

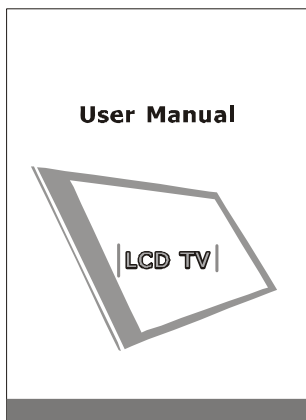
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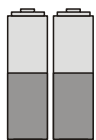

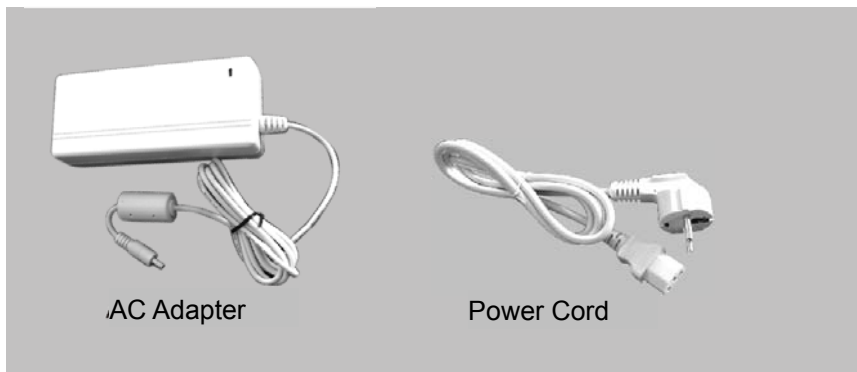

About Symbols

This manual includes different kinds of symbols. To ensure the correct using, as well as to avoid danger to users and others, the following introductions should be adhered to.



This is a WARNING symbol. If the users ignore this warning, there might be personal damage or even death due to incorrect operation.



This is an ATTENTION symbol. If the users ignore this warning, there might be damage to the person or to the appliance due to incorrect operation.

No Operations when Problems Occur

When abnormal phenomenon happens, such as smoking, smell, no picture, no voice, over loud voice, damage of part or cable, and inside of liquid or other things, there might be fire or electrical shock. Under such occasions, please unplug the TV set, make sure there is no smoke or smell, and get contact with the dealer. DO NOT repair it by yourself, or there might be hurt to human body.

No Entry of Liquid or Object

There might be fire or electrical shock if liquid or other object get inside the appliance. Please pay more attention to your children. If it happens, please unplug the TV set, make sure there is no smoke or smell, and get contact with the dealer.

- Keep the TV away from rain and moisture.
- Do not set liquids, including flower vases and vessels filled with chemicals or water etc. on top of the TV or around it.
- Do not set metal or tinder on top of the TV or around it.

Don't open the TV Set

There is high voltage subassembly inside the TV set, which may cause fire or electrical shock during repair.

- DO NOT remove cover (or back).

No Quiver or Concussion on TV Set

This appliance should not be exposed to dripping or broken. Continuous use might cause fire or electrical shock. If the panel gets broken, please unplug the TV set, and get contact with the dealer.

Set the TV on Balanced Spot

There will be damage if the TV drops or breaks.

- Don't set the TV on uneven, oblique, or shacking surface.

Ventilation

Don't interfere with its proper ventilation when the TV is working or has just been unplugged, or the display may be spoiled or life shortened due to over heating. In order to keep proper ventilation, please allow a clearance of 25cm on each side from the wall.

- Don't set any object around the ventilation openings of the appliance.
- Don't block the ventilation openings.
- NO inversion of the screen.
- Don't cover the appliance with table cloth.
- Don't set the appliance on carpet, bedding, or near to curtain.

Power Sources

Unbefitting power sources may cause fire or electrical shock. The appliance should be connected to a power supply of the type described in the operating instructions or as marked on the appliance.

- Power supply cord should adapt to the socket outlet.

Power Cord Connection

Incorrect connection of power cord may cause fire or electrical shock.

- Don't touch the cord with wet hands.
- Please check the pontes if it is clean (no dust) before use. If it is not, please do the cleaning with dry and soft fabric.
- Fix the power cord steadily in to the socket outlet to avoid it becoming flexible, or it may have malfunction.
- Don't cut off the cord, for it may debase the performance. If you want to lengthen it, please make an appropriate one or get contact with the dealer.
- If you want to change the fuse in the connector plugs, please change it with the same resistance and model.

