

Charging the Battery

When you first get your new phone you'll need to charge the battery.

Connect the adapter to the charger jack.



- 2. Connect the charger to a standard AC wall outlet.
- Disconnect the charger when the battery is fully charged.

Powering On/Off

Make sure the SIM card is in your phone and the battery is charged.

- Press and hold the **Power Key** to turn on your phone.

 The transit off process and hold the **Power Key** to turn on your phone.
- To turn it off, press and hold the Power Key to open the options menu. Touch Power off and then touch OK.

Waking Up Your Phone

Your phone automatically goes into sleep mode when it is not in use for some time. The display is turned off to save power and the keys are locked to prevent accidental operations.

You can wake up your phone by turning on the display and unlocking the keys.

- 1. Press the Power Key to turn the screen on.
- 2. Touch and hold at the center of the screen.

buttons, simply touch them with your finger.

To open the available options for an item (for example, a message or link in a Web page), touch

and hold the item.

- To swipe or slide means to quickly drag your finger vertically or horizontally across the screen.

- To drag, press and hold your finger with some pressure before you start to move your finger. While dragging, do not release your finger until you have reached the target position.

- Rotate the screen
 For most screens, you can automatically change
