II. BASIC OPERATIONS RELATED WITH TABLET USAGE

1. Starting the device

To start the device press and hold for few seconds POWER button (marked with  symbol) placed on the side of device. Your battery has been partially charged at the factory, but you may need to recharge it before you can switch on your device for the first time. Connect the charger to a wall outlet, then connect the charger to the device. Do not connect incompatible products.

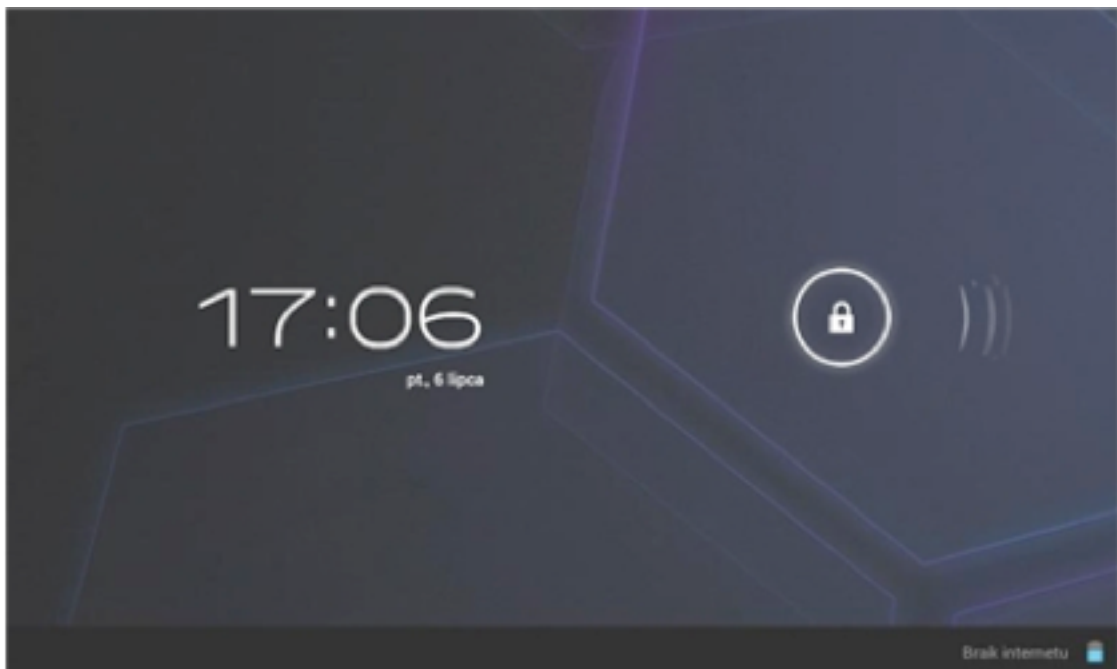
- Charging time is around 5 hours
- If you are using device during charging process, charging process will be extend.
- Use your tablet at least once a week.
- Charge the device only indoor.
- Do not store the adapter in high temperature.

As with all batteries, the capacity of the battery reduces each time it is charged/depleted. However, you can still try to prolong the battery's lifetime by following the suggestions below:

- Use your tablet at least once a week.
- Charge the battery regularly and fully.
- Never leave the battery fully discharged for a long period of time.
- Never overcharge your battery.
- Always keep the device and the battery away from heat.

2. Unlocking touch screen

After system start or after longer period of idle tablet's touch screen become locked. To unlock it drag lock symbol in the direction indicated on the device screen.



Note:

During longer period of idle, system turns into “power saving” mode automatically turning off the screen.

User can lock the screen by pressing  button.

3. Screen lock settings

Settings of screen lock can be adjusted.

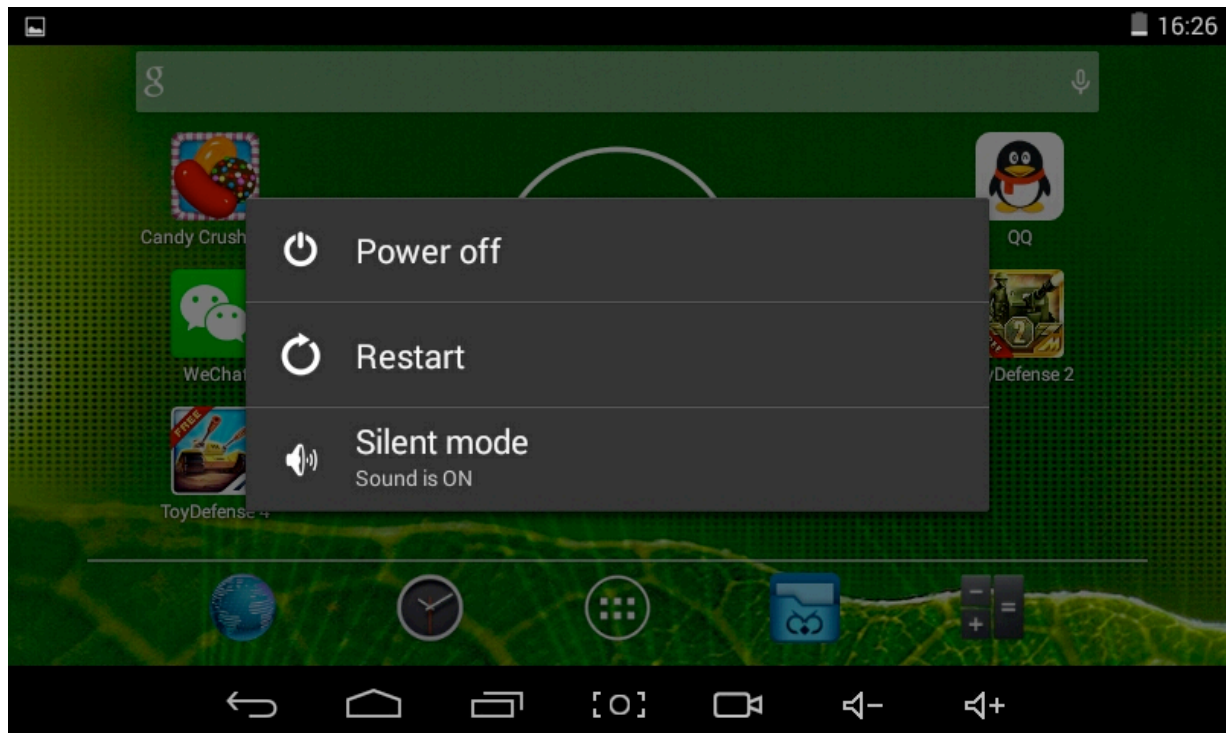
On the main screen or in All Applications screen touch Settings icon