Connect to Earth Connection

This appliance shall be connected to a mains socket outlet with a protective earth connection. If the provided plug does not fit into your outlet, consult an electrician for replacement of the obsolete outlet. Take care of the cord, or there might be fire or electrical shock due to broken cord. Please make sure that the cord is not over hot, pressed, or tensed. If the cord has problem (the core string emerges or the cord breaks), please get contact with the dealer.

- Never allow heavy objects such as the TV set itself to be placed on the power cord. Never cover the cord with table cloth, for it may lead you to set heavy object on the cord duo to ignorance.
- When removing the power plug from the socket, always hold onto the plug, never pull by the cord.
- Don't set the cord next to heaters.
- Don't touch the plug right after it is unplugged to avoid electrical shock.
- Don't touch the plug during lightning.
- Don't allow cord to become knotted or tangled.
- Protect the power cord from being walked on or pinched particularly at plugs, convenience receptacles, and the point where they exit from the apparatus.

Dispose the Batteries Carefully

- Incorrect disposal of batteries may cause fire or human damage, and even explosion.
- Don't throw batteries into fire or water.

- Places where is deflective or unbalanced.

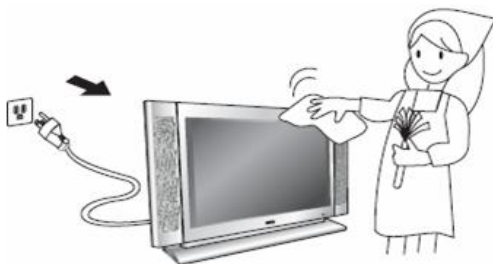

Watching TV

Please watch TV indoors where there is proper brightness. Please make sure the sunlight will not fall directly on the picture screen. Please relax your eyes every now and then by taking an overlook.

How to Clean the TV Set

Before cleaning, please turn off the TV and unplug the power cord. Don't beat or scrape the screen with sharp and hard object. Clean the screen with a soft cloth moistened in warm water. A mild soap may be used if the screen is extremely dirty. Dry the screen with a soft cloth after cleaning.



Notes of Cable Connection

- Make sure that all cables, including connector plugs, extend lines, and connecting cables between equipments are specify by the manufacturer. Before changing the connection, please turn off the power and unplug the power cord;
- The power cord should not be the same one as other equipments';
- Use plugs with a protective earthing connection.

Notes of Transportation

Please handle with care during transportation. Besides, please use the original carton and wrappage, or it may damage the TV set. Please retain the original carton and wrappage.

Don't Impact the Remote Control

Impacts on remote control may lead to trouble.

- Please don't chuck the remote control;
- Don't set heavy object on remote control.

To Avoid Fierce Lights

The sensor of remote control will not work if the lights, such as sunlight or bright indoor illumination fall directly on it. Make sure that there is no interference from wireless, or it may cause distortion of the picture or unusual sound. There should no equipment like mobile telephone or wireless receiver.

Adjust Volume to a Proper Level

It's better to turn down the volume and shut the windows at night, in case it will influence others.

Note on Installation

- Never use wooden screws and bracket to fix up. Use those that are specified by the manufacturer;
- Use only with the cart, stand, tripod, bracket, or table specified by the manufacturer, or sold with the apparatus. When a cart is used, use caution when moving the cart/apparatus combination to avoid injury from tip-over;

