and maintenance should be undertaken by trained
