I-2 Installing

Deciding On an Installation Site

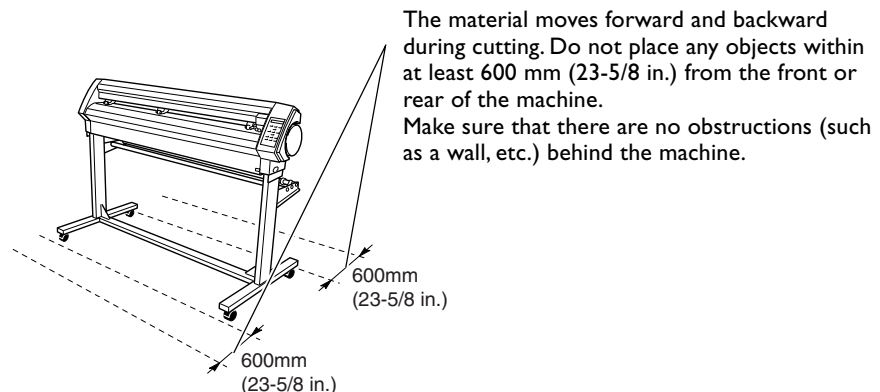
Installation Space

GX-500 : 1200 mm (47-1/4 in.) high, 1700 mm (66-15/16 in.) wide, and 900 mm (35-7/16 in.) depth

GX-400 : 1200 mm (47-1/4 in.) high, 1500 mm (59-1/16 in.) wide, and 900 mm (35-7/16 in.) depth

GX-300 : 1200 mm (47-1/4 in.) high, 1250 mm (49-1/4 in.) wide, and 900 mm (35-7/16 in.) depth