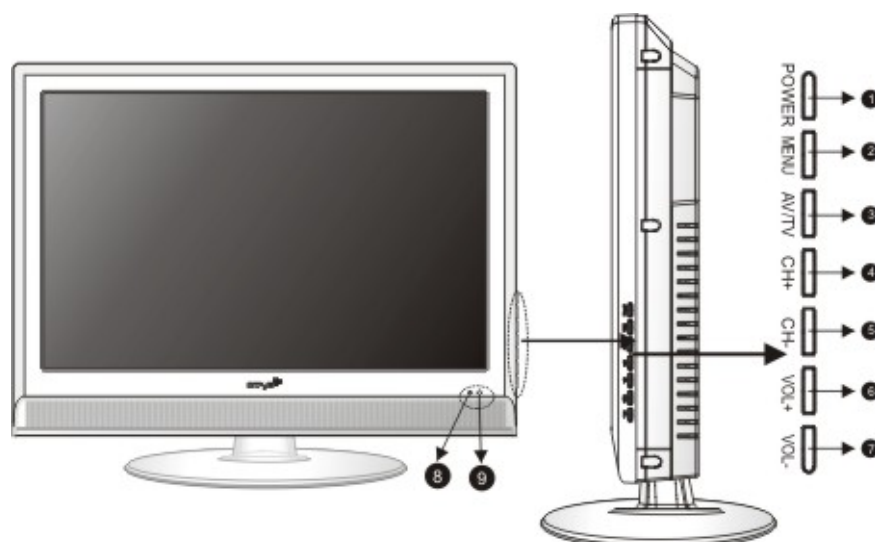

- (9) (Receiver) Infrared remote control sensor window

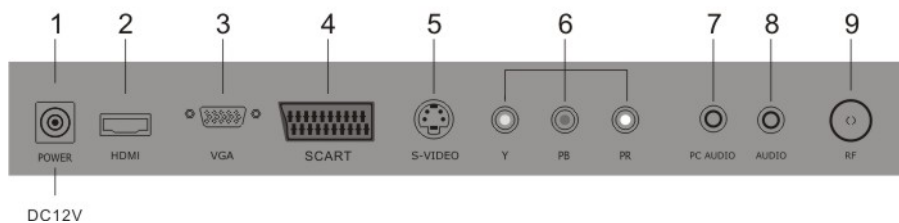
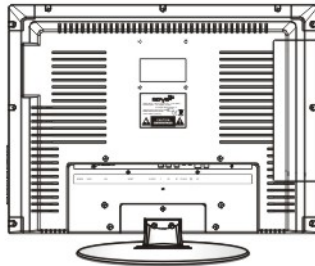

INSTALLING BATTERIES

- (1) Open the battery compartment cover on the back side
- (2) Insert two 1.5V batteries of AAA type with correct polarity
- (3) Close the battery compartment cover on the back side

Notes on Using Batteries

The use of the wrong type of batteries may cause chemical leaks and/or explosion.

Please note the following:

Always ensure that the batteries are inserted with the positive and negative terminals in the correct direction as shown in the batteries compartment. Different types of batteries have different characteristics. Do not mix different types.

Do not mix old and new batteries. Mixing old and new batteries will shorten battery life and /or cause chemical leaks from the old batteries.

When batteries fail to function, replace them immediately.

Chemicals which leak from batteries may cause skin irritation.

If any chemical matter seeps out of the batteries, wipe it up immediately using a dry cloth.

Due to varying storage conditions, the battery life for the batteries included with your unit may be shortened.

If the remote control is not used for a long period of time, remove the batteries.

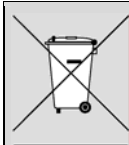

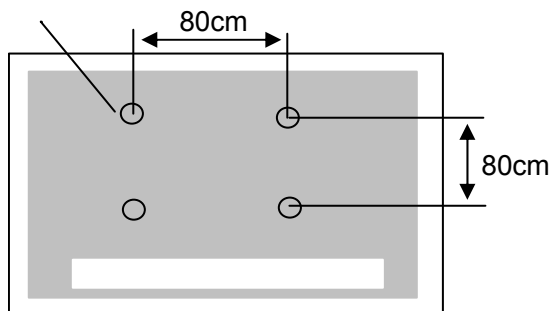

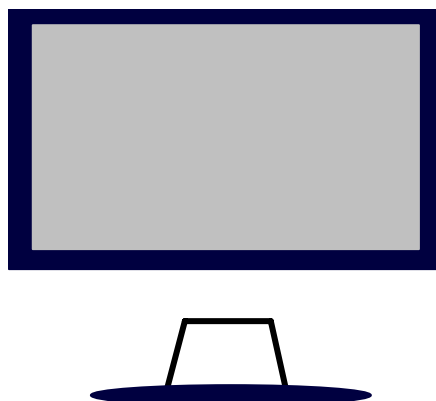
Wall Mount: Horizontal installation

- (1) Secure the wall brackets with the bolts (not provided as parts of the product, must purchase separately) on the wall. Match the height of the bracket that is mounted on the wall. The wall bracket is of normal dimension. Please see the position of the wall brackets bolts as follow picture .The actual dimension of the wall brackets bolt should according to the products. Detailed installation instructions are available from your dealer; see the optional Tilt Wall Mounting Bracket Installation and Setup Guide.

