





■ Control panel


The LED indicators show current status of each function. All buttons on the control panel are intended to control the connected Hitachi projector. Please refer to the section "Controlling the projector" (20) for more details about controlling the projector.



NOTE • A part of Hitachi projectors cannot be controled with those control buttons. Please ask your dealer for more details.

■ Ports

The ports with "OUT" are to connected with Hitachi projector, and those with "IN" except for DC IN are for signal source devices such as computers and DVD players. Please refer to the section "Connecting" (415~18) for more details.



NOTE • The **USB IN TYPE B** port is for a computer only.

Installing

When you install the product especially as fixed to such as wall and shelf, please be sure to consult your dealer to employ a professional about installation.

Please check and follow the notes below before the work to keep you and your surrounding including the product safe.

△WARNING ► Install the product where you can access the power outlet easily. If an abnormality should occur, unplug the product urgently. Otherwise it could cause a fire or electric shock.

- ▶ Do not subject the product to unstable conditions. If the product falls or topples over, it could result in injury or damage to the product and the surrounding things. Using a damaged product could result in a fire and an electric shock.
- Do not use any mounting accessories except the accessories specified by the manufacturer.
- Do not ride or lean on the product especially when the product is installed on a wall






■ AC adapter

There is a room on the back side of the switcher unit to store the AC adapter and excess of its cord. We recommend to put them before attaching any accessories on the back side of the switcher unit.

- 1. At first, connect the AC adapter and the power cord. Check the direction of the AC adapter when putting it into the space to have its plug reach **DC IN** easier, and avoid extra stress on the connecting portion of the cords. We recommend to direct the inlet socket on the AC adapter to the door of the space.
- 2. Pass the power cord and the cord of AC adapter along the grooves and fix with hooks at 2 points each as directed in the drawings.







When the product has already installed


Open the door on the side panel and put the AC adapter into the space. Be careful to avoid extra stress on the connecting portion of the cords. Fix only the cord of AC adapter along the groove.

NOTE • Please push in the AC adapter and the cords enough so that the door can close well.

■ Tablet arm


Please attach the tablet arm on the back side of the product to keep a tablet on top of the product while using it.

1. Release the 4 screws on the back side of the product indicated in the drawings.



Using the tablet arm

Lift and put down the arm so that it holds the tablet put on top of the product at the groove.



△CAUTION ► Be sure to use the tablet arm to hold the tablet when placing the tablet on the product. Do not place things extremely heavier than a tablet on the product.

■ Wallmount bracket (fixed installation to wall)

At first, please consult your dealer to install the product with the Wallmount bracket. To install the product onto a wall, use the Wallmount braket, screws and bolts included in the package. Please check and follow the notes below before the work to keep you and your surrounding including the product safe.

△WARNING ► Technical skills are required to install the product. Please do not attempt to perform the installation yourself. Please confer with your sales agent about the installation of this product before contracting a service specialist.

- ▶ Employ the services of a tradesman to perform the installation.
- ► Hitachi will not be held responsible for any accidents or injuries resulting from incorrect mounting or improper use of this product.


To sales agents and tradesmen

- For your customers' safety, be sure that the point where you attach the wallmount bracket has sufficient strength to bear the weight of the product.
- The included screws are designed for wood only. Use anchor bolt to mount on a concrete wall.

The product can be mounted onto a wall in two ways, INSTALLATION 1 and 2. The installation on Wallmount bracket depends on which direction you want to lay the cables and how you want to mount it onto a wall. We recommend INSTALLATION 1 more, but use the method INSTALLATION 2 in cases as following;

- The product is going to be mounted in a hollow difficult to screw the bracket from side.
- The product may be moved often after installation.

Please refer to the following instruction for installation procedure.

NOTE • INSTALLATION 2 can be used only when having the cables go downward.


• The included screws are designed for wood only. Use anchor bolts to mount on a concrete wall. (The screw diameter and length : Φ11, W6x(10+20))


INSTALLATION 1

This procedure uses all, bracket A and B, 4 screws and 6 bolts. The product is going to be fixed firmly.


NOTE • Please check beforehand if there is enough space to tighten the bolts to fix the product onto the wall.

- 1. Mount the bracket A onto a wall using the included screws.
- 2. Attach the bracket B to the back side of product with 2 bolts as the drawings below.





- 3. Align the bracket A and B.
- 4. Fix the bracket A and B with bolts from the side at the four corners.




NOTE • Please remind to prepare enough space to access the bolts for screwdriver.

