How to Use Your Dent4U

Dent4U has been carefully designed to offer you and your family a new and unique toothbrushing experience that is both safe and effective. Remember, however, when using electric products of any kind, you should always follow safety precautions. Read the following user manual carefully before use.

Getting Started

- 1. Remove the battery compartment cap from the handle. (Fig. 2)
- 2. Insert two AA 1.5-volt batteries into the handle. (Fig. 3)
- **3.** Push the battery compartment cap back onto the handle. (Fig. 4)
- **4.** Attach the brush head to the handle. (Fig. 5)

Using Your Dent4U

- 1. Wet the bristles and apply toothpaste.
- 2. Place the toothbrush against the teeth.
- **3**. Hold the handle and turn on the Dent4U. Gently move the brush head across the teeth back and forth. Continue this motion throughout your two-minute brushing cycle.
- **4.** For effective use, it is important to apply only light pressure and let the toothbrush do the brushing for you. Do not scrub.
- **5.** After you have completed the two-minute brushing cycle, you can spend more time brushing the chewing surfaces of your teeth and your tongue.

Special Features

- 1. Smartimer: After working for two minutes, the Smartimer automatically turns off your toothbrush. To pause or stop brushing during your two-minute cycle, press the power button.
- **2.** Battery indicator (Fig. 6): The battery indicator shows you the amount of power left in the batteries. The green light indicates you have at least 16 two-minute brushings available. The red light indicates there are fewer than 16 brushings available.

Cleaning

Do not place brush heads or the handle in a dishwasher.

- 1. Rinse the brush head and bristles after each use. Let the brush head air dry. (Fig. 7)
- 2. Remove the brush head once a week and clean the connection between the brush head and the handle. (Fig. 8)
- **3.** It is recommended to clean the handle regularly with mild soap and a wet cloth. (Fig. 9)

Storage

If you are not going to use the toothbrush for a month or longer, remove the batteries, clean the appliance, and store it in a cool and dry place.

Disposal

In the interest of protecting the environment, at the end of its life, please do not dispose of the item with normal household waste. Send it to the Dent4U Service Center or drop it off at any appropriate collection point for recycling. (Fig. 10)
