

Important Safety Instructions

Read this manual thoroughly before first use and keep it in a safe place for future reference, along with the warranty card, purchase receipt and carton. The safety precautions enclosed herein reduce the risk of fire, electric shock and injury when correctly adhered to.



- Before installing this TV set, make sure your outlet voltage corresponds to the voltage stated on the appliance rating label of the power adaptor being used..
- Only use this TV with the power adaptors supplied. If either plug does not fit into your outlets, consult your dealer or an RV service center for replacement of the outlet.
- Do not overload the power outlet.
- **CAUTION**: To reduce the risk of fire or electric shock, do not expose this TV set, the power supply cord, plug and antenna cable to rain or moisture; do not use it anywhere near water; do not touch the power plug with wet hands.
- Do not let the cord hang over the edge of a table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- Do not allow anything to rest on or roll over the power cord and antenna cable. Protect the cord and run all cables so that no one steps on or trips over them.
- Do not run the cord near heat-producing appliances such as radiators, stoves or irons. The excessive heat could melt the insulation and expose live wires.
- When not in use, disconnect the power cord from the outlet. Hold the plug, not the cord, when disconnecting the unit. Pulling the cord can damage the internal wires and may cause a fire.
- Never touch the TV screen, antenna or cord during thunderstorms. Stop use during thunderstorms; unplug the unit when a thunderstorm is approaching.

Important Safety Instructions (Cont.)

Usage conditions and restrictions

- Follow the instructions in this manual when installing and adjusting the TV set. Only adjust those controls that are covered in this instruction manual; improper adjustment of other controls may result in damage. If this happens, unplug the TV and have it serviced by appropriately qualified personnel.
- Do not change or modify the TV set in any way. Only use the attachments/ accessories specified.
- Do not cover the ventilation openings with items such as newspapers, tablecloths, curtains etc., as this could impede ventilation.
- Do not insert any objects of any kind into this unit through the ventilation slots or DVD slot, as they could touch the current-carrying parts or short-circuit parts, resulting in fire, electric shock or damage to the unit.
- Do not touch the screen with fingers, as this may scratch or smudge the TV screen.
- Do not expose the batteries to excessive heat such as sunshine, fire or the like.
- Unplug the TV set in all of the following circumstances:
 - If it has been subject to impact or has been dropped and is damaged.
 - If its voltage adaptor plugs, or the wall socket, are damaged.
- The appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Young children should be supervised to ensure they do not play with the TV.


Position

- If a television is not positioned in a sufficiently stable location, when stand mounted, it can potentially be hazardous if it falls. Many injuries, particularly to children, can be avoided by taking simple precautions such as:
 - Using cabinets, shelves or stands that provide a sturdy support for the TV and are not in areas where the TV can be accidently knocked or bumped.
 - Only using furniture that can safely support the television.
 - Ensuring the TV is not overhanging the edge of the supporting furniture.
 - Not placing the TV on tall furniture (for example, cupboards or bookcases) without anchoring both the furniture and the TV to a suitable support.
 - Not standing the TV on cloth or other materials placed between the TV and supporting furniture.
 - Educating children about the dangers of climbing up to reach the TV controls.

Important Safety Instructions (Cont.)

- When deciding where to put the TV set, make sure the location is:
 - Well ventilated. Leave at least a 20cm space all around the TV set for good ventilation.
 - Protected from overheating and away from direct sunlight.
 - Away from damp and cold.
 - Away from areas with extremes of temperature (below 0°C or exceeding 40°C) or moisture.
 - Away from moisture drips or splashes.
 - Protected from excessive dust.
- Do not install this equipment in a confined space such as a bookcase or similar.
- Do not put any objects filled with liquids, such as vases, on top of the TV set.
- Do not place any naked flame sources, such as lighted candles, on top of the TV.





Installation

Wall-mounting

This television set is equipped with VESA mounting points on the back panel for use with wall-mounting brackets (not included).

NOTE: The distance between the holes is 75 x 75 mm in width and height.



For wall-mounting, remove the two screws to remove the entire stand assembly.

NOTE: The screws in the package are for securing the TV stand only. If you are wall-mounting the TV, use the screws supplied with the wall mount.

Installation (Cont.)