INSTALLATION 2


This procedure uses bracket B, 4 screws and 2 bolts. The product is going to be hang on the wall so that it can be used only when having the cables go downward.

1. Put marks on the wall at the hole position of the bracket B. Then, tighten the screws at the marked exactly.




NOTE • Try hooking the bracket B to check if the screw position and the gap between the wall are proper. Do not over tighten the screws.

2. Attach the bracket B to the back side of product with 2 bolts as the drawings below.



3. Hang the product onto the screws.





Installing (continued)

■ Cable cover and cable tie

Please attach the cable cover to avoid dust, especially chalk dust. Also attach the cable ties to keep cables without fixing screws from falling out as needed.

- 1. Release the 4 screws indicated in the drawings.
- 2. Align the screw holes on the cable cover and the switcher unit, and fasten them with the 4 screws released beforehand.
- 3. Fix the cable ties at the holes in the cable cover as directed in the drawing.






NOTICE ▶Be aware that the screws are 2 kinds, silver and black, machine and tapping. Both the screw and screw hole might become useless if they were tried to fasten in wrong pair.


Installing (continued)

Side holder

Attach the side holder for convenience to keep accessories such as an Apple TV[®], a remote control and interactive pens, which are often used with the projector.


Take off the hole cap and hook the side holder in the holder pocket as directed in the drawings. Push down the holder until the mark "▼" on the switcher unit can see above the holder.





△CAUTION ► The side holder can turn up to 45 degrees. Do not try to turn moreover to avoid breakage.


▶ Put the interactive pens making their nibs upward to avoid unexpected operation and futile consumption.



■ Security tool

A commercially available anti-theft chain or wire can be attached to the security bar on the product. Refer to the figure to choose an anti-theft chain or wire. Also this product has the security slot for the Kensington lock.

For details, see the manual of the security tool.



△WARNING ► Do not use the security bar and slot to prevent the product from falling down, since it is not designed for it.

NOTE • The security bar and slot is not comprehensive theft prevention measures. It is intended to be used as supplemental theft prevention measure.

Connecting

Before connecting the product to a device, please consult the manual of the device to confirm that the device is suitable for connecting with this product and prepare the required accessories such as a cable in accord with the signal of the device.

Please check and follow the notes below before the work to keep you and your surrounding including the product safe.

△WARNING ► Use only the appropriate accessories. Otherwise it could cause a fire or damage the product and devices.

- Use only the accessories specified or recommended by the product's manufacturer. It may be regulated under some standard.
- Neither disassemble nor modify the product and the accessories.
- Do not use the damaged accessory. Be careful not to damage the accessories. Route a cable so that it is neither stepped on nor pinched out.
- ▶ Please pay extra caution when connecting the power cord and the AC adapter, as incorrect or faulty connections may result in fire and/or electrical shock.
- Do not touch them with a wet hand.
- Only use the power cord and the AC adapter that came with the product.
- Only plug the power cord into an outlet whose voltage is matched to the power cord. The power outlet should be close to the product and easily accessible.
 Remove the power cord for complete separation.
- Do not distribute the power supply to multiple devices. Doing so may overload the outlet and connectors, loosen the connection, or result in fire, electric shock or other accidents.

- ▶ Do not use any extension cable or device when connecting the USB wireless adapter to the product.
- ▶ Before you insert or pull out the USB wireless adapter from the product, turn off the power of the product. Do not touch the USB wireless adapter while the product is on.

Connecting (continued)

- NOTE Do not turn on or off the product while connected to a device in operation, unless that is directed in the manual of the device. Otherwise it may cause malfunction in the device or product.
- Be careful not to mistakenly connect a connector to a wrong port. Otherwise it may cause malfunction in the connected devices.
- When connecting a connector to a port, make sure that the shape of the connector fits the port.
- Tighten the screws to connect a connector equipped with screws to a port.
- Please use the cable tie to prevent cables without fixing screws from falling out as needed.
- · Some signal may need an adapter to input this product.
- This product might not output proper signal depending on the signal input.
- Be sure to use an HDMI[™] cable that has the HDMI logo. Use a Category 2-certified HDMI[™] cable to input 1080p@50/60 signal to the product.
- When the product is connected with a device having DVI connector, use a DVI to HDMI[™] cable to connect with the HDMI input.
- Connect the **HDMI OUT** port to the **HDMI 1** port of the projector when the projector has multiple HDMI input ports.
- If you would use simple mouse & keyboard function on the projector, it would be better to connect the projector (via the product) with single computer to prevent operation mistake.
- If an oversized USB storage device blocks other ports, use a USB extension cable to connect the USB storage device.
- Depending on the size of the plugs and the USB device, the cable cover may not be closed properly. Be careful not to break the cover by forcing it to be closed.