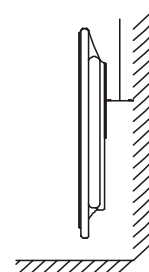
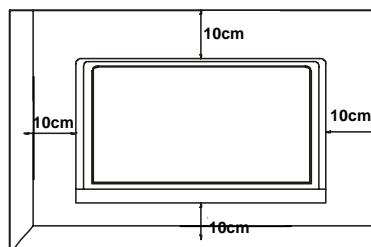
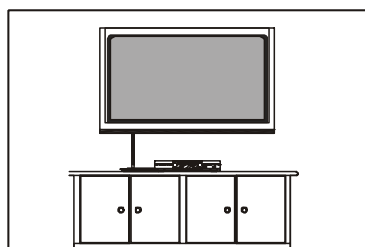
The wall brackets bolt position



- (2) Remove the table stand of the TV when install the TV on a wall as follow:



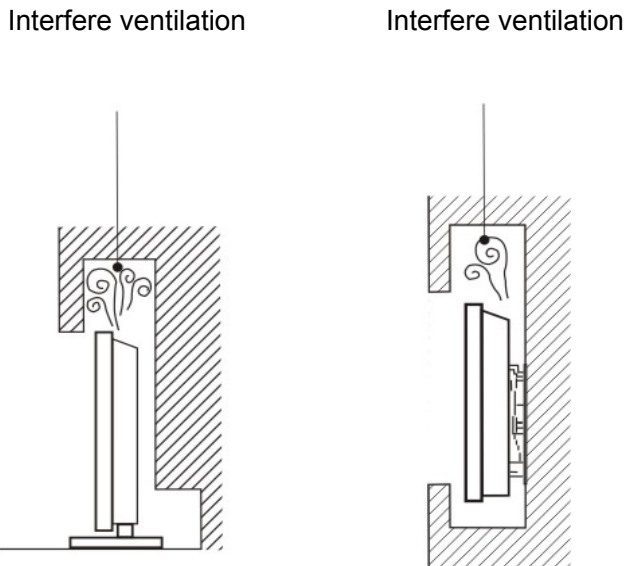
- (3) For proper ventilation, allow a clearance of 10cm on each side from the wall.

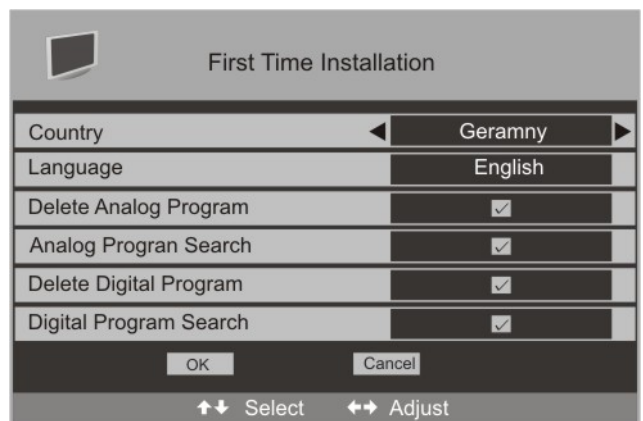
QUICK GUIDE

First Installation

The installation assistant starts automatically when the device is being switched on for the first time.

1. Choose the desired option in the menu using the ▼ / ▲ buttons.
2. Change the settings using the ◀ / ▶ buttons.
3. You can choose among the following settings:

Language	OSD Language
Delete Program Search	
Analogue Program Search	
Delete Digital Program	
Digital Program Search	



4. Now, press the OK button and confirm pressing the ENTER button. Upon this, the chosen settings will be executed.

NOTE: The standard language is English. The options are marked during the first installation.

INSTALLATION

Change the language setting

1. Press the LCD menu button of the remote control and choose FUNCTION. Press once the ◀ -button.
2. Choose the option LANGUAGE. Use the ▼ / ▲ buttons.
3. Change the language using the ◀ / ▶ buttons.