4. Turning off the system

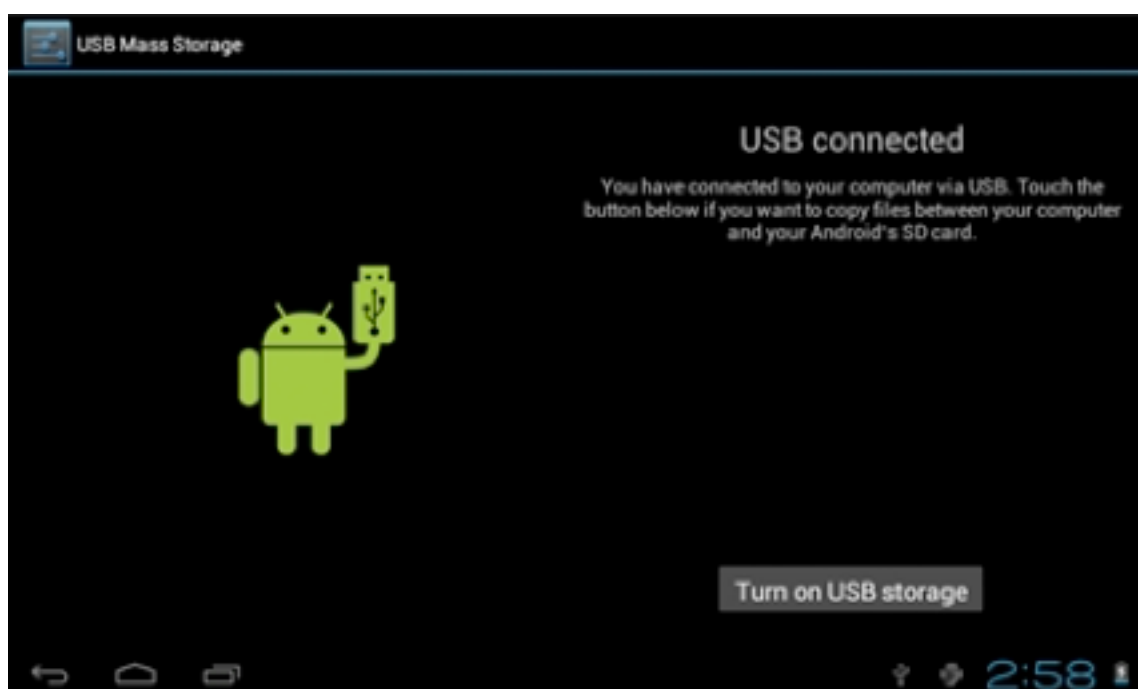
To turn off tablet, press and hold power button  then select “Power off”.



5. Connecting tablet to PC

USB connection allows to exchange files between the tablet and PC computer. This function allows to upload into device memory pictures, films, music or using tablet as portable memory. Connection can be established by using special adapter or USB cable (included with the device). When you connect tablet to a computer, there will be visible message on screen:

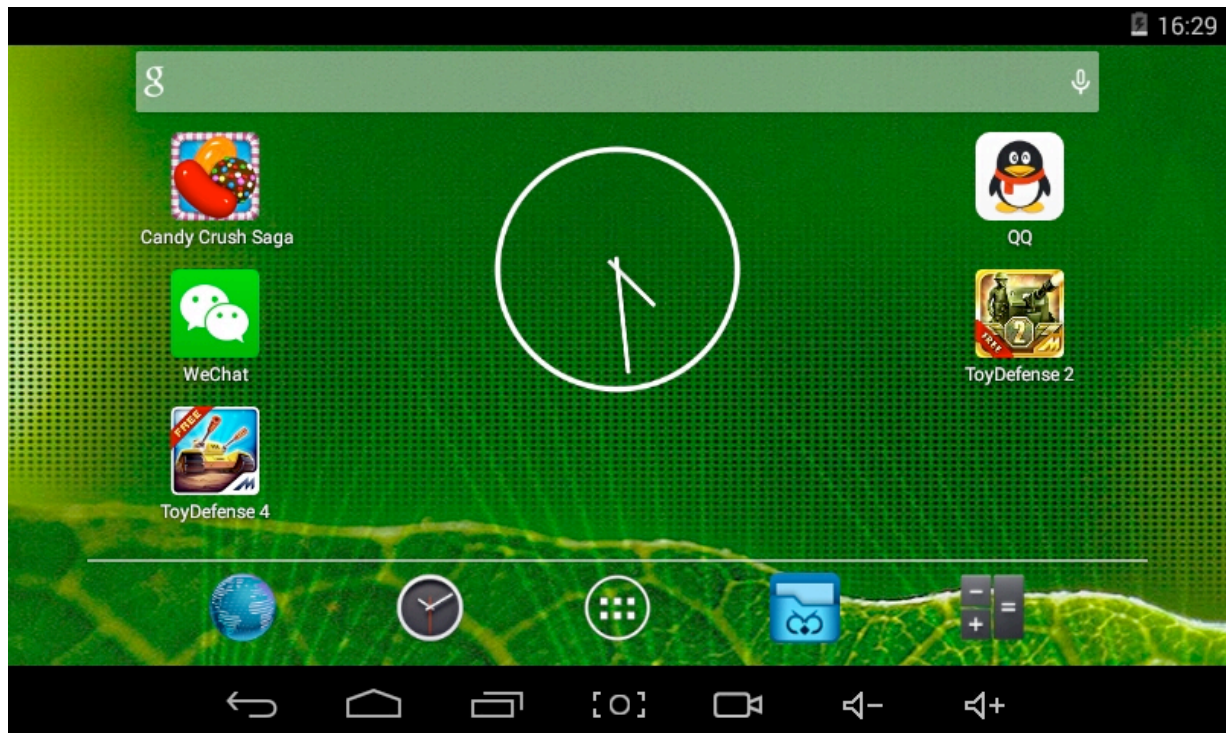
To make the connection, press **“Turn on USB storage”**

After starting the tablet the main Menu on touch screen is visible.

