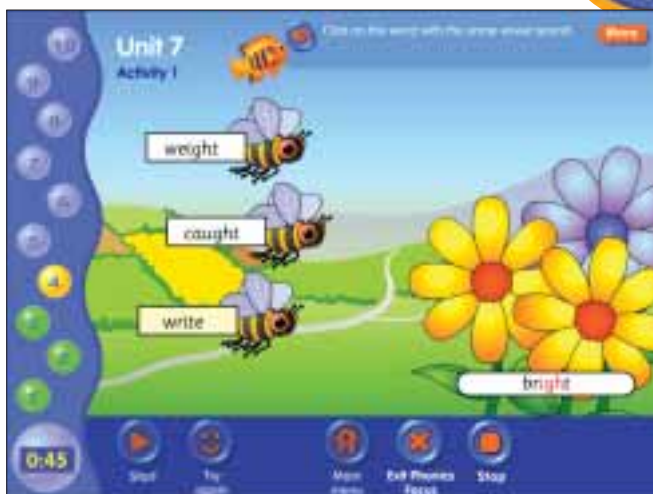

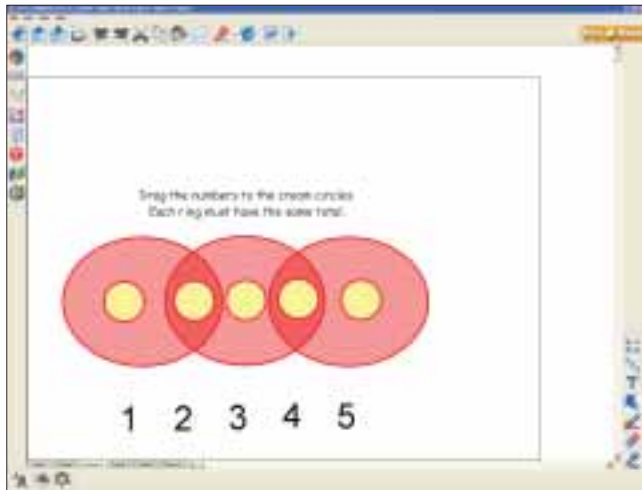


▲ Abacus and place value

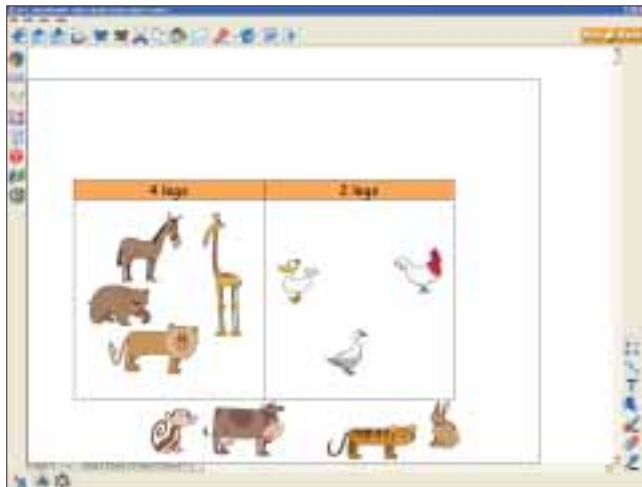

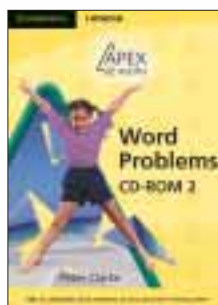

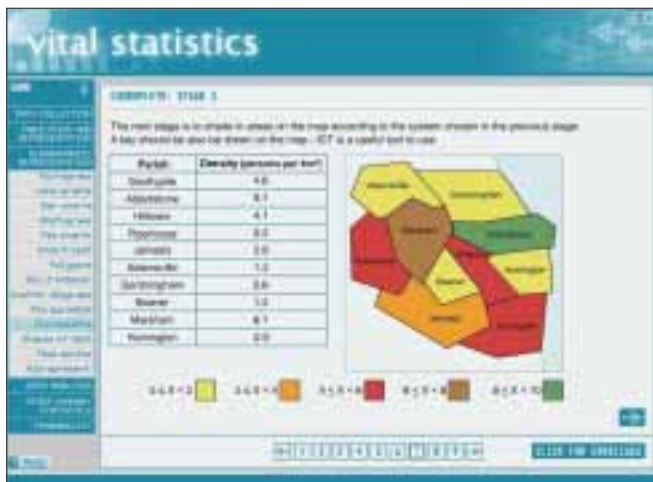