Repeat first installation routine

1. Press LCD menu button of the remote control and choose FUNCTION. For this, press once the ◀ -button.
2. Afterwards, choose the option "FIRST TIME INSTALLATION" using the ▼ / ▲ -buttons.

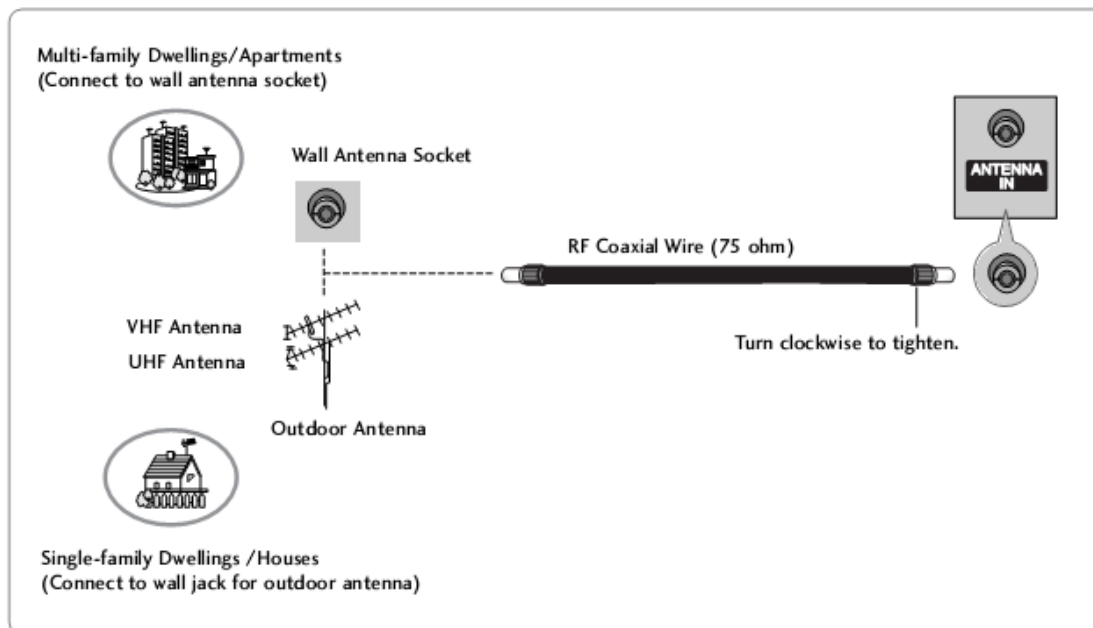

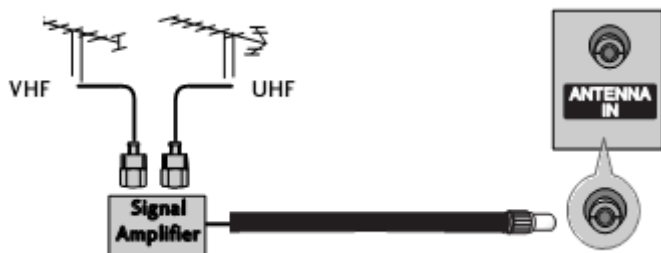

ANTENNA CONNECTION

- In poor signal areas, to get better picture quality, install a signal amplifier to the antenna as shown below.
- If signal needs to be split for two TVs, use an antenna signal splitter for connection.



NOTE:

You are able to use analogue TV (Cable TV) or DVB-T as signal source.

For DVB-T (DTT) reception insure that the service is available for your area. DVB-T radio in particular is very limited and not available in most locations.

Depending on your region and building structure, a stronger antenna may be requires in order to receive DVB-T stations. Metal buildings and the geographic location of the transponder may have a strong effect on the reception. Please note that this is not a device defect; merely specific specifications for the reception of DVB-T.

