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## WinCE PC Station Introduce:

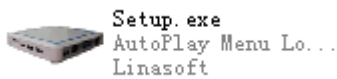

Working diagram as below:



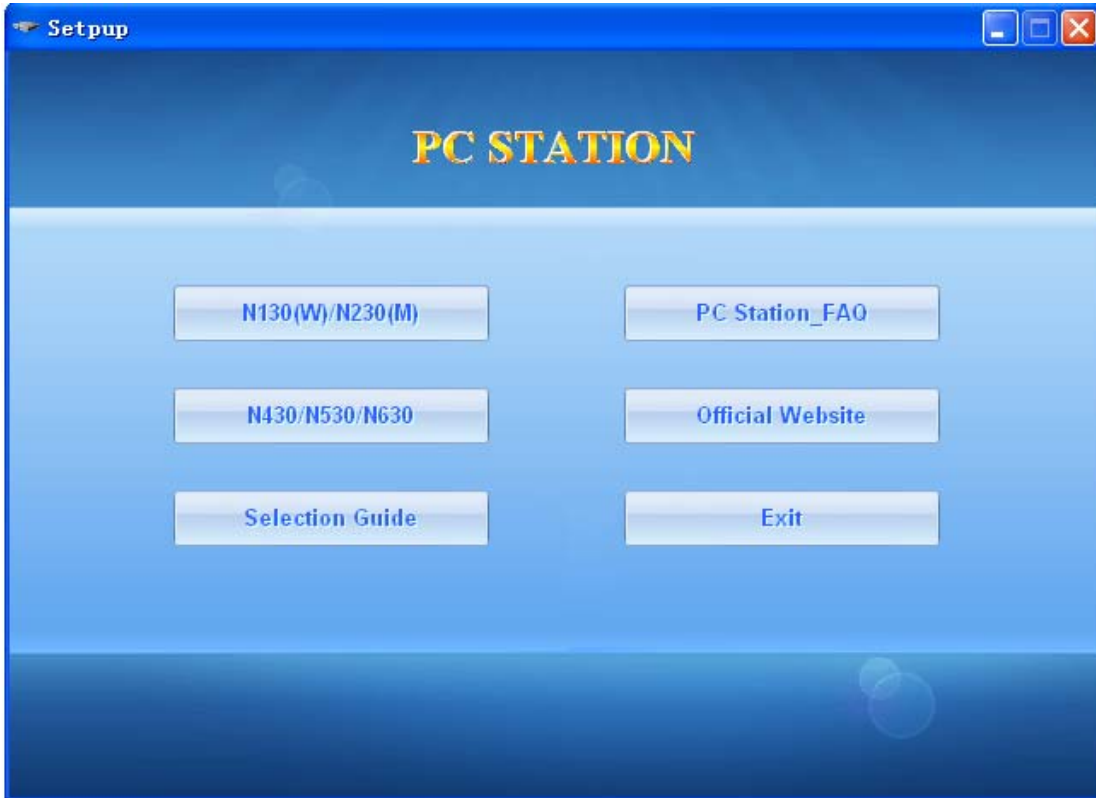
## Install software on the host computer

