# **1. Safety information**

In order to properly and safely use your wireless device, please read the safety instructions carefully.

## **Product of public safety**

This product is electromagnetic radiation, the maximum specific absorption rate (SAR) the 9g average: 0.9W/kg and meet the national standard G B21288-2007 requirements.

## **Electronic equipment**

Prohibit the use of wireless devices or equipment, it may cause interference and security of electronic equipment, turn off the wireless devices.

## **Medical equipment**

- Forbid the use of wireless devices for medical and health care facilities, please follow the provisions of the place, turn off the wireless device.
- Operating of mobile phone may interfere with medical devices like hearing aid and pacemaker. Please always keep the mobile phone more than 20 centimeters away from such medical devices when the phone is powered on. Do not carry the mobile phone in the breast pocket. #### **General Care**

- As your mobile phone can produce electromagnetic field, do not place it near magnetic items such as computer disks.
- Using the phone near electrical appliances such as TV, telephone, radio and personal computer can cause interference, which affects the function of the phone.
- Do not expose your mobile phone to direct sunlight or store it in hot areas. High temperatures can shorten the life of electronic devices.
- Prevent liquid from leaking into your phone.
- Do not drop, knock or harshly treat your phone. Rough handling can break internal circuit boards.
- Do not charge the mobile phone without battery.
- Do not short-circuit the battery, as this can cause excessive heat and fire.
- Do not store battery in hot areas or dispose of it in a fire to avoid explosion.
- Store the phone out of the reach of little children. The phone may cause injury if used as a toy.
- Be aware of the usage limitation when using a mobile phone at places such as oil warehouses or chemical factories, where there are explosive gases or explosive products being processed, because even if your phone is in standby mode, it still transmits radio frequency (RF) energy. Do not touch the antenna while calling. Otherwise it will affect the quality of calling and waste battery energy. The damaged antenna will cause slight burn while touching your skin.

- Do not put other things on the terminal to avoid overlaying radiator.
- Keep the antenna free from obstructions and position the antenna straight up. This will ensure best call quality.
- Use a wireless hands-free system (headphone, headset) with a low power Bluetooth emitter.
- Make sure the cell phone has a low SAR.
- Keep your calls short or send a text message (SMS) instead. This advice applies especially to children, adolescents and pregnant women.
- Use cell phone when the signal quality is good.
- People having active medical implants should preferably keep the cell phone at least 15 cm away from the implant.











### 4 . Basic Functions

#### 4.1 Power on / off

- Turned off, press and hold button switched on.
- Turned on, press and hold button to shut down.

#### 4.2 Speakerphone

- State in the call, press OK to use the hands free function.

#### 4 .3 Dial

- Directly through the phone keypad to enter a phone number, press the dial key to call.
- Contacts to select a number then press the dial key to call.
- The standby mode, press the dial key, recent dial-up list that appears select the telephone number, then press the dial key to call.

#### 4 .4 Answer

1. When the phone calls, press the dial key to answer the phone.
- When a call comes in, press the left soft key can remove the ringing tone. The calls will not be rejected.
  - Press the right soft key can refuse to answer the call.



2. Press the hook key to end the call.

#### 4.5 Phone Lock

- In standby mode, press left soft key and then '\*' key to lock the phone, enter 0000 (the initial password) to unlock.

#### 4.6 Keypad Lock

- Standby mode, enter [Settings] - [Phone settings] - [keyboard lock] - [activated], open the keyboard lock.

## 5. Phone menu instructions

### 5.1 Contact

Store contact information, you can add, find contacts, setting group dialing, copy, move, or delete operation, store your phone number, to view the capacity of the mobile phone and UIM card information.

#### 5.1.1. Add New

- You can add contact details: where groups, phone number, office number, home number, and other numbers, email addresses, and memos.
- Edited for more information, press [left soft key] to save the contact information.

#### 5.1.2. Search

Find the phone number you save.

- Select [Contacts] - [Find].
- In the contacts list that appears press [up / down navigation key] to scroll through contact numbers.
- Enter the contact name or contact name starts with character.
- Enter the complete phone number or partial phone number.

#### 5.1.3. Groups

- You can modify the name of the group; you can also set the tone.
- Select [Contact] - [Group], use [up / down navigation key] to scroll through the group. Selected group, press the left soft key], you can add new members, set the ringtone and rename.