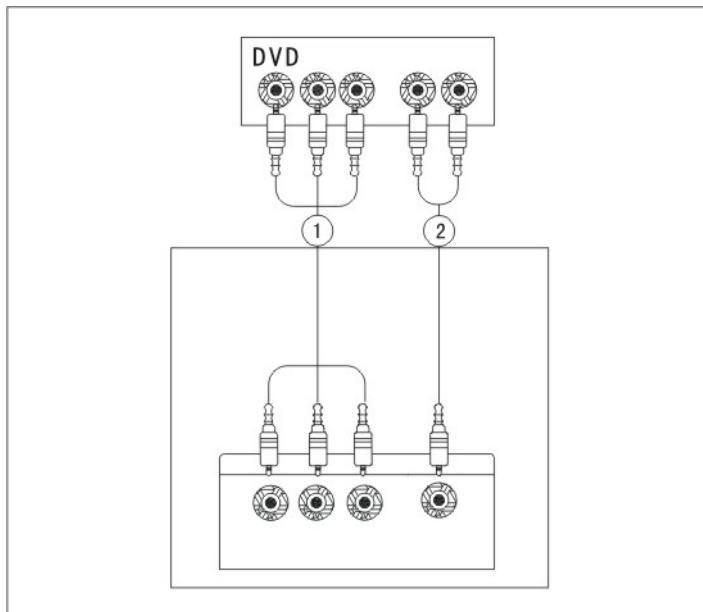

DVD CONNECTION

When connecting with a component cable

1. Connect the video outputs (Y, PB, PR) of the DVD to the YPbPr jacks on the set
2. Connect the audio outputs of the DVD to the Audio Input jack on the set.
3. Turn on the DVD player, insert a DVD.
4. Select YPbPr source with using the SOURCE button on the remote control
5. Refer to the DVD player's manual for operating instructions

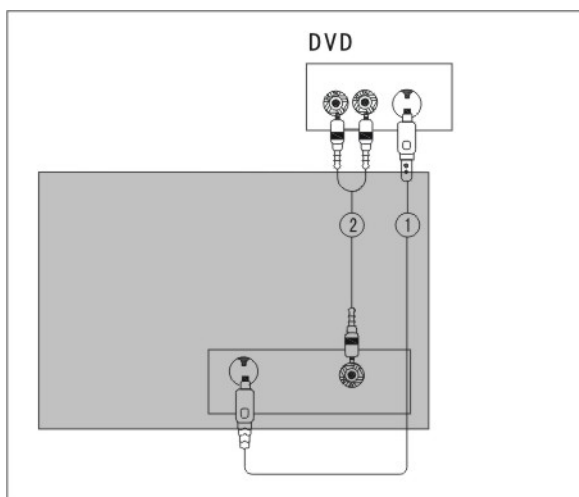

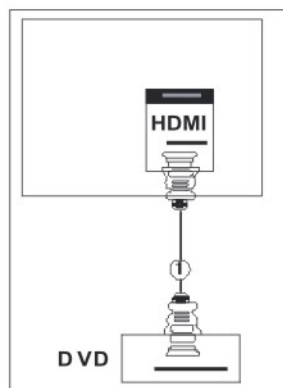
When connecting with a S-Video cable

1. Connect the S-VIDEO output of the DVD to the S-VIDEO input on the set.
2. Connect the audio outputs of the DVD to the Audio Input jack on the set.
3. Turn on the DVD player, insert a DVD
4. Select S-VIDEO source with using the SOURCE button on the remote control.
5. Refer to the DVD player's manual for operating instructions



When connecting with a HDMI cable

1. Connect the HDMI output of the DVD to the HDMI Input jack on the set.
2. Select HDMI source with using the SOURCE button on the remote control
3. Refer to the DVD player's manual for operating instructions.



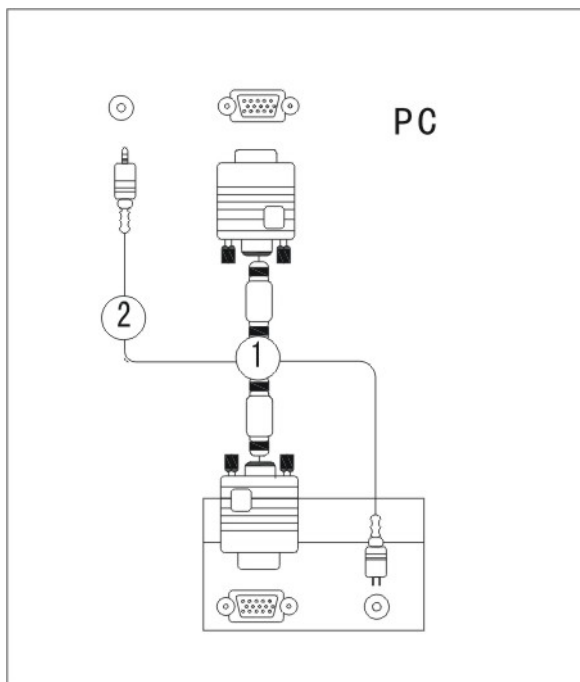
HDMI provides both audio and video signals and typically provides superior image quality to component or S-Video.

