The School Resourcing System can be accessed remotely and the following table outlines the minimum requirements to operate the system.



WHAT IS THE SCHOOL RESOURCING SYSTEM

This system enables Principals to view the One Line Budget for both reporting and planning purposes. The system functionality includes Preliminary Budget planning up to February Census, once Operational Budgets are approved the system enables Principals to monitor the One Line Budget for the remainder of the school year.