#### 5.1.4. Speed Dial

- Setting method: Select the [Contact] - [shortcut dial-up] - [Set] - [options] - [Set] set to complete.
- If you have already set up two or more contacts, you can **replace, delete, and delete all operations.**
  - **Replace:** select Replace to change the phone number corresponding to another number;
  - **Addition to delete:** delete a speed dial number;
  - **All deleted:** delete the entire stored speed dial.

**Note:** The quick dial number can only be set from the phone contacts.

**5.1.5. Copy**

- You can copy the contact numbers, Phone to UIM card and UIM card to Phone.

**5.1.6. Move**

- You can move a contact number, Phone to UIM card and UIM card to Phone.

**5.1.7. Delete**

- You can delete a contact number or all contact from the Phone and UIM card.

**5.1.8. My number**

- You can view the number and edit the number you saved.

**5.1.9. Memory information**

- View the saved contacts by phone and UIM card capacity.

**5.2. Messages****5.2.0. Short Message**

- Press [Right] button or menu to enter the SMS menu, you can edit the text message, text and voice mail content.
- Users can view, edit text, but also the information set operation. Can set the priority of information, open, close the receipt of the report, set the period of effective information, turn on, turn off to save the send message function, lock the UIM card inbox (enter the initial password 0000), set up automatic scrolling time, open, shut down automatically deleted information, open, close the Alert function, select the save location.

**5.2.1. New Message**

You can send a text message, if the caller in the process of editing information, the information will be edited automatically saved to the Drafts.

**5.2.1.1.** Select [Information] - [new information].

**5.2.1.2.** Edit the information and press the OK button].

**5.2.1.3.** Enter to send the number.

**5.2.1.4.** You can send to 10 contacts.

Press the left soft key **】**

- Send: to send a short message.
- Number: Select a recent number.
- Search for a contact: Select a number from your contacts.
- Recipient groups: select a number from the recipient group.
- Priority: Set the SMS priority to low or high.
- Save send a message: Set whether to save the sent text messages.

**5.2.2. Inbox**

**5.2.2.1.** You can search and view the received short message.

**5.2.2.2.** Select [Short Message] - [Inbox].

**5.2.2.3.** Press on the key] [next key] Select to view text messages, press the OK button] to view the messages.

**5.2.2.4. Press the left soft key】**

- Re: reply to this article text messages.
- Forward: Forward this article text messages.
- Call: Call the number.
- Call Editor: edit the number before the call.
- UIM card go to the Inbox: UIM card inside the short message transfer to the Inbox.
- Inbox Go to the UIM card: SMS Inbox inside the UIM card.
- Save number: save SMS numbers.
- Delete: Delete the short message.

**5.2.3. Outbox**

- You can save sent and unsent SMS messages, and you can view in the outbox

**5.2.4. Drafts**

- The information is not edited or editing but was not sent when stored in the Drafts.
- Enter Drafts, use 【】 / 【next】 navigation key to select the information you need, press the Enter key to view and edit information, and then send a message; press the right soft key to delete the information.

**5.2.5. Templates**

- Nine predefined phrase sentences, you can edit and add new template in the template.

**5.2.6. Recipient groups**

- This feature allows mass text messages can be set up to 5 groups, you can press the] / [under] the navigation keys to select the group, add members to the group. Select the group you need, and then press the left soft key can view, rename, empty group operation.

**5.2.7. Deleted text messages**

- You can delete your phone, Outbox, UIM card, Drafts.

**5.2.8. Message settings**

- Based on individuals need to set the mobile phone short message function
- Priority
- Send a Message, you can set the priority of information, such as: urgent or normal;
- Receipt of the report
- Open the receipt of the report, you can prompt you for information has been sent successfully;
- Expiration date
- You can select the period of validity of the SMS.
- Save to send information
- When this feature is enabled, send a message or send a failure message will be automatically saved to the Outbox.

- Lock the Inbox of the UIM card
- In order to protect the personal privacy settings, into the inbox of the UIM card, need to enter the default password 0000.
- Auto scroll time
- Detailed view of information, the information content is larger than the screen to automatically scroll the contents of the timer set time.
- Automatically delete information
- This feature is turned on, the earliest when the SMS inbox storage to exceed the maximum capacity, received a SMS will be automatically deleted.
- Alert
- Set up message when new information is received, if not treated, the phone will remind you automatically.
- Location to save the
- Set the phone to save the information to the location, you can choose to save to phone or UIM card.

