Be sure the temperature inside the vehicle is between +45°C and 0°C before turning your unit on.



❖ Getting started

Q10 receiver is an automotive grade set top box able to receive free to air DVB-T Television.

Turn the unit on


- Please wait until frame ① will be shown on the screen .
- > press [OK] button to start the automatic channel search.

To stop the search press the EXIT button. Frame② will be shown on the screen. Press [OK] to confirm stop search or the [EXIT] button to resume it.

At the end of the scan phase, frame 3 will be shown on the screen.

> Press [OK] button to save the channels on the TV LIST. The first channel on the updated TV LIST will be shown on the screen.

If at the end of the scan phase frame (a) is shown on the screen, check the connections and the overall installation of the receiver, then press in sequence [EXIT], [SCAN] and [OK] buttons to restart the scan phase.

First Use

TV ANTENNAS

Recommendations

Use only active antennas amplified with adequate gain directly powered by the receiver antenna connectors and suitable to the reception of the Digital Terrestrial signal (DVB-T).

Quantum Antennas, linked together with Q10 receiver, have been manufactured in order to optimize the system's functioning.

WARNING: ONLY use Quantum antenna provided. Use of different antenna or external power may result in product damage and might affect the warranty terms.



- Be sure to position the antennas as far away and opposing from each other as possible. For example, place the first antenna on the right side of the wind screen of the vehicle① and the second one on the left side of the rear window② or on the left rear vent wing③.
- Antennas must be installed as far away from the metal parts (vehicle's roof or vertical borders of the wind screen/rear vent wing) as possible.
- Placing the antenna in the bonnet or the boot (depending on the vehicle) can influence the signal reception. It's recommend to experiment firstly where to place the antennas; whether on the higher or the lower part of the window. The higher part usually guarantees more protection from noises caused by motorcycles and scooters.
- Handle with care the coaxial cable setting in order = to avoid damages due to vibration or crushing.
- Be sure that the connections have been correctly set and check the screwing of the connectors. Signal reception's problems are often caused by incorrect assembly.









Autotracking and Autosearch

These innovative automatic functions enable the receiver to still be in tune with the selected channel while on the move.

Typical DTT Networks are Multi Frequency Network (MFN); each TV channel may be transmitted at different frequencies depending on the specific geographical area.

Once a specific TV channel has been selected, the Autotracking and Autosearch functions will tune, track and in some cases automatically search for a channel where there is a frequency change or signal loss without the need of manually starting a new search.

To have the Autotracking and Autosearch functions performing in the best possible way, it is recommended to carefully follow the instructions below:

- **1.Start an autoscan** tune into the available channels in that specific area by pressing [SCAN] ①
- **2.Create a FAVOURITE TV LIST (from menu) -** define and organize the list of your favourite channels ②
- **3. Select the FAVOURITE TV LIST as default** ③ If the Autosearch function does not permit tuning into all favourite channels, start the operations described at the point 1 and 2 again but in another location.

WARNING: channels marked in red are temporarily not available due to the lack of network coverage ④.

How to switch the receiver on

Depending on the specific car installation, the receiver will be switched on as soon as the car key turns on the battery. In case an external a/v source was previously activated, please use the $[\Phi]$ button on the remote control Φ to exit stand-by mode.


How to select a channel

A TV or Radio channel can be selected in three different modes:

- DIRECT: select the desired channel by using the numerical buttons (S)
- USING ARROWS: select the desired channel by using the up/down buttons [▲] and [▼]② and press [OK]③ to confirm the selection.

INFORMATION BAR will be previewed on the screen® before the channel tuning.

• USING PROGRAM BUTTONS: press [P+] [P-]® to browse directly through channels without using the [OK]® button.



USE SPECIFIED ACCESSORY PARTS

Route the electrical and audio/video cables and wiring away from moving parts or sharp/pointed edges. This will prevent crimping and damage to the wiring. If wiring passes through a metal hole, use a rubber grommet to prevent the wires' insulation from being cut by the metal edge of the hole



How to select a channel in a TV/Radio List

- Press [LIST] ① to show the TV List
- > Press [GREEN] to switch between the general TV LIST and the FAVOURITE TV LIST if previously preset [see MENU]
- Press [TV/RADIO] (yellow) to show the RADIO LIST
- > Press the same button to switch between the Radio List or the previously selected TV LIST
- Select the desired channel

WARNING: channels marked in red are temporarily not available due to lack of network coverage ®

How to adjust the volume level

The volume level can be adjusted by using the [VOL+] [VOL-] buttons

Mute

• Press [MUTE] \$\infty\$ to switch on/off the audio output

How to view program info



The receiver enables the user to connect an external audio/video source (e.g. Videogame console, DVD player, etc..) to an audio/video input (as shown on page 17) using the remote control

• How to select audio/video input:

Using the Power button of the remote control $\, \oplus \,$ the user may switch from a digital TV signal to an external source signal and viceversa.







How to manage the Favourite Tv List

It is possible to create a personal favourite TV List. TV LIST and RADIO LIST include all the tuned channels which cannot be personalised.

1. How to create the Favourite Tv List:

- Press [MENU] ②
- Select TV LIST and press [OK] 4 to confirm
- Select CREATE and press [OK] 4 to confirm
- Browse the list sequentially by using the up and down buttons [▲][▼]⑤, or in groups of six channels by using right and left buttons [◀][▶]⑥ and select the channel
- Press [OK] ⊕ to confirm the selection. A tick signal ✓ will be shown next to the selected channel ②
- If you want to cancel the selection press [OK]
 ⊕ again and the tick mark ✓ will be deleted

2. How to delete a channel from the Favourite Tv List:

Follow the same procedure as shown in point 1 above and replace CREATE with DELETE.

3. How to sort the Favourite Tv List:

- Press [MENU] ②
- Select TV LIST and press [OK] @to confirm
- Select SORT and press [OK] @to confirm
- Browse the list sequentially by using the up and down buttons [▲][▼]⑤ or in groups of six channels by using the right and left buttons[◀][▶]③ and select the channel you want to move
- Browse the list in the same way and click on the position where you want to move the selected channel. A tick mark will be shown next to the selected channel
- Press [OK] 4 to confirm the new position of the channel 8

4. How to delete the Favourite Tv List:

Follow the same procedure as shown in point 1 above and replace CREATE with ERASE $\,$



How to navigate the Settings Menu

- Press [MENU] 2 to view the main menu on the screen
- Select SETTINGS by using the right and left [↓] [▶] ③ buttons.
- Press OK to enter this sub-menu and then press it again till you get the required item
- Select the desired function firstly by using the right and left buttons [↓] [▶] ③ and then the up and down [▲] [▼] ④ buttons
- Press [OK] to confirm the selection and to move to the next function or [EXIT] to cancel the selection
