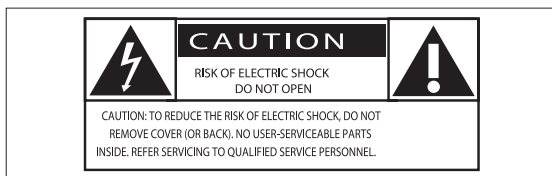

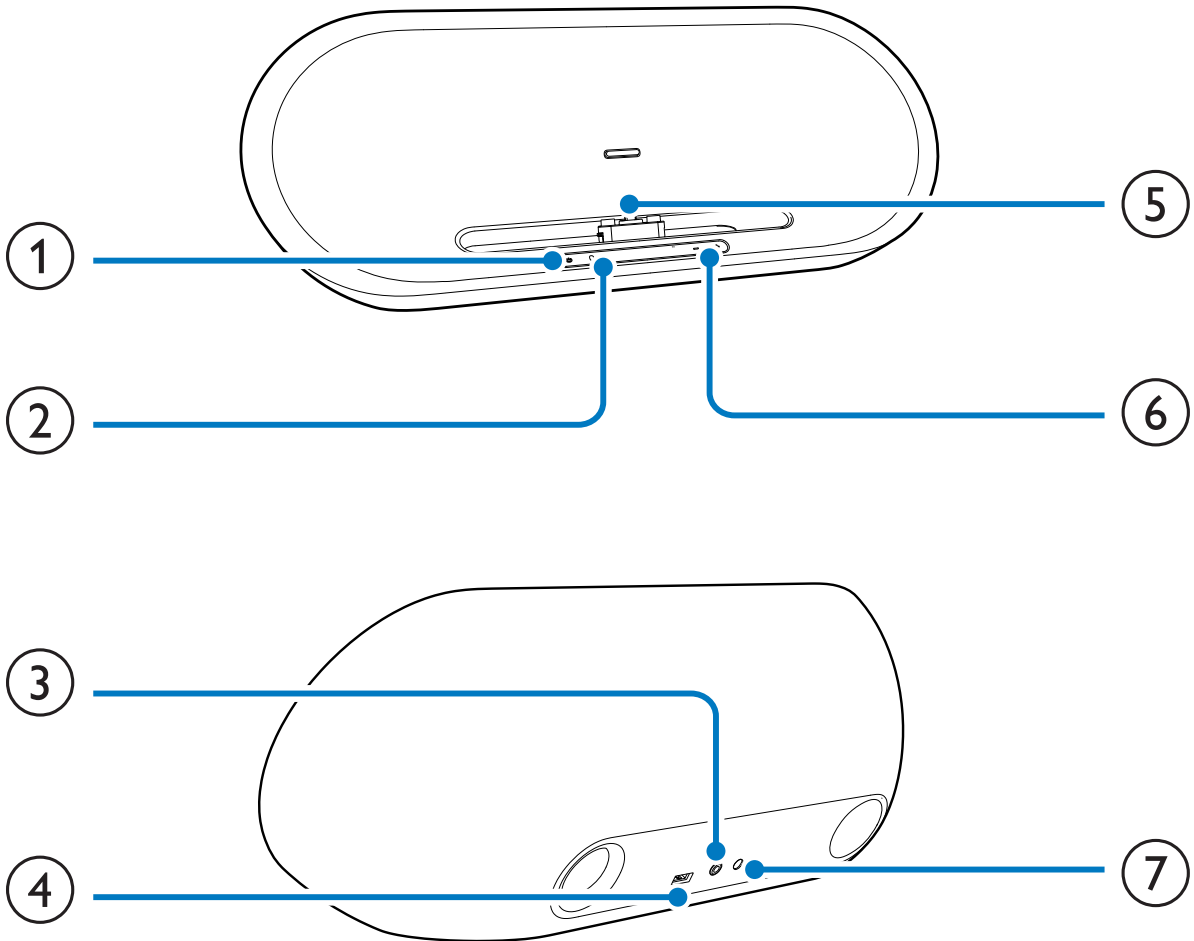

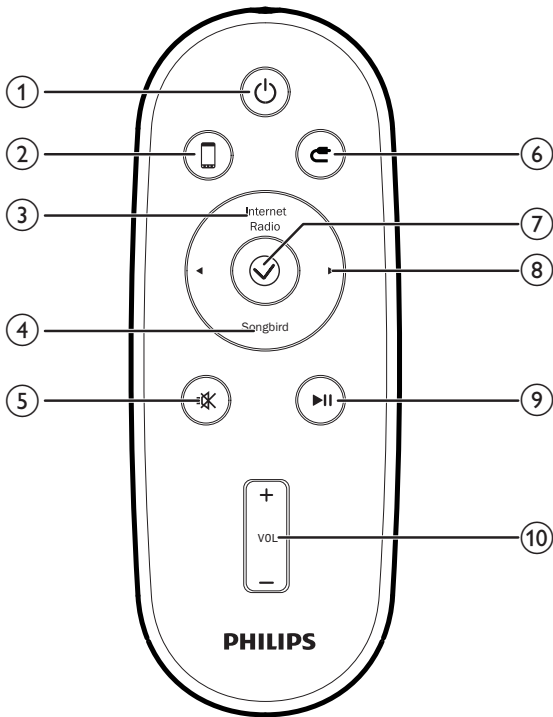

## Connect power

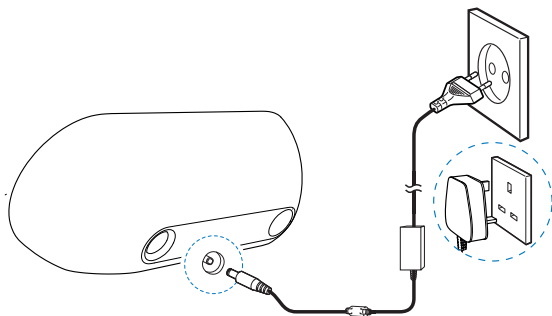
### ! Caution

## Prepare the remote control

## Turn on

- ↳ The Bluetooth indicator  $\star$  on the display panel begins to blink.

## Switch to standby mode

Press  $\phi$  again to switch the docking speaker to standby mode.

- ↳ The Bluetooth indicator  $\star$  on the display panel goes off.

## Charge your portable device

When the docking speaker is connected to power, the portable device starts charging automatically.
