# **CLOCK AND TIMER**

#### Setting the Clock

- With the power off, press and hold the **Clk Set/Mem** button. 1. The hour on the display will begin flashing.
- Press the Tune +/- buttons to adjust the hour. 2.
- Press the Clk Set button again to adjust the minutes. 3. The minutes on the display will begin flashing.
- Press the Tune +/- buttons to adjust the minutes. 4
- Press the **Clk Set** button to finish setting the time, or wait for 5. the display to stop flashing.

#### Setting the Timer

1. With the power off, press the Timer button. The display will flash.

## CD

Note: This unit is not compatible with MP3 CDs.

#### Loading and Playing a CD

- 1. Open the **CD Door**.
- 2. Place a CD into the tray, label side facing up.
- 3. Close the **CD Door**.
- 4. Press the **Source** button to switch to CD mode.
- Press the **Play/Pause** button to begin playing the loaded CD. 5.
- 6. Press the **Skip/Tune** buttons to cycle through tracks.

### RADIO

#### Radio Reception

An FM Antenna is built into the unit. To improve FM radio reception, adjust the position of the unit.

#### Tuning the FM Radio

- 1. Press the **Power** button to turn the under cabinet music system on.
- 2 Press the **Source** button to switch to FM Radio Mode.
- 3. Press the Tune +/- button to tune the radio manually.
- 4. Hold down the **Tune +/-** button to scan for available stations.

## **BLUETOOTH AND LINE IN**

#### Pairing a Bluetooth Device for the First Time

- 1. Power on the unit by pressing the **Power** button.
- Press the Source button to switch to Bluetooth mode. The Pairing Indicator 2. will flash slowly
- Press the Pair button. The Pairing Indicator will flash quickly. When pairing, 3. remain within 3 feet of the unit.
- Using the native controls on your Bluetooth device, select the IKBC384 in 4. your Bluetooth settings to pair.
- If your device requests a password, enter the default password **0000**. 5.
- Refer to the user's manual for your specific device for instructions on pairing 6. and connecting Bluetooth devices.
- When successfully paired and connected, the Pairing Indicator will be solid. 7.
- After initial pairing, the unit will stay paired unless unpaired manually by the 8. user or erased due to a reset of the device.
- If your device should become unpaired or you find it is unable to connect, 9. repeat the above steps or press the Pair button to start the pairing process pairing again.

- Press the **Timer** buttons to adjust the timer in increments of 10 min. 2.
- Press the **Tune +/-** buttons to adjust the timer in increments of 1 min. 3
- 4. Wait for the display to stop flashing.
- After the set time has expired, the under cabinet music system will 5. sound an alarm.

### Disabling the Timer

To cancel the alarm after it has sounded, press the Power button.

To cancel the timer before the alarm has sounded, press the **Timer** button until the display reads 000 and the timer light is no longer lit.

#### Programming a CD

- 1. Press the **Stop** button to stop the CD during play.
- 2. Press the Prog button.
- "PROG" will begin to blink on the display. 3.
- 4. Press the **Tune +/-** buttons to select a track.
- Press the **Program** button to save the selected track to the program. 5.
- Repeat steps 4 and 5 to program up to 20 tracks. 6.

#### Saving and Playing a Station as a Preset

- 1. Tune to the desired station.
- 2. Press the Clk Set/Mem button.
- Preset number will appear on the display.
- 3. Press the M +/- buttons to adjust to the desired preset number.
- 4. Press the Clk Set/Mem button to save the current radio station to the selected preset.
- 5. Press the M +/- buttons to cycle through preset radio stations.

### Playing Audio through Bluetooth

- After successfully pairing to a device, use the native controls on the connected Bluetooth Device to select a track.
- To play or pause the selected track, use the native controls on the connected 2. Bluetooth Device, or the Play/Pause button on the unit.
- To skip forward or back on the selected track, use the native controls 3 on the connected Bluetooth Device, or the Skip/Tune +/- buttons on the unit.
- Audio played through the connected Bluetooth device will now be heard 4. through the speakers

#### Using the Audio Input

Requires a 3.5mm audio cable (not included).

- Connect a 3.5mm audio cable to the Line In Input on the side of the 1. unit and the audio output on an audio device.
- 2. Press the **Power** button to turn the unit on.
- 3 Press the **Source** button to switch to **Line In mode**.
- Use the native controls on the connected device to play your audio 4. through the unit.