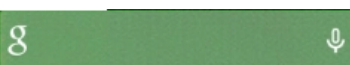
Using  button you can always turn to “MAIN MENU”



Top of the screen:



Google Browser: Allows to open internet browser along with available keyboard



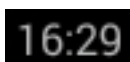
Voice Input: Allows to enter the text by voice (to use this function it is necessary to connect to the Internet)



All Applications: Icon is placed in right bottom place of the screen
Activation of the icon allows to: display installed applications, switch between applications



USB Connection: Icon is displayed when the USB port is in use.



Local Time: Displays the time preset by the user in system.



Wi-Fi Network: Icon is display when the Wi-Fi network is active.



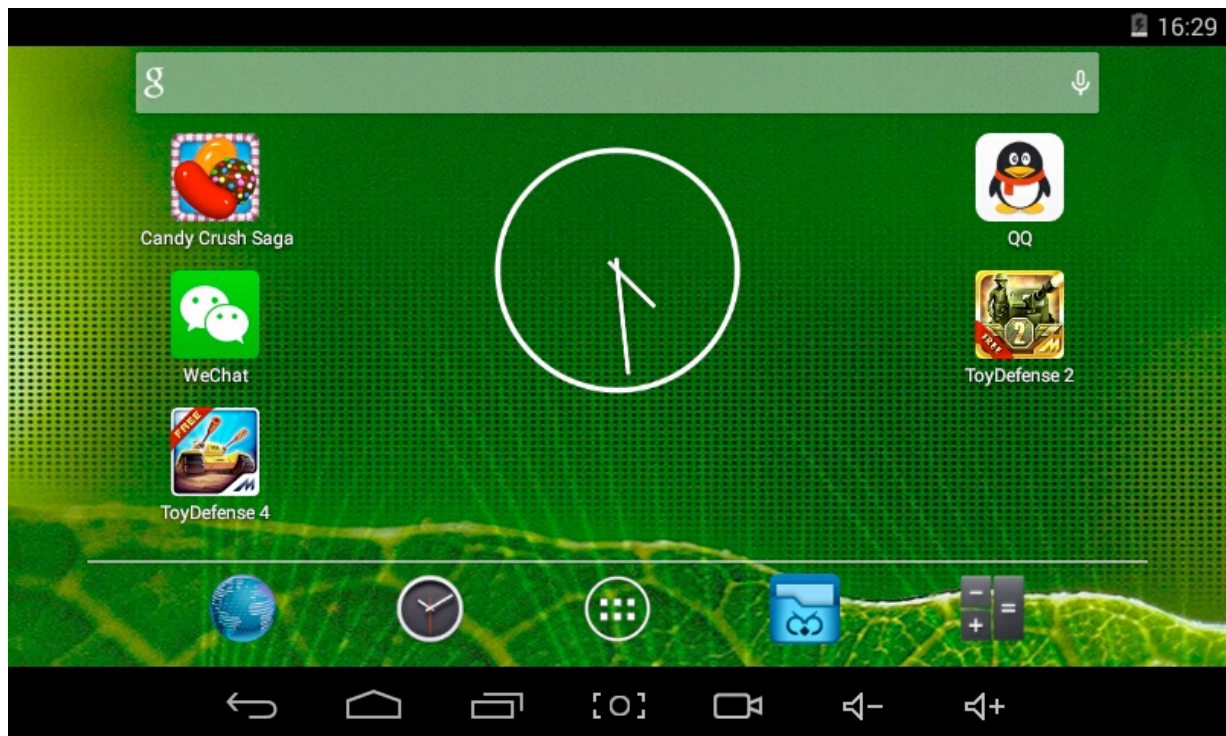
Charge Status: Icon informs about actual battery level.



Mobile Network: Icon informs about active 2G/3G mobile network connection.

Center of the screen

contains view of desktops that can be modified, adjusted to user individual needs. On desktops shortcuts to applications, widgets, folders and wallpapers can be changed.



Bottom of the screen:

there is placed status bar which contains function keys and information icons.



Back: Opens previously used screen, even if it is placed in other applications. After returning to main screen you can't go back any more.



Main Screen: Opens the main screen. If the left or right desktop is visible, the main screen is opened.



Recent Applications: Open list of thumbnails of recently used applications. To open the application touch its thumbnail. To remove thumbnail from list move it to the left or right.

1. Widgets

Widgets are usually simple applications displayed on the desktop screen. They are designated to do one certain activity, for example displaying the time, actual weather, adding

notes. Thanks to their functionality, widgets are becoming more and more popular within users as an essential part of operating system.

IV. TABLET OPERATING

1. Touch screen handling

Operation of tablets with touch screens is realized by a system of gestures.

Most of applications work with gravity sensor (the so-called G-Sensor), which allows to automatic rotation when you change the position of tablet. This feature allows you to use tablet both horizontally and vertically.



TAB

Single tap on the screen element (for example icon or button) to select it



DOUBLE TAP

Quick double tap on the screen element to start automatic zoom (text, photo etc.). Another double tap to undo an action.



LONG PRESS

Tab and holding finger to view context menu (same as right button in PC mouse)



SCROLL

Scrolling on the screen or menu with controlled speed



FLICK

Fast scrolling of menu or page



PINCH

Closing two fingers together to gradual zoom out text/picture



SPREAD

Spreading two fingers to gradually zoom in text/picture

2. Voice entering of the text

This functions uses speech recognition service, so to be able to use it, active connection with the internet by mobile network or Wi-Fi is necessary. In most of places where you input text by screen keyboard, you can also input the text by voice.

To do this you have to:

- (1) tap text field or choose place in the text
- (2) choose  on screen keyboard
- (3) after choosing the microphone icon, you can start voice entering of the text

3. Search

Google search engine (on the left top corner of screen) allows to search for all necessary information.

