

### UNPACKING

Once your Pegasus Touch has arrived and you have removed the unit from the box, you will need to do the following to prepare the machine (wire cutters or scissors required):

- 1. Remove all wrapping and packaging material from the exterior.
- 2. Remove the resin tray (vat) from the vat holder.
- 3. Cut the zip tie restraining the vat holder.
- 4. Check that the resin tray is clean and all plastic wrap is removed.
- 5. Keep original shipping container and packaging in case of repair.



#### Inspect the interior and exterior of the printer for damage.

## STARTING UP

In order to make sure you're running the latest and greatest software and firmware, please do the following when you power the printer on for the first time:

- 1. Connect your printer to your local network via Ethernet.
  - a. Your PC should be connected to the same network.
  - b. Your network should be connected to the internet.
- 2. If you haven't already, download RetinaCreate from fsl3d.com.
- 3. Power on your printer and launch RetinaCreate.
- 4. If your software is up to date, you'll see a green readiness button in RetinaCreate If your software is out of date, you will be prompted to download updates
- 5. Apply any updates.
- 6. Once updates are complete, power cycle the printer and you're ready to go.