### 5.3. Profiles

Defined phone profiles

- You can each scene mode available ringtone options, keypad tones, and other settings as the default setting, or personalization options to meet your individual needs. You can select the following scene modes: vibration mode, silent mode, normal mode, the outdoor mode.
- Activate the profile:
- Standby mode, press the menu - profile - vibration, mute (Silent), in general, outdoor - settings.
- In normal (General) mode, select "Edit", you can set the type of incoming call alert and ring tones for text messages, type and ring tones, volume settings, open, close, service tone.

### 5.4. Call History

Including a call or answered the phone, you can set up call (to answer the way to the call management, call waiting, call forwarding, voice encryption, etc.), display of talk time, delete call records and other operations.

**Description:** View call records there are two kinds of methods:

- Press dial keys to enter from the menu interface, call management, including telephone calls, received calls and missed calls.

#### 5.4.1. Dialed calls

- View the dialed calls list.
- [Left soft key on the screen view / edit the number in the information / call / save / delete / delete all.

#### 5.4.2. Received calls

- View Phone List.

- For more information, please refer to [dialing].

#### **5.4.3. Missed call**

- View the list of missed calls.
- For more information, please refer to [dialing].

#### **5.4.4. In Call Memo**

- The view saved in the call notes (limited number).
- During a call, press the left button] to save the call notes.

#### **5.4.5. Call Duration**

- View the time information of the selected call record.

#### **5.4.6. Delete History**

- Delete all call records. Including dial calls, received calls and missed calls.

**MY MTS Planet:** Enjoy services which are available to the subscriber.

Some network services, please contact your network provider for the detailed information.

### **5.6. Tools**

Your phone provides a number of features used to help you effectively manage your daily life, such as alarm clock, calendar, notepad, stopwatch, calculator, unit conversion, world clock.

#### **5.6.1. Facebook**

**Facebook:** To direct connection to access social network.

#### **5.6.2. Alarm Clock**

- Your phone provides a 3 alarm clock. Set the alarm, the alarm clock icon is displayed in the system tray on the screen. If the current time is the alarm clock set time, the phone will ring.

#### **5.6.3. Calendar**

- Schedule to facilitate the recording schedule, store your appointments, a simple view. In accordance with the goals set to prompt your arrangements!

Set the time and memo, alarm clock timer sounded.

- Use the navigation keys to select the date, then press OK;
- Press the left soft key to select Add;
- Enter the schedule information and alarms;
- Press the OK button to save.

#### **5.6.4. Note (Notepad)**

- To use this feature, can create and manage text record of the important things.

#### **5.6.5. Stopwatch**

- Timer expires, the application.

#### **5.6.6. Calculator**

- Calculate the simple math arithmetic. Press the navigation key to enter "+ - x /" press the \* key once to enter "(" according to the secondary input"), press the # key for a decimal point.
- Press [0] ~ [9] and the navigation key for calculation

#### **5.6.7. World Clock**

- Facilitate the identification of other regions and countries of the time.
- Press the left / right navigation keys to select the target city;
- 2 Press OK to confirm the selected location time settings - display settings - to set up dual-clock in the clock will be displayed and selected the location of the time.

#### **5.6.8. Torch**

- Select on or off as you needed.

### **5.7. Multimedia**

#### **5.7.1. FM Radio**

You can use the application as a traditional FM radio with automatic tuning and saved channels. Before using this function, you need to insert headset into its corresponding slot. In FM radio interface, you can press Up & Down navigation key to tune volume, left or right direction key to change the channels.

#### **5.7.2. Games**

- Tetris game
- Instructions: by the arrow keys or number keys to move or rotate the box. Rotating box, button, press on the arrow keys or the number 2 key, left and right arrow keys or digital 4,6, respectively, to achieve the left, move right arrow keys or numeric keys to achieve accelerated, according to the number keys or OK The key to the box directly in the end, press the left soft key to pause the game, press again to continue the game, the right soft key to exit the game.