Assembling the stand

Step 1:

Place a soft, cushioned material on top of a flat surface to prevent damaging the LED LCD screen. Then place the TV monitor flat on top, with the screen side facing down, and attach the stand to the support column with the three supplied self-tapping screws, as illustrated on the right.


Step 2:

Fasten the two supplied flat head screws between the support column and the back cover, as illustrated on the right.

Audio Output Socket

Use this socket to connect wired or wireless headphones plus to connect to compatible RV Media audio systems to play audio through the RV's main audio system.



USB Connection



NOTE

This TV is also supplied with a short USB extension lead. This is for connection to the USB Port to allow easier connection of a USB Flash Drive (to the end of the extension lead rather than the port) due to the wide variety of shapes and sizes of the USB drives currently available.

Getting Started

Using the remote control


Inserting batteries

- Remove the battery cover on the back of the remote control by gently pushing down the cover lock and pulling the cover upwards.
- Insert two AAA batteries, following the +/marking in the battery compartment.



Precautions when using batteries

- Do not use old and new batteries together.
- Do not use different types of battery (for example, manganese and alkaline batteries) together.
- Note that there are chargeable and non-chargeable batteries. Do not attempt to charge non-chargeable batteries.
- Remove the batteries from the remote control unit and store it in a dry place if you do not intend to use the remote control for more than a month.
- **CAUTION: Risk of Fire!** Make sure to insert the batteries correctly and use only suitable batteries of the same type.



To use the remote control, point it towards the remote sensor at the front of the television. The remote control has a range of up to approximately eight meters from the TV at an angle of up to 60 degrees.

NOTE:

- The remote control will not operate if its path is blocked.
- Do not drop the remote control, do not subject it to physical shocks.
- Keep the remote control dry; exposure to moisture it may cause it to malfunction.
- Replace the batteries with new ones when operation of the unit deteriorates.

Your RV Media TV with inbuilt DVD & USB functionality is supplied with two Power Adaptors allowing you to use your TV in a multitude of applications:

- Caravans, Campers & RV's
- Trucks (12V or 24V operation)
- Marine (12V or 24V operation)
- Store Demonstrations
- Home use
 - Kitchens
 - Bedrooms
 - Garage
 - Security etc

12/24V Operation

Your TV is supplied with a 12/24V adaptor fitted with a Accessory Plug (Cigarette Lighter Plug) which can be connected to 12V or 24V sources. This adaptor also ensures in 12V RV applications that your TV is protected from voltage spikes from Chargers & Solar Systems etc – up to 30V!

The adaptor is supplied with Velcro straps to allow you to secure it neatly to the TV Bracket or other suitable mounting point.

NOTE. The 12/24V Adaptor is also available as a separate spare part if you require a second power connection point (eg for exterior Caravan usage) – Part Number: 041438.



240V Operation

The TV is also supplied with a traditional 240V power adaptor allowing you to take advantage of 240V power where available.



Remote Control Functions



■:Turn the TV on or off.

Press this button to mute or restore sound.

NICAM/A2: press this key to select the stereo mode.

ASPECT: Press to adjust picture ratio.

PMODE: Select picture mode.

SMODE: Select sound mode.

0-9: Select and switch to a channel using 0 - 9.

-/--: Switch the program digit.

Switch back and front between the current and previous channels. Repeat

the program in MEDIA model **DISPLAY:** Display TV information.

EJECT ≜: Press to eject the DVD-disc in DVD mode

: Start to record (PVR Function).

(The USB drive is formatted when recording so make sure you do not have any important files stored on it).

AUTO: Adjusts the picture automatically in PC mode.

PROGRAM: Selects the DVD program.

INTRO: Press this button to display the Chapter time. (Used in models with a DVD player only).

GOTO Jump to a desired Chapter or Title.

(Used for model with DVD player only).

AB: Select the segment to repeat.

RED, GREEN, YELLOW, BLUE: Used for different menu options.

SLEEP: Set the sleep timer.

SOURCE: Press to change signal source.

ENTER: Enter the selected option or execute the selected operation.

MENU: Press this button to enter the main menu for various optional adjustable

EXIT: Exit the OSD (On-screen display).

CH▲/CH▼: Change the channel up and down.

SUBTITLE: Open or close subtitle.

