PAIRING

Bluetooth enabled PDA

"Pairing" means creating a trusted relationship between two or more Bluetooth devices. The devices must be paired before they can communicate with each other. Pairing identification is stored for later use, and the devices will automatically recognize each other the next time they are connected. The NUV2815S/NUV2815B will store up to 7 device IDs in memory, although it can only connect to one device at a time.

Note: Make sure the NUV2815S/NUV2815B is "off" before starting the Pairing procedure.

How to pair with cellphones 1. Place the NUV2815S/NUV2815B within 1 foot of the device to be paired with.



- 3. The red LED indicator on NUV2815S/NUV2815B will stop flashing when pairing is successful.



When connecting the NUV2815S/NUV2815B to another music source via the 3.5mm jack, the Bluetooth function will be cancelled. The NUV2815S/NUV2815B will not operate as a handsfree device.

Note: In order to save power, please unplug the audio cable when not in use.

LOW-POWER PROMPT The red LED will flash when the power level is low. Please recharge the unit.



STEREO MUSIC After pairing with a Bluetooth device that supports the A2DP profile, such as a PC or a cellphone, the music output of those devices will be transmitted to the NUV2815S/NUV2815B and the music play can be controlled from the NUV2815S/NUV2815B (please refer to the attached control overview).

ANSWERING/ENDING PHONE CALLS If you are playing music from the cellphone, the music play will be paused when there is an incoming call. A beep tone will also be heard to notify that there is an incoming call. Press the MFC once to answer the call and press it once again to end the call. When the call is ended, the music play will be automatically resumed.