- (1) Select **Google** from the top left corner of screen
- (2) Using screen keyboard or microphone  enter search term

4. Adding shortcuts

You can modify desktops by adding shortcuts from the Main Menu. To do this you have to:

- (1) Choose  to display all of installed apps
- (2) Long press the chosen app icon and a window of Main Menu will pop up
- (3) Move the icon to free space then release it

5. Removing shortcuts

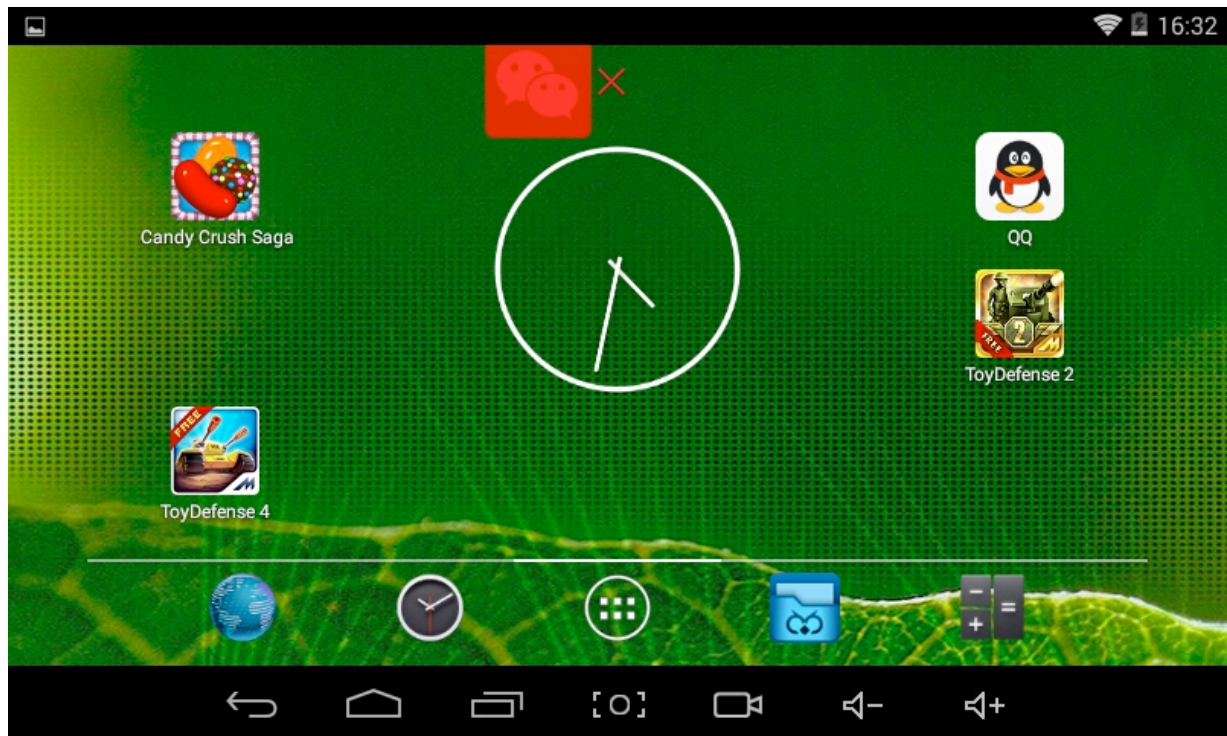
When you need to remove shortcuts form Main Menu, you have to:

- (1) Long press the icon which you want to remove.
- (2) Drag the icon to X or Trash-Bin (varies from system version) symbol to remove it

6. Removing shortcuts

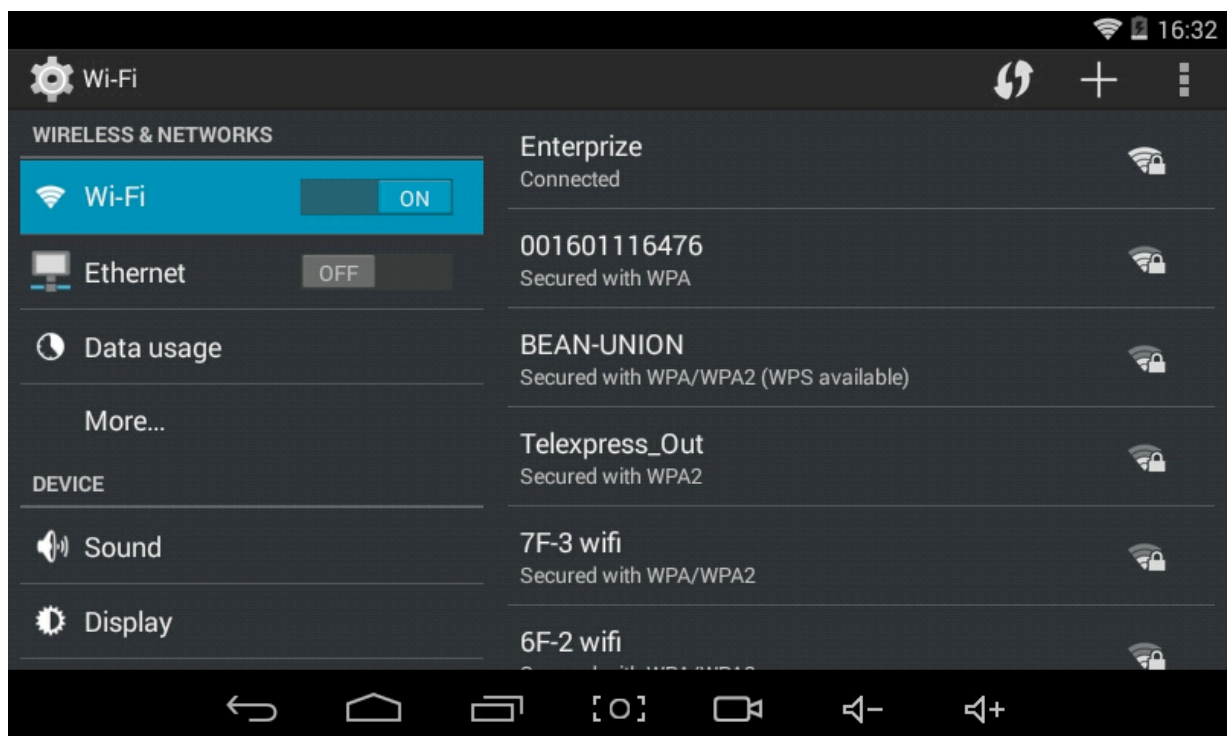
While using the tablet, a lot of unused apps can slow down the system. To close those apps you have to:

- (1) Choose  to display thumbnails of running apps
- (2) Long press the app which you want to close
- (3) Select **"Remove from List"**



V. SETTINGS

1. Wireless and network - Wi-Fi



2. Connecting with Wi-Fi network

To set menu press  icon, then to start connection with Wi-Fi access point, set Wi-Fi switch into position ON. After this procedure, scanning for available Wi-Fi networks will begin. After searching available Wi-Fi networks containing names and additional informations

concerning security will be listed. Networks that are secured will have lock icon placed near the Wi-Fi icon.

