



This unit is an additional handset for use with the following Panasonic Digital Cordless Phones: KX-TG7200/KX-TG7220

You must register this handset with your base unit before it can be used. This installation manual describes only the steps needed to register and begin using the handset. Please read the base unit's operating instructions for further details.

Charge the batteries for about 7 hours before initial use.

Please read this installation manual before using the unit and save it for future reference.





*1 The handset cover comes attached to the handset.

Note:

- Please read the base unit's operating instructions for additional/replacement accessories
- This equipment is designed for use in the UK and Republic of Ireland.
- In the event of problems, you should contact your equipment supplier in the first instance.

Important information

General

- Use only the AC adaptor supplied with this product.
- Do not connect the AC adaptor to any AC outlet other than a standard 220-240 V AC outlet.
- This product is unable to make calls when:
- the portable handset battery(ies) need recharging or have failed.
- there is a power failure.
- the key lock feature is turned on.
- Do not open the charger or handset other than to replace the battery(ies).
- This product should not be used near emergency/intensive care medical equipment and should not be used by people with pacemakers.
 Care should be taken that objects do not fall onto, and liquids are not spilled
- Care should be taken that objects do not fall onto, and liquids are not spiller into, the product. Do not subject this product to excessive smoke, dust, mechanical vibration or shock.




- Do not use this product near water.
- This product should be kept away from heat sources such as radiators, cookers, etc. It should also not be placed in rooms where the temperature is less than 5 °C or greater than 40 °C.
- The AC adaptor is used as the main disconnect device. Ensure that the AC outlet is installed near the product and is easily accessible.

Warning:

- To prevent the risk of electrical shock, do not expose this product to rain or any other type of moisture.
- Unplug this product from power outlets if it emits smoke, an abnormal smell, or makes unusual noise. These conditions can cause fire or electric shock. Confirm that smoke has stopped emitting and contact an authorised service
- Do not place or use this product near automatically controlled devices such as automatic doors and fire alarms. Radio waves emitted from this product may cause such devices to malfunction resulting in an accident.
- Regularly remove any dust, etc. from the AC adaptor/power plug by pulling it from the power outlet, then wiping with a dry cloth. Accumulated dust may cause an insulation defect from moisture, etc. resulting in a fire.
- Do not damage the power cord/plug. This may cause a short circuit, electric shock, and/or fire.
- Do not touch the plug with wet hands.

- We recommend using the supplied battery(ies) or additional/replacement battery(ies) noted in the base unit's operating instructions. Use only rechargeable battery(ies).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not dispose of the battery(ies) in a fire, as they may explode. Check with local waste management codes for special disposal instructions.
- Do not open or mutilate the battery(ies). Released electrolyte from the battery(ies) is corrosive and may cause burns or injury to the eyes or skin. The electrolyte may be toxic if swallowed.
- Exercise care when handling the battery(ies). Do not allow conductive materials such as rings, bracelets or keys to touch the battery(ies), otherwise a short circuit may cause the battery(ies) and/or the conductive material to overheat and cause burns.
- Charge the battery(ies) provided with or identified for use with this product only in accordance with the instructions and limitations specified in this manual.

The AC adaptor must remain connected at all times. (It is normal for the adaptor to feel warm during use.)


Location

- For maximum distance and noise-free operation, place your base unit:
- away from electrical appliances such as TVs, radios, personal computers, or other phones.
- in a convenient, high, and central location.

Battery installation/Battery charge

Important:

- Use only the supplied rechargeable batteries noted on page 2, 3.
- USE ONLY rechargeable Ni-MH batteries AAA (R03) size.
- Do NOT use Alkaline/Manganese/Ni-Cd batteries.
- \bullet Ensure correct polarities $(\stackrel{\bullet}{\bigoplus}, \mathrel{\bigcirc})$ when installing the batteries.
- Wipe the battery ends (⊕, ⊝) with a dry cloth.
- When installing the batteries, avoid touching the battery ends (⊕, ⊕) or the unit contacts.
- 1 Press the notch on the handset cover firmly and slide it in the direction of the
- **2** Insert the batteries negative (\bigcirc) end first. Close the handset cover.
- 3 Place the handset on the charger for about 7 hours before initial use.



Note:

- \bullet The handset display may show "Please Wait..." when the handset is placed on the charger if it is not registered to a base unit.
- If you fully charged the batteries, but the operating time seems to be short, wipe the battery ends (\bigoplus, \bigcirc) and the unit contacts with a dry cloth.









Ensure that the handset is switched on. If it is not on, press and hold [> 0] for few seconds to turn the handset on.

- $\boldsymbol{1}$ Lift the handset and press [$\boldsymbol{\nearrow} \boldsymbol{0}$]. Place the handset on the base unit.
 - Continue the operation even when the handset display shows "Please Wait...".
- 2 Proceed with the operation for your model.

■ KX-TG7200

Press and hold (1)) on the base unit for about 5 seconds. (No registration tone)



■ KX-TG7220

Press and hold [•))] on the base unit for about 5 seconds, until the registration tone sounds.







3 With the handset still on the base unit, wait until a confirmation tone sounds and **Y** stops flashing.


Note:

- If an error tone sounds, or if ♥ is still flashing, register the handset according to the base unit's operating instructions.
- If all registered handsets start ringing in step 2, press [***)] to stop. Start again from step 1.
- The KX-TG7200 does not feature an answering system.
- Answering system features are available only when this handset is registered to the KX-TG7220.