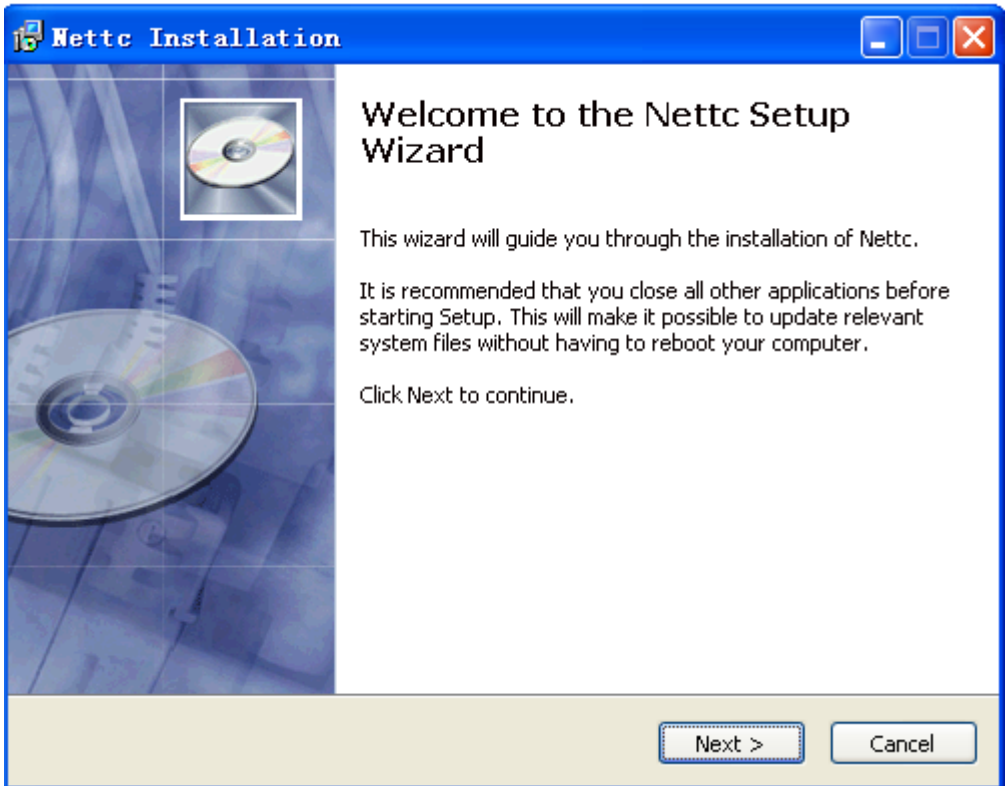

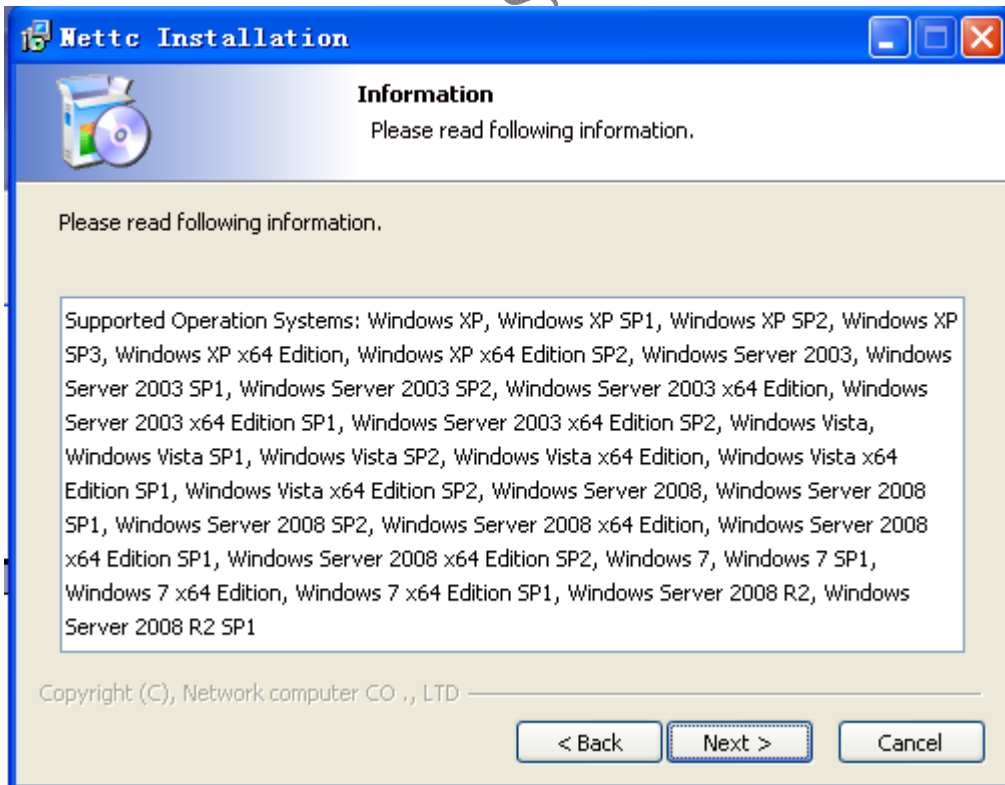


To setup software on HOST directly pls click  and go to picture 3, if you want to check User Guide or brown CD, click others as you want.