To connect to a secured Wi-Fi network you to have proper data for logging. To do this you have to:

- (1) Turn on Wi-Fi networks service
- (2) From the list of available networks choose the network with which you want to establish a connection
- (3) Select “**Add Network**” (function situated in upper right corner of the screen)
- (4) Enter the password
- (5) Select “**Connect**”

To extent the battery life of your tablet, we advise you to turn off Wi-Fi when not in use.

3. Deleting Wi-Fi settings

When you want to delete previously used network you have to:

- (1) Turn on Wi-Fi
- (2) Long press the name of the network
- (3) Select “**Forget Network**”

4. Wi-Fi advanced settings

To enter advanced Wi-Fi setting you have to:

- (1) From the main menu select Settings 
- (2) Select  placed in upper right corner of the screen
- (3) Chose “**Advanced**”

In advanced Wi-Fi settings you can change following features:

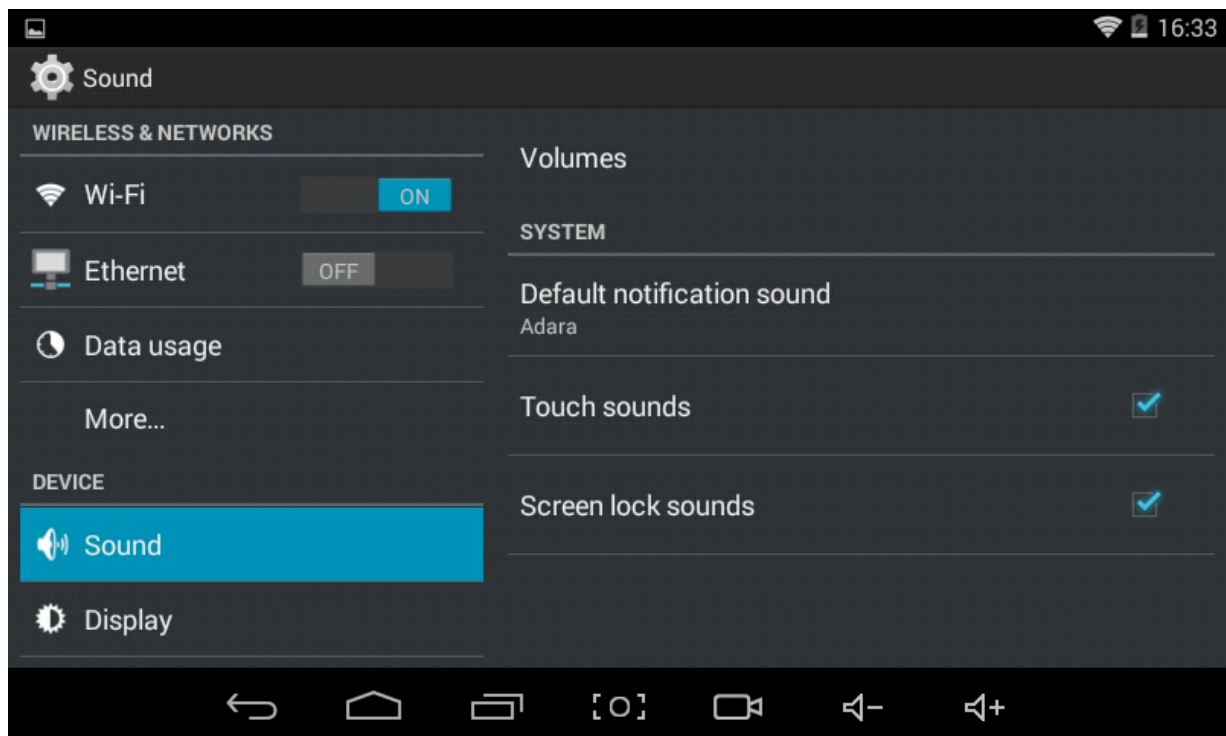

Screen contains also additional informations:

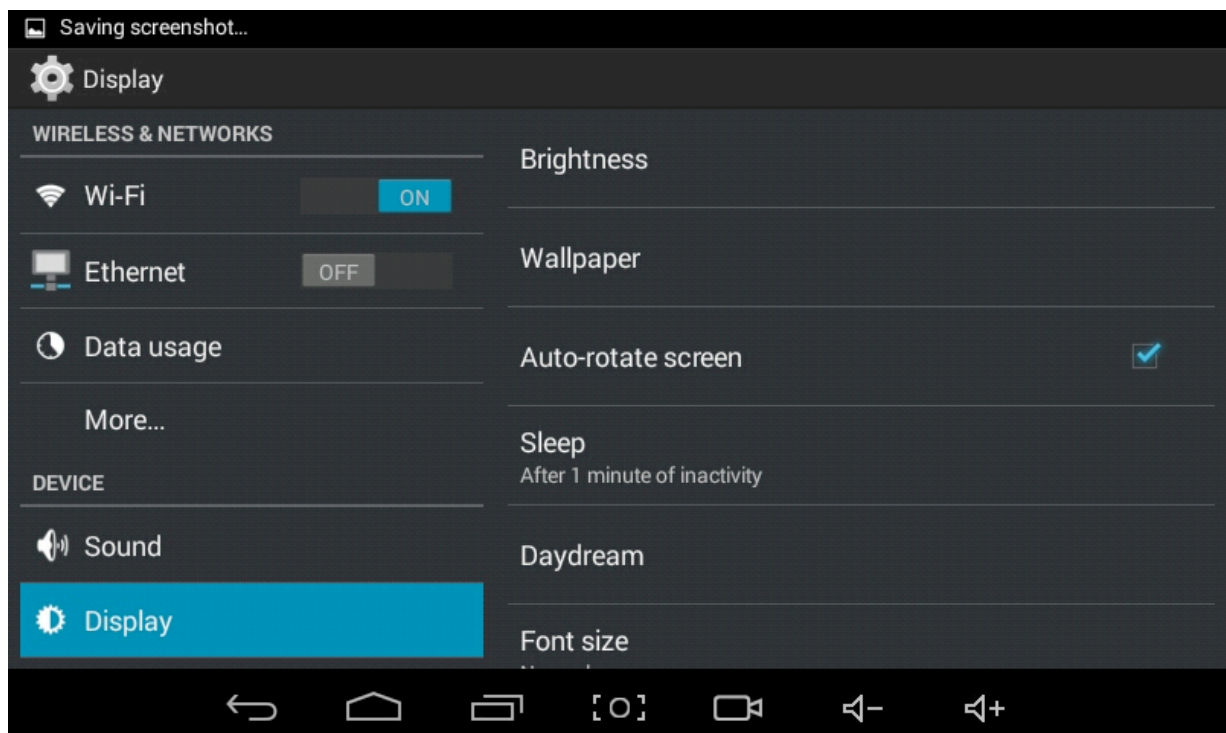
- **MAC Address:** MAC (Media Access Control) address of the device