T.SHIFT: Press the button to pause current DTV program and start record

background. (Used for model with DTV function only)

ANGLE: Select the angle. (Used for models with DVD function only)

VOL▲/VOL▼: Adjust the volume up/down.

HOLD: Freeze a multi-page passage on screen in Teletext mode.

Press to start playing MEDIA, or to pause playback.

REVEAL: Præss this button to reveal the hidden information in Teletext page. Press again to hide the information.

Press to rewind.

SIZE: Display the top, bottom or all of page to read easily in Teletext mode.



Press to play forward. (Used for models with MEDIA or DVD function only)

INDEX: Press this button to go to the index page in Teletext.

Stop playing Media. (Used for models with MEDIA or DVD function only)

Skip to previous chapter. (Used for models with MEDIA or DVD function only)

S.PAGE: Carry out the function of SUBCODE in the text while enter the text display mode.

(Used for European region DTV mode only)

: Skip to next chapter. (Used for models with MEDIA or DVD function only)

TEXT: Press to enter the Teletext mode.

ZOOM: Select the zoom picture. (Used for models with DVD function only)

FAV: Switch between custom set " Favorite List"

MENU (BLUE): Press this button to return the root menu or exit the DVD main menu.

AUDIO: Press to select the DTV audio or DVD audio.

DTV: Press to switch to DTV (Digital TV) mode

TITLE: Press this button to return the title menu. (Used for model with DVD function only)

EPG: Enter electronic program guide.

TV/RADIO: Switch between DTV program and radio program (Only audio but not image).

Remote Control Functions (Cont.)

Teletext function

Teletext or Austext is no longer available in Australia, nor is there any plan for a replacement. For more information, please visit the websites of the Australian channel providers.

However, one teletext option, "closed captions", is still available on most Australian television channels. This service allows you to activate subtitles while watching normal television programs that provide it.

Accessing closed captions

While watching a program, press the teletext button (TEXT/MIX) on the remote control, then enter the numbers 801 on the remote control to activate the subtitles. To exit the subtitles, press the TEXT/MIX button again.

TEXT Teletext on/off

HOLD Teletext hold button

SUBTITLE Subtitle/Closed Caption button

INDEX Teletext index button

Basic Operation

Make sure all necessary connections are correctly made before connecting the power adaptor and turning on the power. The power indicator on the TV will turn red to indicate it is in stand-by mode.


Power on/off

Press **(**)/Ion the remote control (or on the back of the TV) to turn on TV. The power indicator will change from red (stand-by) to blue (on).

To turn the TV off, press 0/1 The unit will revert to stand-by mode and the power indicator will turn red.

Volume adjustment

Press [VOL-] to reduce the volume, press [VOL+] to increase the volume.




Mute function

Press [MUTE \mbox{M}] on the remote control to switch off the sound temporarily, press it again (or the [$\mbox{$\frac{1}{2}$}$] button) to restore the sound.

TV channel selection

To select your TV channel, select analogue (ATV) or digital (DTV) as input source first, then choose your channel one of the following ways:

- Press [CH✓] or [CH▲] on the main unit.
- Press [0–9] using [-/--] if necessary if the channel number has 2 digits or more to input the channel number directly.
- Press [LAST CH] to go back to the previous channel you watched last time.



Selecting an Input Source

You can select an input signal source by pressing the SOURCE button on your remote control or control panel of your TV. The on screen display menu shows the diagram below on the screen, and you can either press the SOURCE button on the control panel repeatedly or the arrow buttons on your remote control to choose an input signal source.

You can choose from the following input sources if you have your audio and video devices connected to your TV.

When you switch on this TV for the first time, you need to select the language and the country to auto search for all the DTV programs in your area.



- Press **SOURCE** button to display the input source list.
- Press ▼ / ▲or SOURCE button to select the input source you want to watch.
- Press ENTER button to enter the input source.
- · Press EXIT button to quit.

On Screen Display when you change the volume

- When you press the VOL+ to increase the volume and VOL- to reduce the volume, the diagram below shows on your screen for 3 seconds.
- The MUTE symbol will show on one of your screen corners when you press the MUTE button, press the MUTE button again and the symbol will disappear.
- You can turn the sound on again either by pressing the MUTE button or the VOL+ button. The diagram below shows you the sound level in the volume indicator.




