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New York Approved Tests

The New York Approved Tests application is part of the ARUP Connect applications available to ARUP clients on the Internet. You can access this feature by logging in to ARUP Connect using your user name and password, and then selecting **NY Approved Tests** from the **Order Management** menu. The following window is displayed. Here you can search for a specific test or view a list of all New York Approved tests.

Note: You will need to call ARUP Client Services for information on New York approved HIV testing.



Find a Test

In the **Test Number or Mnemonic** field type the number or mnemonic of the test you want to look up and then click **Check Status**. The test number and name are displayed along with a message saying either "Not NY Approved" or "NY DOH Approved" as seen in the following example.