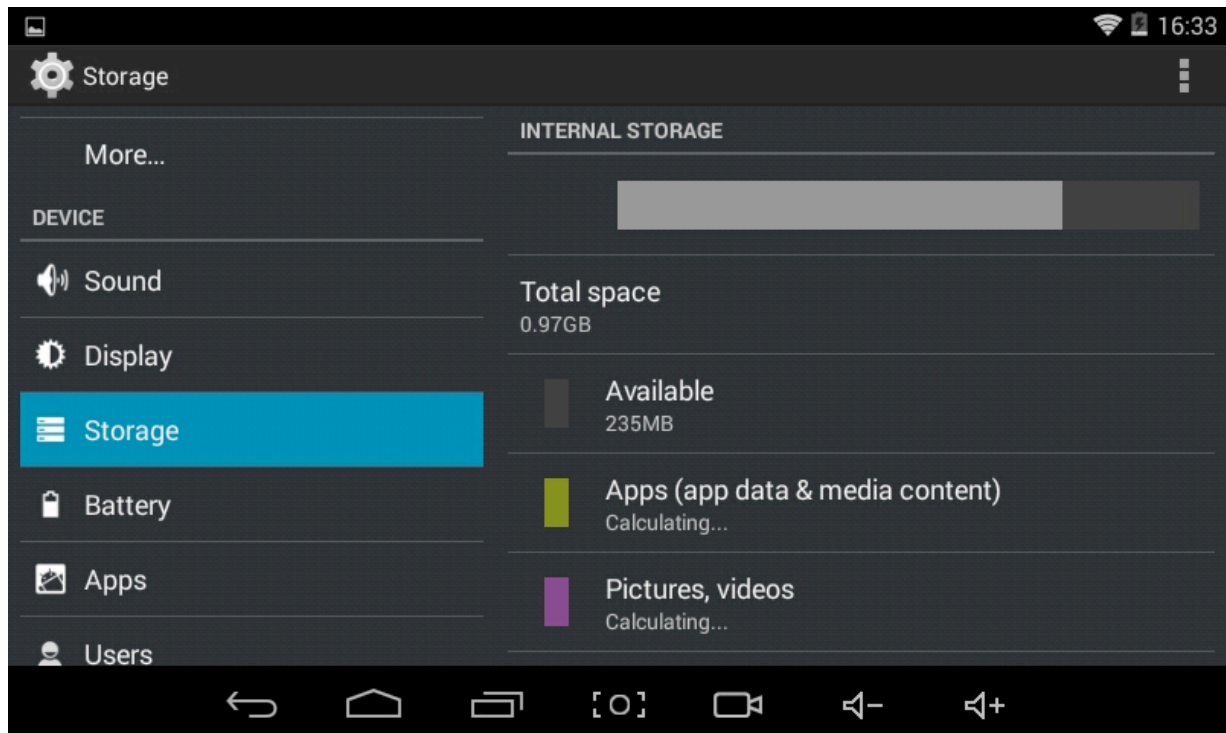

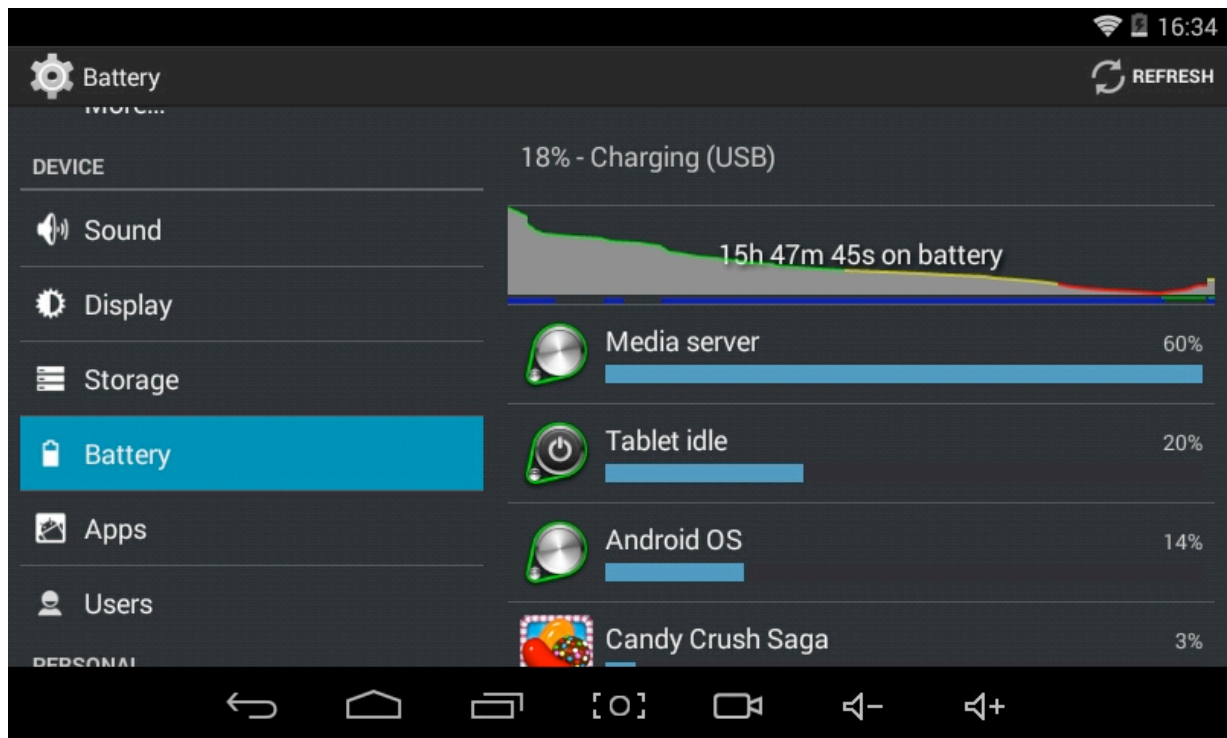

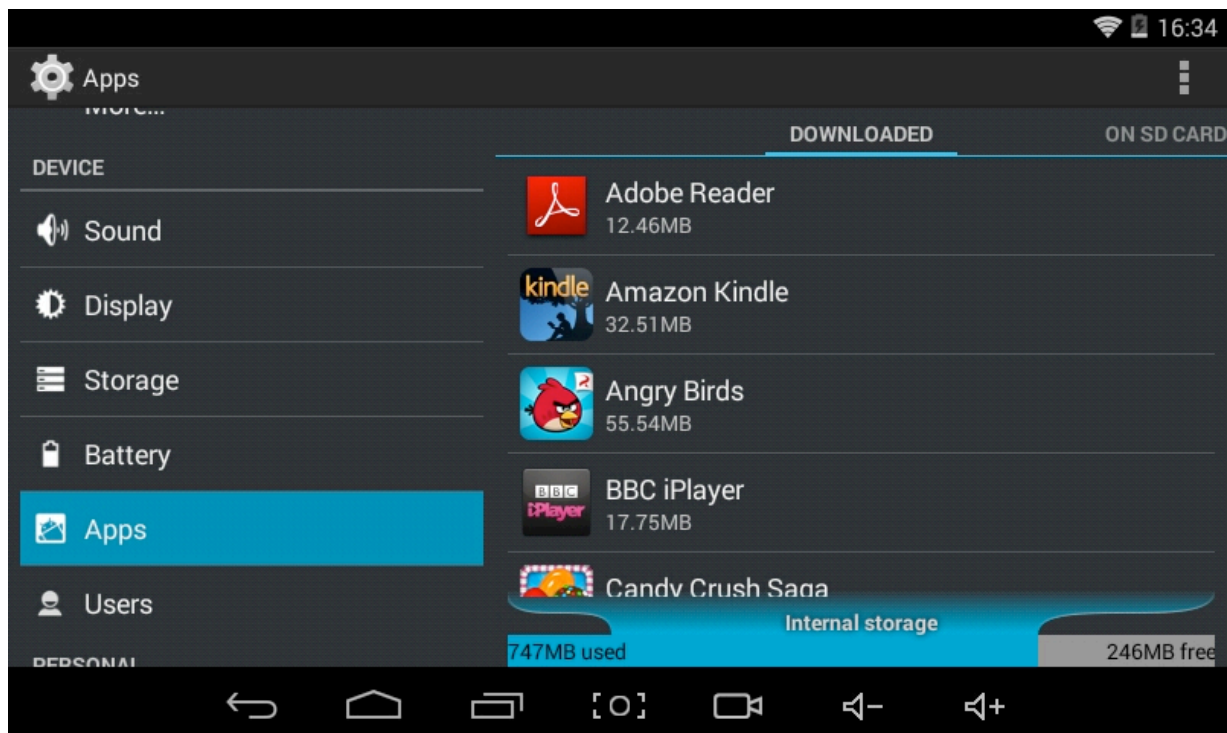

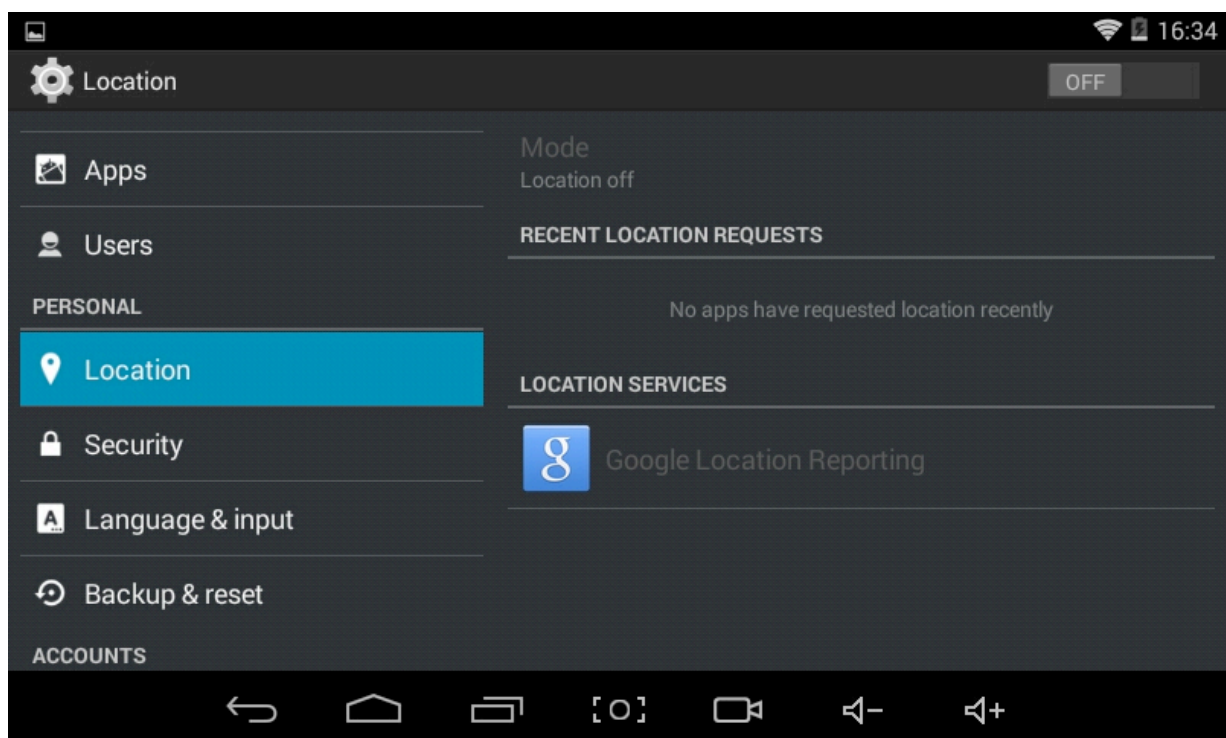

VI. GOOGLE PLAY

1. Setting up the Google account

Through Google Play store (former Android Market) you can download applications provided there. Using Google Play is free. Some of the applications available on Google Play are free of charge, while other are paid.

To start using Google Play you must have a Google account email address. To set up the Google account with the device system you have to:

- (1) Turn on the device and select **GooglePlay**
- (2) If the email account has not been added, there will be displayed message **“To use GooglePlay, you must have a Google account”**
- (3) Select “Create a Google account” and follow the instruction displayed on the screen.

After setting up the Google account you can download application from the Google Play.

4. Setting up the Google account

From Google Play you can download free and applications.

Free applications:

- Large text
- Auto-rotate of the screen
- Speak out loud passwords
- Time of tap and hold

- Install web scripts Auto time zone

Paid applications:

- Choose an application which you want to install
- When you decided to buy and install application choose button with the price (If it would be your first GooglePlay shopping, you will be asked to log on Google Wallet)
- Select payment method or add a new card.
- Tap **Accept and download** to complete the purchase.

Note:

Download of the application begins after payment confirmation. Purchased application will be associated with Google account, allowing to install them unlimited number of times on the device.

VII. FAQ

❖ How the update process is made?

Updates are downloaded automatically after Connecting the device to the Internet.

❖ Is it possible to replace battery in tablet?

Battery in device is installed permanently. Any attempt of individual battery replacement is equivalent to loss of device guaranty. All matters regarding replacement of the tablet batteries please consult with ET Ltd service.

❖ Where can I find apps for the tablet?

