安全與保養

注意事項

- 液晶體面板 液晶體面板為玻璃製造,若不慎掉落地面可能會碎裂。
 把機體放在穩定的平面上。
- 熱源 保持產品遠離熱源,例如散熱器、爐灶、暖爐和其他發熱產品。
- 水和濕氣 切勿將產品置於水中、靠近水或類似浴室等濕氣重的地方。

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產品保養

- 將電話放置在遠離濕、熱或太陽曝曬之處。

開始操作

連接AC 變壓器 / 電話線

將變壓器和電話線插入插槽插座中。這兩者的位置應距離電話不遠。 將 AC 變壓器和電話線連接至底座。



將手機放在底座的托架中充電。使用前先為手機充電 15 小時。

安裝手機電池

手機使用 3 顆 NiMH 750 mAh 1.2V (AAA)可充電電池(獨立包裝)。 警告:若誤放其它類別的電池可能會產生爆炸的風險。根據指示丢棄 已使用的電池。

安裝手機電池:

1. 滑下電池蓋。

2. 如圖所示,配合兩極方向(+ 和 -)插入電池。

3. 放回蓋子,聽到卡嗒聲後,表示已牢固滑回原位。



爲手機電池充電

使用手機前,必需將之先充電 15 小時。 1.欲為手機充電:將手機放在底座的托架上。

2. [__]→[■] 將閃爍,表示手機正在充電中。

3. 電池完全充電後,電池圖標將停止閃爍,並將顯示 [12]。

欲繫上皮帶夾,將其固定在所在 的位置:

欲解除,把鉤鬆開及移除:

提示 若無法用手撥開皮帶夾,可使用類似螺絲起子(未隨附)等薄的 鈍器。小心不要刮傷手機的表面。





電池耗盡





基本功能

手機將在無作業一段時間後,進入睡眠模式,而液晶體背光燈和按鍵 燈也將關閉。按任何鍵返回待機模式。將啓動液晶體背光燈和按鍵 燈,並指示為待機模式。

欲調整從待機模式切換至睡眠模式的時間,請參考變更顯示設定 - 背 光燈設定。

註:若已開啓按鍵鎖,閣下必須先行解除電話鎖,才能進入待機模 式。

註:當撥打或接聽電話時,拿起手機並將其上方(接收器)置於耳 邊,然後再說話。 一旦接收器接觸閣下的耳朵,機體的智慧型按鍵鎖 將自動鎖住手機的按鍵。閣下可把手機的下方(麥克風)置於唇邊, 對著麥克風說話。小心處理手機,避免意外觸控到按鍵。若遇困難, 亦可使用手動按鍵鎖(詳情參閱「智慧型按鍵鎖」段落)。

智慧型按鍵鎖和手動按鍵鎖

智慧型按鍵鎖避免在通話時意外啓動按鍵。手機上方內的感應器面板 (即接收器的位置)將感應到閣下的耳朵碰到接收器,並自動啓動按鍵 墊。為確保已啓動智慧型按鍵鎖,在對著手機麥克風說話前,請先將 手機接收器置於耳邊,並在手機接收器置於耳邊前,避免手指碰到按 鍵墊。一旦手機接受器離開閣下的耳朵,智慧型按鍵鎖將停止運作。

欲啓動/停止啓動智慧型按鍵鎖:

手機與底座已預先在工廠彼此註冊。因此,產品拆封後應馬上就能使 用。當閣下添購手機時,須向底座註冊,以便撥打和接聽電話。 閣下 最多可再註冊3個手機,以便透過相同的底座撥打和接聽電話。手機 的排序為1至4。

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handset microphone and avoid touching the keypad with your fingers until the handset receiver rests on your ear. Smart Key Lock will disengage as soon as you remove the handset receiver from your ear.

To activate / deactivate smart key lock:

- 1. Go to Phone Setting > Smart Key Lock.
- 2. Use \Lambda and 💙 to select 'ON' / 'OFF'.
- 3. Touch **menu** to confirm.

A manual key lock can also be activated to prevent the accidental triggering of keys during standby mode or sleep mode.

To activate / deactivate manual key lock:

In standby mode touch menu then immediately touch *. Sindicates key lock is activated.

NOTE Only the menu key functions during key lock stage. However, upon receiving an incoming call the **TALK** key will be automatically unlocked to enable the answering of the call. Key lock is temporarily deactivated when an emergency number is dialled and the talk key is pressed.

BABY CALL

Baby call allows you to set a number to automatically dial when any key (apart from **m∈nu**) is touched. To de-activate baby call repeat steps 1 to 3, selecting 'OFF' instead of 'ON'

To set baby call:

- 1. Go to Phone Settings > Baby Call.
- 2. Use \Lambda and 🗸 to select 'ON'.
- 3. Touch **menu** to confirm.
- 4. Use 0 9 to enter the baby call number. Touch $\frac{clear}{f}$ to delete numbers if an error is made.
- 5. Touch **menu** to confirm.

