

LED UMBRELLA LIGHT

LPL1040BX Owner's Manual

Location of Controls

- 1. 32 Super Bright LEDs
- (8 LEDs in each light head 5 White LEDs & 3 Amber LEDs) 2. Pivoting Light Heads
- 3. Quick Release Button: for mounting unit
- 4. ON/OFF Switch with Selectable Dimmer
- 5. Light Mode Switch: Downlight or Uplight + Downlight
- 6. LED Color Selector Switch
- 7.8 LED Uplights
- 8. Self Adjusting Mounting Brackets
- 9. Battery Compartments

Installation

Light Positioning

This innovative light allows you to mount the light onto an umbrella pole. To do so, simply: (1) Press the Quick Release Button to separate the light.

(2) Place the light around the pole (Fig 1) and re-connect the light. Be sure it clicks closed securely (Fig 2).

NOTE: Each light head can only pivot 30°. To prevent damage to the unit, do NOT force the light heads. Doing so may damage the unit and will void the warranty.

Operating Directions For ON/OFF Switch With Selectable Dimmer

- 1. Press once for full brightness.
- Press and hold for desired brightness.
- 3. Press a third time to turn the light OFF.

Dual-Color Light Output

Each light head contains 5 Super Bright White LEDs and 3 Super Bright Amber LEDs. To select the color you desire simply, switch the Light Color Selector Switch to the desired light color.

NOTE: Both white & amber downlight LEDs cannot be on at the same time.

Light Mode

This light can be used in one of 3 configurations:

(1) Downlights Only: White LEDs

- (2) Downlights Only: Amber LEDs
 (3) Uplights & Downlights: White LEDs only

Inserting/Replacing the Batteries

If the LEDs appear to be dim this is an indication that your batteries need to be replaced. To Replace the Batteries

- 1. Remove cover to both battery compartments.
- 2. Remove old batteries (if replacing batteries) from both battery compartments.
- 3. Replace each compartment with three (3) new AA batteries.
- 4. Make sure to follow battery polarity guide when installing new batteries.
- 5. Replace battery compartments.

Battery Precautions:

- 1. Use only the size and type of batteries specified.
- 2. Always purchase the correct size and grade of battery most suitable for the intended use.
- 3. Be sure to follow the correct polarity when installing the batteries as indicated in the battery
- compartment. Reversed batteries may cause damage to the device.
- 4. Do not mix alkaline, standard (Carbon-Zinc), or rechargeable (Nickel Cadmium) batteries.
- 5. Replace all batteries of a set at the same time. Do not mix old and new batteries.
- 6. Clean the battery contacts and also those of the device prior to battery installation.

7. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

8. Remove batteries if consumed or if product is to be left unused for an extended period of time.

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