There are about 200,000 apps available for the Android system; you can download them through Google Play store (former Android Market).

❖ Is it possible to edit photos using tablet?

On Google Play there are apps allowing to edit photos on Android devices.

❖ Is it possible to run Java games on tablet?

Normally you cannot, because Android system doesn't support Java apps. In Google Play you can find Java emulators.

❖ What the USB Host means?

In USB Host mode you can connect to tablet mouse, keyboard, flash drive, portable disk or gamepad.

❖ If I have USB/micro USB port in tablet is it possible to connect to it an external hard drive?

Yes, if the tablet has USB Host.

❖ Does Android have the ability to read doc, docx, ppt, zip, rar, PDF files?

While using proper apps available on Google Play, you can read all of popular file formats.

❖ Is it possible in Android system to copy files, create folders etc.?

All of those operations can be make while using file managers.

❖ Are there any programs designated for Android system allowing to torrents download?

Yes, there are and they are available on Google Play.

❖ Does apps developed for smartphone would be properly displayed on tablet?

There is possibility that programs developed for smartphones would run in lower resolution.

❖ **Does apps developed for smartphone would be properly displayed on tablet?**

There is possibility that programs developed for smartphones would run in lower resolution.

❖ **In case of connecting mouse to tablet USB port should the cursor on screen appears?**

Yes, after connecting mouse to the tablet USB port the pointer on screen should appear.

❖ **Does tablets with Android system allow to watch movies on TV screen with subtitles (for example avi, rmvb with txt or subtitles)?**

Yes, you can connect tablet to TV with DLNA or HDMI cable and watch movies with subtitles via proper player (which you can down from Google Play)

❖ **Does tablets with Android system allow to run flash add-ons on websites?**

Yes, thanks to Adobe Flash Player for Android system it is possible to brows websites made in Flash technology.

❖ **Is it possible to run flash games on Android system?**

Yes, but it is necessary to install Adobe Flash Player.

❖ **How to open PDF or EPUB files?**