Connecting (continued)

After making sure that the projector and the signal source devices are turned off, connect the signal source devices before power supply. Please refer to the figures in the next page.


The ports with "OUT" are to connected with Hitachi projector, and those with "IN" except for DC IN are for signal source devices such as computers and DVD players. Connect the CONTROL OUT port of the product and the CONTROL (IN) port of the projector with RS-232C (cross) cable to control the projector from the product.

Connect the power cord to the AC adapter, and connect the DC plug to the **DC IN**. Plug in the power cord at last.

NOTICE ▶The projector cannot be controlled from the product when they are not connected with RS-232C.

NOTE • When you have attached the cable cover, pass the DC plug through the hole in the cable cover to connect it.



Operating

Please check the connection with the projector, the signal source devices and power supply before usage.


A tablet can be put on the top of the product using the tablet arm. Please refer to the section "Tablet arm" ($\square 9$) for more details.

△WARNING ► Heat may build up in the USB wireless adapter, to avoid possible burns turn off the product for 10 minutes before touching the adapter.

△CAUTION ► Be sure to use the tablet arm to hold the tablet when placing the tablet on the product. Do not place things extremely heavier than a tablet on the product.

NOTE • Available functions and the time to display the picture vary depending on the specifications of the projector and relation between the signal source device. Please refer to their manuals about matters.

- Turning on the power
- 1. Plug in the projector and make it standby state.
- 2. Turn the power switch on ("|" position) of the product and wait for a while until the **POWER** indicator lights in green and the **PROJECTOR** indicator lights in orange.
- 3. Turn on the signal source devices.




- 1. Turn off the signal source devices.
- 2. Turn the power switch off ("O" position) of the product and check all the indicators turns off.

■ Controlling the projector

The buttons on the control panel can control the projector as below.



INPUT buttons and indicators

Turning on and off the power

Use the **PROJECTOR** button. Please refer to the section "Regarding the indicator lamps" (22) for the details of the projector status which the **PROJECTOR** indicator shows.

NOTE • Please remember that the projector is turned off by single press of the **PROJECTOR** button without displaying the message dialog to ensure.

Selecting an input signal

Use the **INPUT** buttons. The LED indicator shows which input is selected at the projector.

Temporarily turning off the screen and audio

Press the **AV MUTE** button. The **AV MUTE** indicator lights in green while active. To restore the screen and audio, press one among **AV MUTE** button, **MUTE** button and **VOL** +/- buttons.

Temporarily muting the sound

Press the **MUTE** button. The **MUTE** indicator lights in green while active. To restore the sound, press one among **MUTE** button and **VOL** +/- buttons.

Adjusting the volume

Use the VOL +/- buttons.

Temporarily freezing the screen

Press the **FREEZE** button. The **FREEZE** indicator lights in green while active. To restore the screen, press the **FREEZE** button again.

NOTE • The buttons except for the **PROJECTOR** can be use only while the **PROJECTOR** indicator lights in green.

- Both of the **AV MUTE** and **MUTE** indicators may light when the AV MUTE function is active on a part of Hitachi projectors.
- A part of Hitachi projectors cannot be controlled with those control buttons. Please ask your dealer for more details.

Maintenance


■ Inside of the product

In order to ensure the safe use of your product, please have it cleaned and inspected by your dealer about once every year.

Caring for the cabinet

Incorrect care could have adverse influence such as discoloration, peeling paint, etc.

- 1. Turn the product off, and unplug the power cord. Allow the product to cool sufficiently.
- After making sure that the product is cool adequately, lightly wipe with gauze or a soft cloth.
 If soiling is severe, dip soft cloth in water or a neutral cleaner dilute in water, and wipe lightly after wringing well. Then, wipe lightly with a soft, dry cloth.



- ► Never try to care for the inside of the product personally. Doing is so dangerous.
- ► Avoid wetting the product or inserting liquids in the product. It could result in a fire, an electric shock, and/or malfunction to the product.
- Do not put anything containing water, cleaner or chemicals near the product.
- Do not use aerosols or sprays.

△CAUTION ► Please take right care of the product according to the following. Incorrect care could cause not only an injury but adverse influence such as discoloration, peeling paint, etc.