Menu Options in TV Mode

Picture menu

Press the MENU button to display the main menu.

Press ◀ / ▶ button to select PICTURE in the main menu, the first option will be highlighted.



- Press▲ /▼ button to select the option that you want to adjust in the PICTURE menu.
- Press◀/▶button to adjust.
- 3. After finishing your adjustment, press the MENU button to return back to the previous menu.

Picture Mode

Press ▲ / ▼ button to select Picture Mode, then press the OK button to enter sub-menu.

Press▲ / ▼ button to select. (Available Picture mode: Dynamic, Standard, Mild, Personal).

You can change the value of contrast, brightness, color and sharpness when the picture is in Personal mode. TIP: You can press the PMODE button on the remote control to change the Picture Mode directly.

Use in compensating colour changes with the transmission in the NTSC system.

Colour Temp

Press ▲ / ▼ button to select Color Temperature, then press ◄ / ▶ button to select. (Available Color Temperature: Normal, Cool, Warm).

Aspect Ratio

Press ▲ / ▼ button to select Aspect Ratio, then press ◀ / ▶ button to select. (Available Aspect Ratio: Auto, Zoom1, Zoom2, 4:3, 16:9).



Sound Mode

Press ▲ / ▼ button to select Bass, then press OK button to enter sub-menu. Press ◀ /▶ button to adjust.

Balance

Press ▲ / ▼ button to select Balance, then press the OK button to enter sub-menu. Press ◀ / ▶ button to adjust.

Surround Sound

Press ▲ / ▼ button to select Surround Sound, then press ◀ / ▶ button to select On or Off.

EQ Setting

Press ▲ / ▼ button to select EQ Setting, then press the OK button to enter submenu.



AVL (Auto Volume Level)

Press▲ / ▼ button to select AVL, then press Press ◀ / ▶ button to select On or Off.

SPDIF

Press ▲ / ▼ button to select SPDIF, then press Press ◀ / ▶ button to select Off, Auto, PCM.

Audio Description

Press \blacktriangle / \blacktriangledown button to select Audio Description, then press the OK button to enter submenu.

Channel Menu

Press the MENU button to display the main menu.

Press ◀/▶ button to select CHANNEL in the main menu, the first option will be highlighted.



- 1. Press ▲ / ▼ button to select the option that you want to adjust in the CHANNEL menu.
- 2. Press I button to adjust.
- After finishing your adjustment, press the MENU button to return back to the previous menu.





Channel Edit

Press ▲ / ▼ button to select Channel Edit, then press the OK button to enter submenu.



These three colored keys are the shortcut keys for programming the channel list.

First press ▲ / ▼ to highlight the channel you want to delete or move or skip, then:

Press the **RED** button to delete the channel.

Press the GREEN button to skip the selected channel.

(Your TV set will skip the channel automatically when using CH+/- to view the channels.) Press the BLUE button to set the channel to moving mode, then press▲ / ▼ to move it to the position you want to move it to, then press the blue button again to confirm the position.

Channel Menu (Cont.)

Signal Information

Press▲ / ▼ button to select SignalInformation, then press the OK button to select the detailed information about the signal. Only available when there is a DTV signal.



Lock & Parental Guidance Menu

Press the MENU button to display the main menu.

Press ▲ / ▼ button to select LOCK in the main menu, the first option will be highlighted.



- Press ▲ / ▼ button to select the option that you want to adjust in the LOCK menu. (Default Password: 0000)
- 2. Press ▲ / ▼ button to adjust.
- 3. After finishing your adjustment, press the MENU button to return back to the previous menu.

Enter Password

Press ▲ / ▼ button to select Enter Password, then press the OK button to make the following 4 options valid. (Default password is '0000'.)

Enable (Password)

Press ▲ / ▼ button to select Enable, then Press ◀ / ▶ button to select On or Off.

Channel Locks, Parental Rating and Lock Keypad are available when Enable is on.


Press ▲ / ▼ button to select Channel Ldcs, then press the OK button to enter submenu.

Lock & Parental Guidance Menu(Cont.)

Hotel Mode

Hotel Mode is a handy feature for use in shop displays or in situations where you want to lock certain functions - for instance lock the TV to a default source (for example USB).