To open PDF or EPUB files it's necessary to download proper program from Google Play.

❖ **Is it possible to change Android system in to Windows 7?**

There is no such possibility. Only tablets based on x86 architecture can be run with windows7. Tablets with Android are based on ARM architecture.

❖ **Are there available Polish characters on virtual keyboard?**

Operation of virtual keyboard is the same as in case of PC keyboard, you can enter Polish characters by using Alt key and with Shift uppercase letters.

VIII. GOOGLE PLAY FAQ

❖ Position of my device is inactive in Google Play

Inactive position concerning the device means that device is incompatible with the apps which you want to install. The key reason is that app is not suitable for display size of Android version.

❖ Downloading of app is blocked and message is displayed “Initiating download”

- (1) In case of downloading paid apps, check your credit card if it is correctly stated or check your Google Wallet account.
- (2) Cancel and start again your download
- (3) Check whether tablet is connected to the network
- (4) Check whether firewall is not blocking access to the Google Play.
- (5) Clear the cache and Google Play data: **Main Menu - Settings - Applications - All - Google Play - Clear data and Clear cache**

❖ Displaying message “Download failed”

- (1) In case of downloading paid apps, check your credit card if it is correctly stated or check your Google Wallet account.
- (2) Clear the cache and Google Play data: **Main Menu - Settings - Applications - All - Google Play - Clear data and Clear cache**
- (3) Restart your tablet then try again your download
- (4) Check whether tablet is connected to the network
- (5) Check whether firewall is not blocking access to the Google Play
- (6) Check whether there is enough space on internal memory
- (7) Clear the SD card: **Main Menu - Settings -Storage - Clear SD Card**

❖ Download from the Google Play can't be started

- (1) Check whether tablet is connected to the network
- (2) Check whether firewall is not blocking access to the Google Play
- (3) Check whether you are logged to the Google Play
- (4) Check whether there is enough space on internal memory