Assembling the Stand

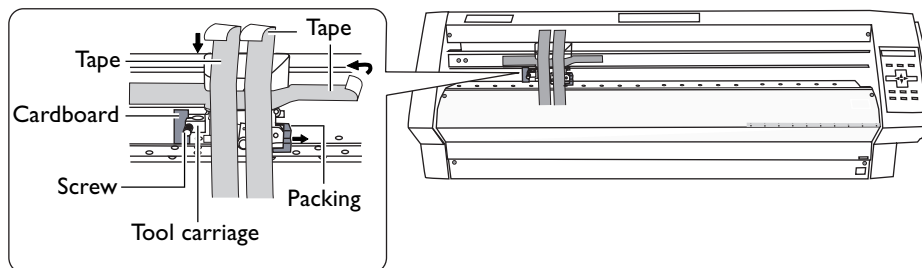

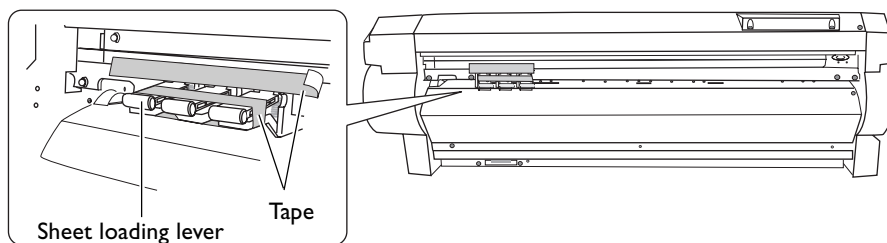

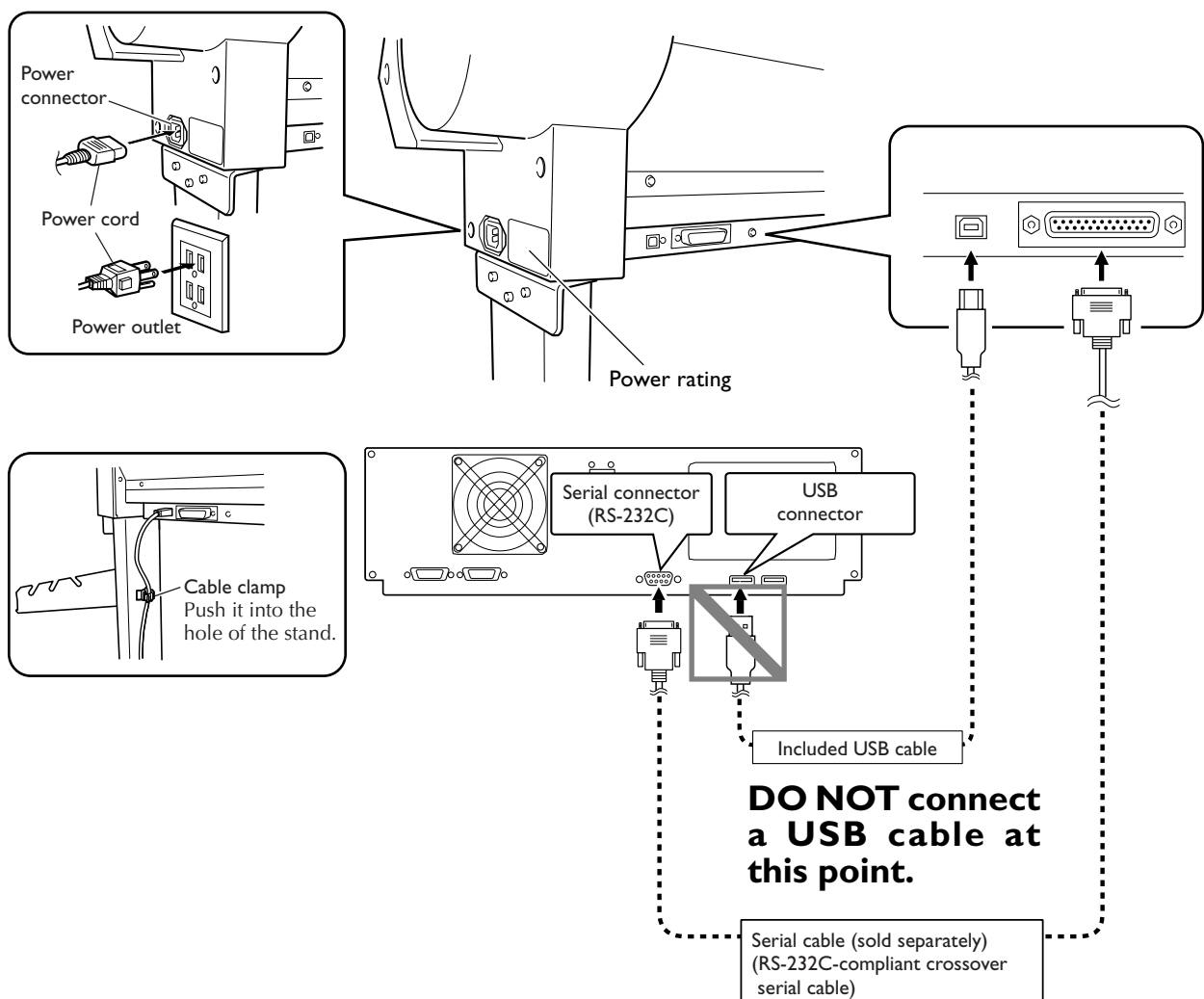

Serial Connection(Windows only)

Use a serial cable from Roland DG Corp. sold separately (for an IBM-compatible computer, use a crossover cable such as the XY-RS-34) or equivalent. A straight cable such as a modem cable will not work.

For more information about the specifications of the serial interface, refer to the "CAMM-1PRO User's Manual."

Using Both a USB Connection and a Serial Connection

This machine allows you to connect a USB cable and a serial cable at the same time. However, the two ports cannot be used simultaneously.

If the [I/O] display-menu item on the machine is set to [AUTO] (the default setting), then the first port that receives data after the power is turned on is selected as the usable port. The usable port cannot be changed except by resetting the power or changing the port setting using the [I/O] menu item.

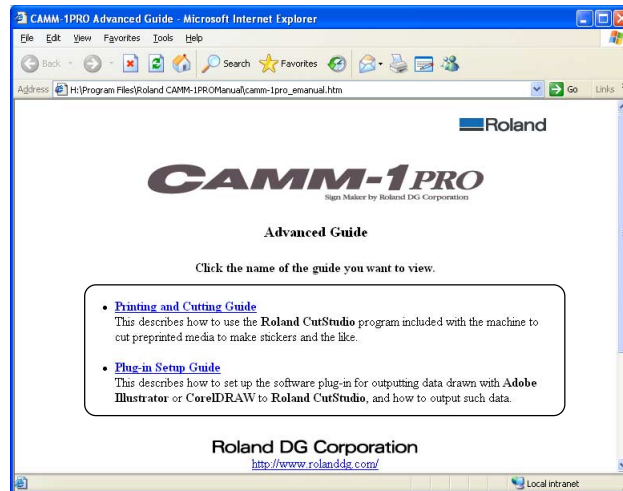
Click [Install].