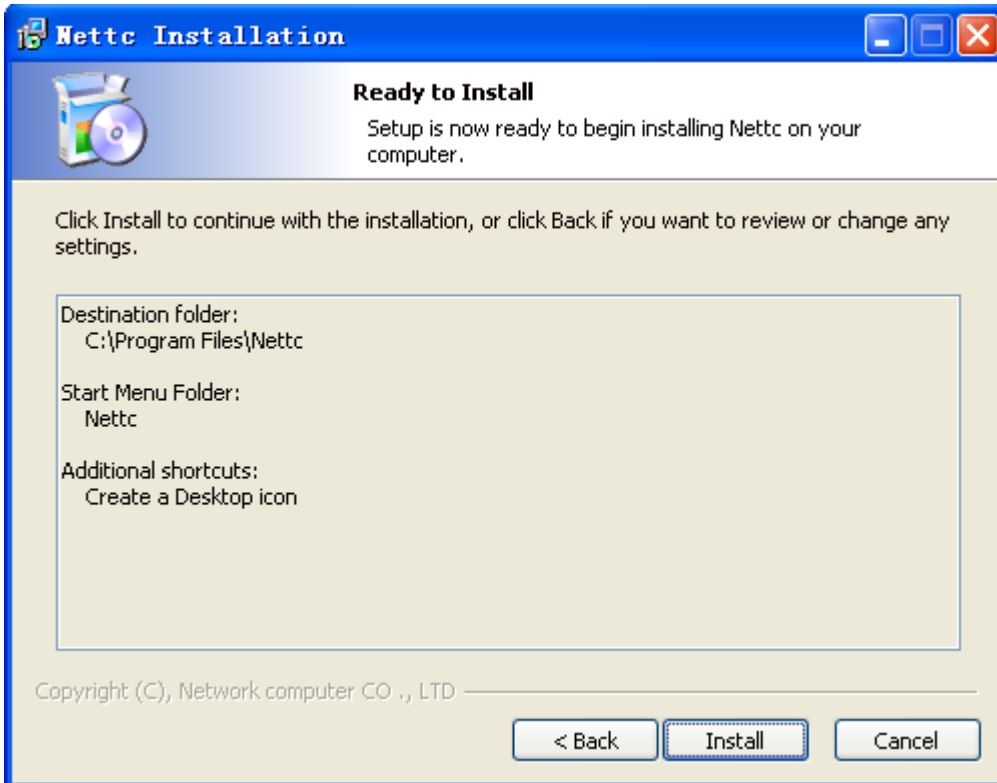

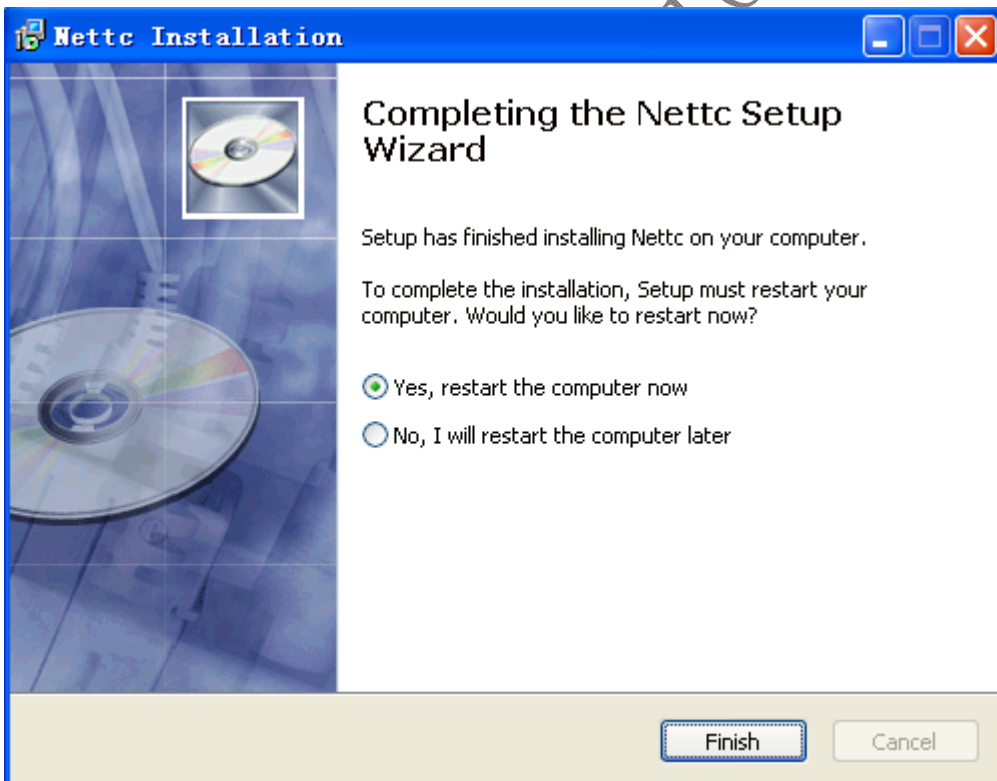
Click "Next" (default installation), can change the installation directory