AUTO ANSWER

Incoming calls are answered automatically when lifting the handset from the cradle when auto answer is activated.

To activate auto answer:

- 1. Go to Phone Setting > Auto Answer.
- 2. Use ▲ and ∨ to select 'ON'.
- 3. Touch **menu** to confirm.

CLOCK AND ALARM SETTINGS

To set the time:

- 1. Go to Time Setting > Clock Setting.
- Use 0 9 to enter the time. (Use # to toggle AM / PM if 12 hour display format is selected).
- 3. Touch **MENU** to confirm.

To change time display format:

- 1. Go to Time Setting > Display Format.
- 2. Use \Lambda and 🗸 to select 12 / 24 hour format.
- 3. Touch **menu** to confirm.
- 4. Use \Lambda and 💙 to select day-month format.
- 5. Touch **menu** to confirm.

To set the alarm:

- 1. Go to Time Setting > Alarm Setting.
- 2. Use \Lambda and 💙 to select 'ON'.
- 3. Touch **menu** to confirm.
- 4. Use 0 9 to enter alarm time.
- 5. Touch **menu** to confirm.

NOTE O indicates alarm is set.

MESSAGE WAITING

If you have a message service with your phone network activated and you have a message waiting:

- M will appear on the screen.
- The base unit LED will flash.

NOTE Will disappear and the LED will stop flashing automatically once all messages have been checked and deleted.

NOTE You must subscribe to this service from your local telephone company.

To manually clear the message waiting indicators:

- 1. Go to Security Set > Clear Msg Wait.
- 2. Use \wedge and \vee to select 'YES'.
- 3. Touch **menu** to confirm.
- 4. 'SUCCESS' indicates that base has been selected. 'RETRY?' indicates that selection has failed. Touch
 to retry or
 to quit.

PAGING THE HANDSET

· To page the handset from the base unit press PAGE.

USING MULTIPLE BASE UNITS/HANDSETS

You can use up to 4 base units and 4 handsets.

To select a base unit on your handset:

- 1. Go to Security Set > Select Base.
- 2. Use ▲ and ▲ to select the base number or 'AUTO' (automatically selects the nearest base).
- 3. Touch **menu** to confirm.
- 4. 'SUCCESS' indicates that base has been selected. 'RETRY?' indicates that selection has failed. Touch **(** to retry or **(** to quit.

REGISTRATION

The handset and base unit are factory pre-registered with each other. Therefore, the unit should be in full working order out of the box. When you purchase an additional handset, you have to register it to the base unit in order to make and answer calls.

You can register up to 3 more handsets to make and answer calls via the same base unit. Handsets are numbered 1 to 4.

To register a new handset:

- 1. Go to Security Set > Registration.
- 2. Use \wedge or \vee to select the handset number for registration.
- 3. Touch **menu** to confirm.
- 4. Use 0 9 to enter the default PIN number "0000".

- 5. Touch **menu** to confirm. Press and hold **PAGE** at the base for 3 seconds, until the in-use light begins to flash.
- 6. Wait for handset to register with the base unit.
- 7. 'REGISTRATION SUCCESS' indicates that handset is registered. 'RETRY?' indicates that registration has failed. Touch
 to retry or to quit.

NOTE The base unit will then send a signal to the handset registering the handset to the base unit. Once the Registration function has been completed, the handset will return to Standby Mode.

To de-register a handset:

- 1. Go to Security Set > Deregistration.
- 2. Use \wedge or \vee to select the handset number for de-registration.
- Touch m∈nu to confirm. Wait for handset to de-register from the base unit.
- 4. 'DEREGISTRATION SUCCESS' indicates that handset is de-registered.

USING MULTIPLE HANDSETS

To make an internal call:

- 1. Touch int
- Use ∧ or ∨ or directly enter handset number to select the handset you wish to call.

3. Touch **M**.

NOTE

- Internal calls are answered identically to external calls (see Basic Functions).
- If an external call is received during an internal call touch **()** to termnate the internal call and answer the external call.

To transfer an ongoing call:

- 1. Touch int
- 2. Use \wedge or \vee to select a handset to transfer to.
- 3. Touch 🥅 .
- 4. Touch **(**) or place the handset in the base unit once the other handset has answered.

To establish a conference call:

- 1. When connecting to the external line by making or answering a call, touch **int**.
- Use ▲ or ▲ and then press or directly press handset number to select a handset for conference.
- When the other handset answers the intercom paging, the line will switch to internal call and the external line will be put on hold.
- 4. Press # key to establish the conference call.

To assign a name to a handset:

- 1. Go to Phone Setting > Handset Name.
- 2. Use 0 9 to enter a name.
- 3. Touch menu to confirm.

RESET

To reset the handset default settings:

- 1. Go to Set Default.
- 2. Use \bigwedge and \checkmark to select 'YES'.
- 3. Touch **menu** to confirm.

NOTE Restoring the default settings will delete all information stored and preferences set.