CONNECTIONS & SETUP

PC CONNECTION

When connecting with a D-sub 15 pin cable

1. Connect the RGB output of the PC to the PC VGA Input jack on the set.
2. Connect the audio outputs of the PC to the PC Audio Input jack on the set.
3. Turn on the PC and the set
4. Select PC source with using the SOURCE button on the remote control.
5. Refer to the PC manual for operating instructions.




BASIC OPERATION


TURNING THE TV ON

If your TV will be turned on, you will be able to use its features.

Turning on the TV



First, connect power cord correctly. When the indicator illuminates red is standby mode.

Press the  button on the remote control then the indicator illuminates orange, after the TV initialization finished, the indicator turns to green. It means the TV is in power mode.

When you press the  button on the remote control once again, the power/stand-by Indicator illuminates red in standby mode.

If you intend to be away on vacation, disconnect the power plug from wall power outlet.

VOLUME ADJUSTMENT

1. Press the VOL +/VOL- button on the control panel or the ◀ / ▶ button on the remote control to adjust the volume.
2. If you want to switch the sound off, press the  button on the remote control.
3. You can cancel this function by pressing the , button or the ◀ / ▶ button on the remote control.

PROGRAM SELECTION

Press the CH +/CH- button on the control panel or the Numerical buttons or the ▼ / ▲ button to select a program number.



BASIC OPERATION

SLEEP TIMER

You don't have to remember to switch the set off before you go to sleep.


The sleep timer automatically switches the set to standby after the preset time has elapsed.

Press the SLEEP button on the remote control repeatedly to select the number of minutes.

The display will appear on the screen followed by close, 015,30,45 ,60,75,90,105and 120 minutes.



RETURN FUNCTION

When you are looking TV programs ,you can press the  button on the remote control to return to the previous channel.

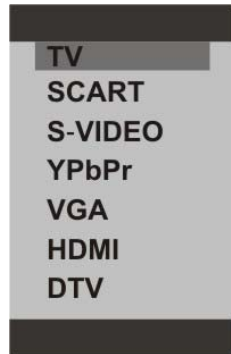
SOURCE INPUT SWITCH

1. Press SOURCE button on the remote control to the source menu.

The source menu rank as: TV - SCART - S-VIDEO - YPbPr - VGA - HDMI - DTV ;

2. Press ▼ / ▲ button on the remote control to select the source in the menu.

When the bar became red means the covering source selected.



OSD OPERATION

HOW TO USE THE OSD (On Screen Display)

The OSD (On Screen Display) function enables you to adjust the screen status conveniently since it provides graphical presentation.

In this manual, the OSD (On Screen Display) may be different from your TV's because it is just example to help the TV operation.

Press the MENU ◀ / ▶ , ▼ / ▲ buttons on the remote control to adjust or set up the pictures, sound, program channel ,PC signal source ,etc .of the TV. Please refer to the interrelated menu operation.

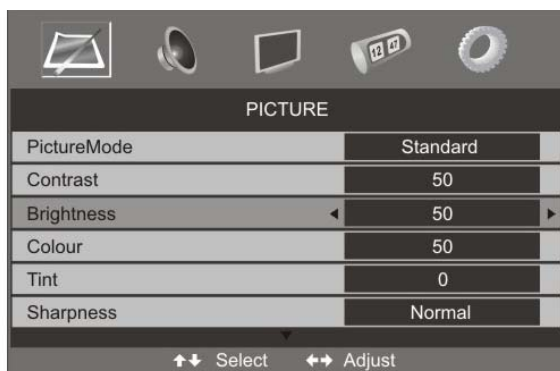
Note : The "MENU", "VOL+/VOL-", " CH+/CH-" buttons on the control panel and the

MENU ◀ / ▶ , ▼ / ▲ buttons on the remote control are of the same function .

