
One Year Manufacturer's Limited Warranty

Congratulations on your purchase of the Reizen Mouse Electronic Magnifier. This magnifier was designed to enable those with low vision to read comfortably and easily. By simply rolling the mouse magnifier over reading material, you'll be able to view text magnified on your PC.

With adjustable 2x to 32x magnification, variable viewing modes and an Image Lock (Freeze Frame) feature, you'll have the flexibility and functionality you need to make reading easier than ever. With the USB version you can also save screen images and share them with family and friends via email.

Important Safety Precautions

To keep the unit in good condition and to ensure safe usage, please refer to the following guidelines:

- Read the instructions in this user's guide before starting to use the unit.
- Do not attempt to repair the unit or open its case. This product contains no user serviceable parts.
- Keep the unit away from wet areas, rain, and other sources of liquids or high humidity. Do not submerge the unit.
- Always operate the unit in a place where the temperature is between 10° and 40° C (50° and 104° F).
- Always store where the temperature is between -20° and 65° C (-4° and 149° F).
- Always use the unit on a stable, level, hard surface such as a desk or table.
- Never force connectors into the unit's ports. All appropriate connectors should fit easily into the ports. If the connector does not fit, turn it around, and try again.
- Use only the power cable that came with your unit. Other adapters may damage unit.
- When cleaning the unit, make sure it is unplugged. To clean it, lightly dampen a soft, clean cloth with water or mild detergent.
- Do not bend or twist the cable excessively as this could cause fatigue and lead to unit failure.
- Do not leave the power cable or product cable where someone might trip over it.

Video Sampling Card Functions:

- A. Date & Time display
- B. Camera timer: take picture every 5 seconds (Refer to item D for save direction path)
- C. Photo frame and save: take picture (JPG or BMP format)
- D. Document save direction path: Set up camera timer and document path
- E. About software version information and developer information
- F. Advanced settings: set up video parameters, digital camera focus and stunts
- G. Video image resolution settings
- H. Video record button
- I. Video record settings: select coder and set up video
- J. File save direction path
- K. Video display interface

Note: In order to get the best image quality, please refer to following instructions:

- 1. Select desired image resolution (refer to G.)
- 2. Save documents to a direction path that is easy to find (Refer to D)
- 3. Adjust mouse camera to get the best image display

Mouse Magnifier Button Functions:

- 1. "M": Mode selection button (Full Color Black on White White on Black High Contrast)
- 2. "+": Zoom in
- 3. "-": Zoom out
- 4. "*": Image Lock (Freeze Frame)
- 5. Camera On/Off Switch

Installing & Using the Mouse Electronic Magnifier (Wireless USB Version for Computer)

- First, charge the wireless mouse magnifier using the supplied cable (Disconnect AC cable near yellow Video Out plug and connect to jack on mouse.) Mouse fully charges in 3-4 hours. After mouse is charged, re-connect cable.
- Unplug any existing camera devices and insert the CD in your computer, then Launch "smartvideo.exe"
- 3. Click "Next" as necessary and then "Finish"
- 4. Simply plug your video sampling card into any USB 2.0 port on your computer. The hardware will install automatically and a notification will appear confirming your device is ready to use.
- 5. To use the magnifier, launch the multi video software (it will be in your programs folder under smartvideo direction path), then move the Mouse Magnifier over the material you wish to read and it will be displayed on the main menu of the software main interface window.
- 6. Use "Plus" & "Minus" keys to adjust the magnifying power (2x to 32x)
- 7. Use "M" to choose Color, Black on White, White on Black or High Contrast mode
- 8. Use the "*" (Image Lock) button to 'freeze' an image for extended viewing