Press ▲ / ▼ button to select Hotel Mode, then press the OK button to enter submenu.



New Password

Press ▲ / ▼ button to select New Password, then enter a 4 digit number you want to set as the password. Repeat 4 digit number to confirm new password.

Clear Lock

Press ▲ / ▼ button to select Clear Lock, then press ◀ / ▶ button to select.

NOTE: The default password is "0000" (Administrator password is "4711").

Set-up menu

Press MENU button to display the main menu.

Press ◀/▶ button to select SETUP in the main menu, it will highlight the first option.



OSD Language

Press ▲ / ▼ button to select OSD Language, then press OK button to enter submenu. Press▲ / ▼ / ◀ / ▶ button to select OSD language.

Auto Language

Press ▲ / ▼ button to select Auto Language, then press Ok button to enter submenu.

Press ▲ / ▼ / ◀ / ▶ button to select the Audio Primary Language and Audio Secondary

Language.



- Only the types of disc mentioned on the previous page can be played on this unit; DVD-ROM, CD-ROM, CVD, VCD etc. cannot be played back.
- A DVD-RW (video mode) can generally be played back, but not necessarily all DVDs of this type: playback capability depends on the recording conditions.
- A DVD-RW (VR mode) cannot be played back.
- A DVD+R/+RW can generally be played back, but not necessarily all DVDs of this type: playback capability depends on the recording conditions.
- A DVD-R that has recorded movie data can generally be played back on this unit, but not necessarily all DVDs of this type: playback capability depends on the recording conditions.

Handling, storing and cleaning discs

- Never put anything except a 12cm DVD (or CD) into the disc slot. Foreign objects can damage the unit.

- Never use chemical cleaning spray, liquids or solvents to clean discs. These chemicals will permanently damage the plastic surface of the disc.
- To remove a disc from its storage case, press down on the center of the case and lift the disc out, holding it carefully by the edges.
- Return any discs to their cases after use to protect them from dust and scratches.
- To prevent warping the disc, do not expose it to direct sunlight, high humidity or high temperatures for extended periods of time.
- Do not apply paper labels or write anything on either side of the disc. Sharp writing instruments, or the inks used in some felt-tip pens, may damage the surfaces of the disc.



If this symbol appears on the TV screen during operation, the function you are trying to access is currently not available on the disc.

- 1. Turn on the TV and press [SOURCE] to select the input source as DVD.
- Insert the disc (label facing away from you) into the disc slot (side panel) approx 1/3 of the way in until you feel tension from the disc mechanism. Shortly after the mechanism will continue loading the disc all of the way in. DO NOT FORCE THE DISC IN. The TV will start playing the first file/track/chapter automatically.

NOTE: Regardless of the mode you have selected, when you insert a playable disc into the disc slot, the TV will switch to DVD mode and start playback automatically.

3. To temporarily stop playback of a CD, press ► to stop playback, press it again to resume playback.

To temporarily stop playback of a DVD, press ■ once to stop playback, press it twice to stop playback completely.





A-B repeat (designated range repeat playback)



- 1. Press [A-B] during playback at the beginning of the section you want to repeat (Point A). " A" appears on the TV screen.
- 2. Press [A-B] again at the end of the section you want to repeat (Point B). "DAB" appears briefly on the TV screen.
- 3. To return to normal playback, press [A-B] again.

Important note

The DVD **default password is "0000"** — you need that to enter the password/lock menu so that you can set your own password.

If you forget the password you have set, you have to enter the **master password: "8888"**. This will clear your set password and go back to the default password, which you can change, if you wish.

Subtitle language [DVD]

If the DVD you are watching has subtitles, press [SUBTITLE] repeatedly during playback until the desired subtitle language appears on the TV screen. Example:

Audio soundtrack language (multilanguage) [DVD]

This function works only with discs that have multiple audio soundtrack languages recorded.

Press [AUDIO] repeatedly during playback until the desired language appears on the TV screen.

NOTES:

- When the desired language is not selected, even though the button is pressed, the language is not available on the disc.
- If the language is not recorded on the disc, only the available language on the disc will be heard.
- When you turn off the power or change the disc, you have to select the language again.

On-screen information
