OPERATION

Charge Indicators

Once the front power button is pushed, four charge indicators will be lit according to the chart below.


Charge Light	1 ON	2 ON	3 ON	4 ON
Charge	<25%	25-50%	50-75%	75-100%

CHARGING DEVICES

Connect the mobile device to the B515 Power Bank using the original device charging cable.



*Device charging cable not included

CHARGING B515 POWER BANK

- Use the provided Micro USB cable to charge the B515 Power Bank
- Charge from USB outlet(e.g. wall charger, computer, etc.)

CHARGING STATUS

- Flashing charge indicator light is on: B515 is charging
- All charge indicator lights are on(not flashing): B515 has full charge

ATTENTION: Make sure cables are firmly connected to both the B515 unit and the mobile device to ensure proper charging.