#### **5.7.3. File Manager**

### **5.9. Settings**

Detailed settings on the phone here is.

#### **5.9.1. Display Settings**

##### **5.9.1.1. Background**

- You can customize the wallpaper; activate the network name is displayed, the standby screen will appear, "China Telecom" network name.

### 5.9.1.2. Clock

- **Analog clock, digital clock and dual clock, off** a total of **four** kinds of clock display alternative.

**Note:** Choose dual clock display will increase the clock that you set in World Clock.

### 5.9.1.3. The time format

- Select 12 hours or 24 hours of production for the clock expression

### 5.9.1.4. LCD backlight

- Choose the time of the backlight for 5 seconds, 10 seconds, 20 seconds, 30 seconds or one minute.

### 5.9.1.5. LCD brightness

- Choose the LCD brightness from the three options **Dark, Normal and Bright**.

## 5.9.2. Phone Settings

### 5.9.2.1. Language

- Set the phone's menu interface is in Hindi or English (English).

### 5.9.2.2. Key Guard lock

- The keypad lock is activated; the key operation in the standby screen, the keyboard will lock automatically. Keypad is locked, press the left soft key and then press the \* key to unlock.

### 5.9.2.3. Airplane Mode

- Set the phone to flight mode (Airplane Mode).
- In Airplane Mode, the phone is disconnected from the base station. You cannot call and send a message operation.

### 5.9.2.4. Version of device

- View the machine's software / hardware version, the MEID number.

### 5.9.2.5. Version of device

- View the machine's model / SAR Value.

## 5.9.3. Call settings

- Answer mode
- Select Call button to answer the telephone, there are two kinds of optional: Any key answer, only the answer key to answer.
- Call Forward
- You can divert calls to user-specified number.
- Call Waiting
- You can choose whether to answer the call waiting phone number.
- Voice Privacy
- Use the enhanced encryption or the use of standard encryption, to prevent others from eavesdropping on conversations.
- Clear Voice
- You can choose one option from the On / Off Option.
- Call Connect Alert

- When this feature is turned on, the phone is connected to the mobile station, can hear the tone.

#### **5.9.4. Security Settings**

You must enter the correct unlock code to enter the security settings. The default lock code is 0000.

- PIN code setting
- PIN check (CRC)
- You need to enter the correct PIN code can be selected to open the PIN code check function.
- When activated, each boot will need to enter the correct PIN code to activate the phone.
- Modify PIN code
- Enter the PIN code (example: 1234), and then enter the new password (eg: 0000), and finally to confirm the new password (eg: 0000), you can successfully change the PIN.

#### **Note:**

##### **5.9.4.1. PIN Code change**

- Only open the PIN code check in order to change the PIN.
- When you set the PIN code detection, if three consecutive mismatched, phone card will be locked. At this point, enter the PUK unlock code to use this phone card users need to reboot. For mismatched 10 unlock code, this card will be locked forever, users need to contact your network operator. In this way you can prevent users of the service is unauthorized use. Replace a phone card; the phone can still use the new phone card.
- PIN and PUK code please contact your UIM card vendor to obtain.

##### **5.9.4.2. The phone lock**

- You can select the on / off phone lock. Phone lock is open, you must enter the correct unlock code to unlock your phone.
- Open the phone locks have two choices.
- Immediately: Make sure the phone is locked immediately.
- Boot: Make sure that after each boot will need to enter the unlock code to unlock.

##### **5.9.4.3. Change the phone password**

- Continuous input twice the new modified cell phone unlock code, you can successfully modify the unlock password.

##### **5.9.4.4. Restore the factory settings**

- The phone's settings back to factory settings.

#### **Note:**

Use this setting with caution, may lose some data and information, including phone stored on the phone book, SMS, call records.



## **6. SAR (Specific Absorption Rate)**

### **Information**

The highest SAR value for this mobile phone is <1.6 W/Kg, in accordance with the requirements of the ICNIRP, which recommended the limit for exposure to radio waves is 1.6 watts/kilogram(W/Kg) averaged over 1 gram of tissue.

#### ***Safety precautions:***

- Make sure the cell phone has a low SAR.
- Keep your calls short or send a text message (SMS) instead. This advice applies especially to children, adolescents and pregnant women.
- Use cell phone when the signal quality is good.