Here only signed as MENU ◀ / ▶ , ▼ / ▲ on the remote control

VIDEO MENU OPTIONS

Press MENU button on the control panel or LCD-MENU on the remote control to display the main menu.



1. Press ◀ / ▶ button to select PICTURE in the main menu.
2. Press ▼ / ▲ button to select the option that you want to adjust in the PICTURE menu.
3. Press ◀ / ▶ button to adjust.
4. When you are satisfied with your adjustment, press the LCD-MENU button to return to the previous menu or press the EXIT button to exit the main menu.



Adjusting Tint is only available under NTSC signal mode.

VIDEO MENU OPTIONS

Picture Mode

Select Picture Mode in PICTURE menu. (Available picture mode: Standard, Personal, Movie, Sport, Mild, Game.)

If you change the value of Contrast, Brightness, Colour, Tint, Sharpness or Colour temperature on the picture menu, the picture mode will be changed to "Personal" automatically.

NOTE: You can press PMODE button on the remote control to select the Picture Mode directly.

Contrast

Press \blacktriangledown / \blacktriangle button and then use \blacktriangleleft / \blacktriangleright to adjust the contrast of the picture.



After adjust the value you want, press LCD-MENU button to return to the preview MENU.

Brightness

Press \blacktriangledown / \blacktriangle button and then use \blacktriangleleft / \blacktriangleright to adjust the brightness of the picture.

OSD OPERATION

VIDEO MENU OPTIONS

Colour

Press ▼ / ▲ button and then use ◀ / ▶ to adjust the colour saturation.

NOTE: This option is invalid in PC mode, and it will be shown in gray.

Tint

Press ▼ / ▲ button and then use ◀ / ▶ to adjust the tone of colour when your system is in NTSC.

Sharpness

Press ◀ / ▶ to select the sharpness mode of your TV.

(Available Sharpness Mode: Normal, Sharp, Sharpest, Softest, Soft.)

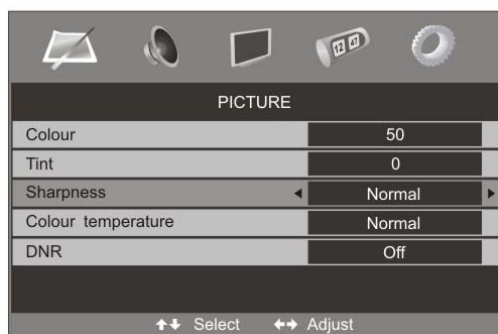
Colour temperature

Select an optimum colour temperature mode to suit your eyes for viewing among Normal, Warm and Cold.

NOTE: This option is available only in PC mode.

DNR (Digital Noise Reduction)

If the broadcast signal received is weak, you can select the DNR option to reduce the video noise level between Off, Low, Mid and High.



OSD OPERATION

AUDIO MENU OPTIONS

Press MENU button on the front panel or LCD-MENU on the remote control to display the main menu.



1. Press the ◀ / ▶ button to select SOUND in the main menu.
2. Press the ▼ / ▲ button to select the option that you want to adjust in the SOUND menu.
3. Press the ◀ / ▶ button to adjust.
4. When you are satisfied with your adjustment, press the LCD-MENU button to return to the previous menu or press the EXIT button to exit the main menu.

Volume

Press ▼ / ▲ button and then use ◀ / ▶ to adjust the sound level.



After adjust the value you want, press LCD-MENU button to return to the preview MENU.

OSD OPERATION

AUDIO MENU OPTIONS

Sound Mode

Select Sound Mode in SOUND menu. (Available sound mode: Personal, Voice, Music, Theatre.)

If you change the value of Bass and Treble on the Sound menu, the sound mode will be changed to "Personal" automatically.

You may select the sound mode directly by pressing SMODE button .

NOTE: You can press SMODE button on the remote control to select the Sound Mode directly.

Bass

1. Odys products are covered by a 24 month warranty. We will resolve damages or defects on Odys products free of charge within 12 months of the purchase date under the following warranty conditions. For any damage or defect determined later than 12 months after the purchase date, proof of a manufacturing fault must be submitted for repair under warranty.
The warranty does not cover batteries and other parts, which are considered consumables, parts that break easily such as glass or plastic or defects based on normal wear and tear.