If installation quits partway through, or if the wizard does not appear when you make the connection with a USB cable, take action as follows.

Windows 2000/XP

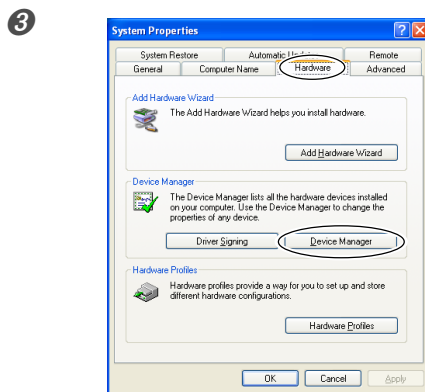
- ❶ If the [Found New Hardware Wizard] appears, click [Finish] to close it.
- ❷ Display [System Properties].

Windows XP

Click the [Start] menu, then right-click [My Computer]. Click [Properties].

Windows 2000

Right-click [My Computer] on the desktop. Click [Properties].



Click the [Hardware] tab, then click [Device Manager]. The [Device Manager] appears.

- ❹ Delete the model name you're using. (or [Unknown device]).

❶ At the [View] menu, click [Show hidden devices].

❷ Find [Printers] or [Other device], then double-click it.

❸ Click the model name you're using (or [Unknown device]).

❹ Go to the [Action] menu, and click [Uninstall].

❺ After the screen shown at left appears, click [OK].

- ⑤ Close the [Device Manager] and click [OK].
- ⑥ Detach the USB cable connected to the computer.
- ⑦ Restart Windows, then uninstall the driver.

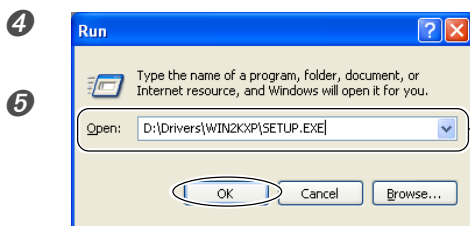

Uninstalling the Driver

When uninstalling the driver, perform following operation.

Procedure

- 1 Before you start uninstallation of the driver, unplug the USB cable from your computer.
- 2 Log on to Windows. If you are installing under Windows 2000/XP, log on as "Administrators" right.
- 3 Insert the included CD-ROM into the CD-ROM drive.
The setup menu appears.
Go to the upper right and click the [X] to close the setup menu.



In this illustration, drive D is specified as the CD-ROM drive.

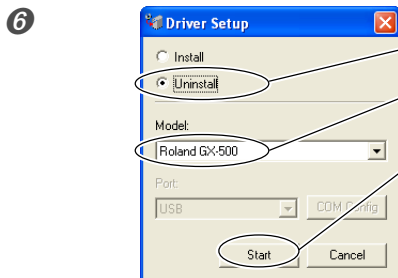
From the [Start] menu, click [Run].

For [Open], type in the information shown below, then click [OK].

The Setup program starts and the [Driver Setup] window appears.

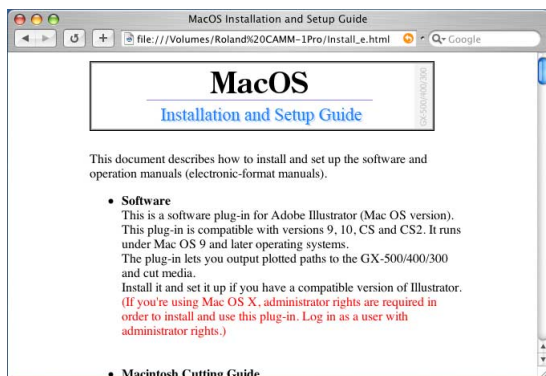
Your Macintosh must fulfill the following requirements in order to use this machine for cutting operations.