# Add users for HOST system

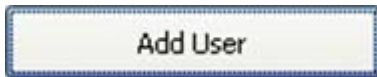


Double click on HOST screen

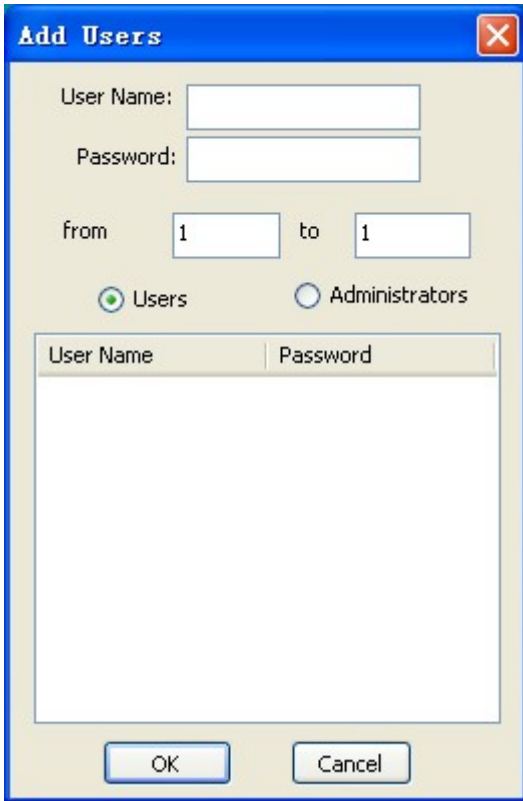

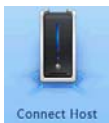
Then turn on power switch. The following interface will appear after the scrollbar ends

### Connect to HOST

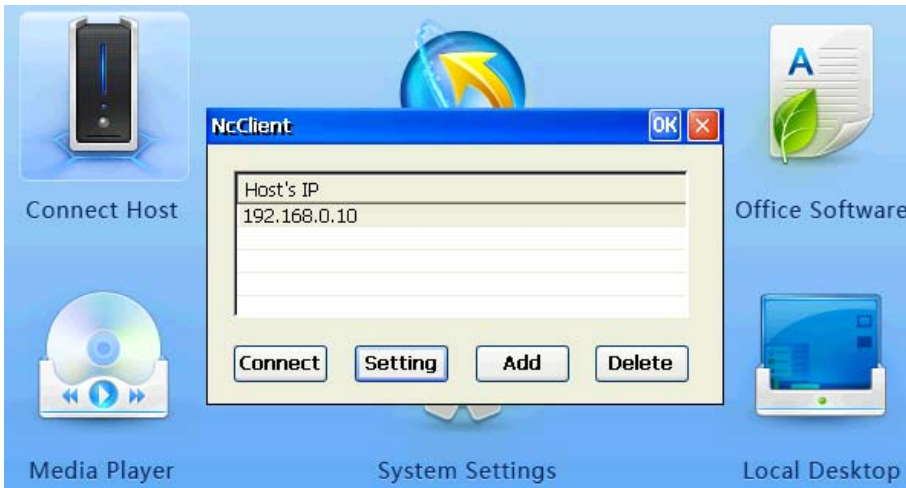


Click **Connect Host** in Pic 11.



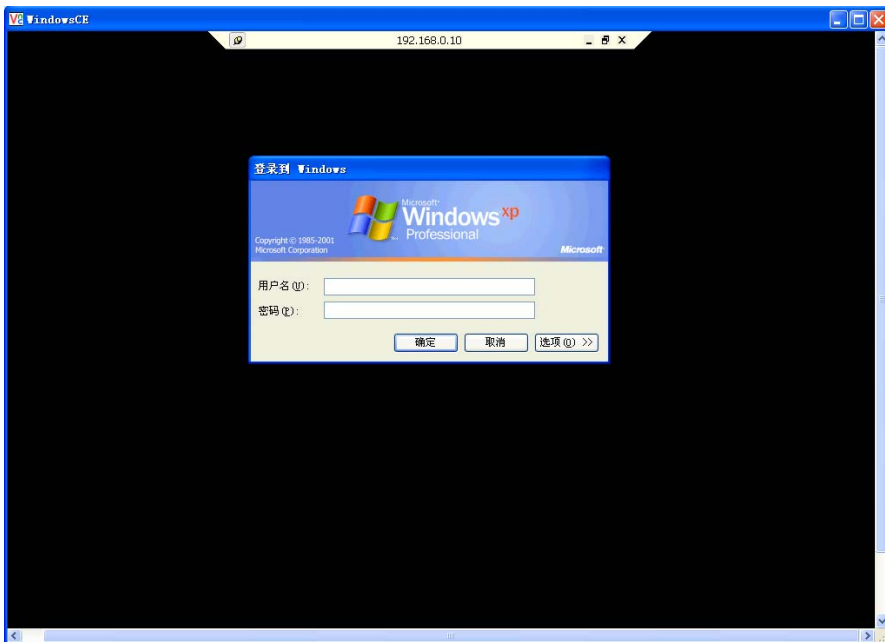

After click **Add** and then input server IP address ,click **OK** .



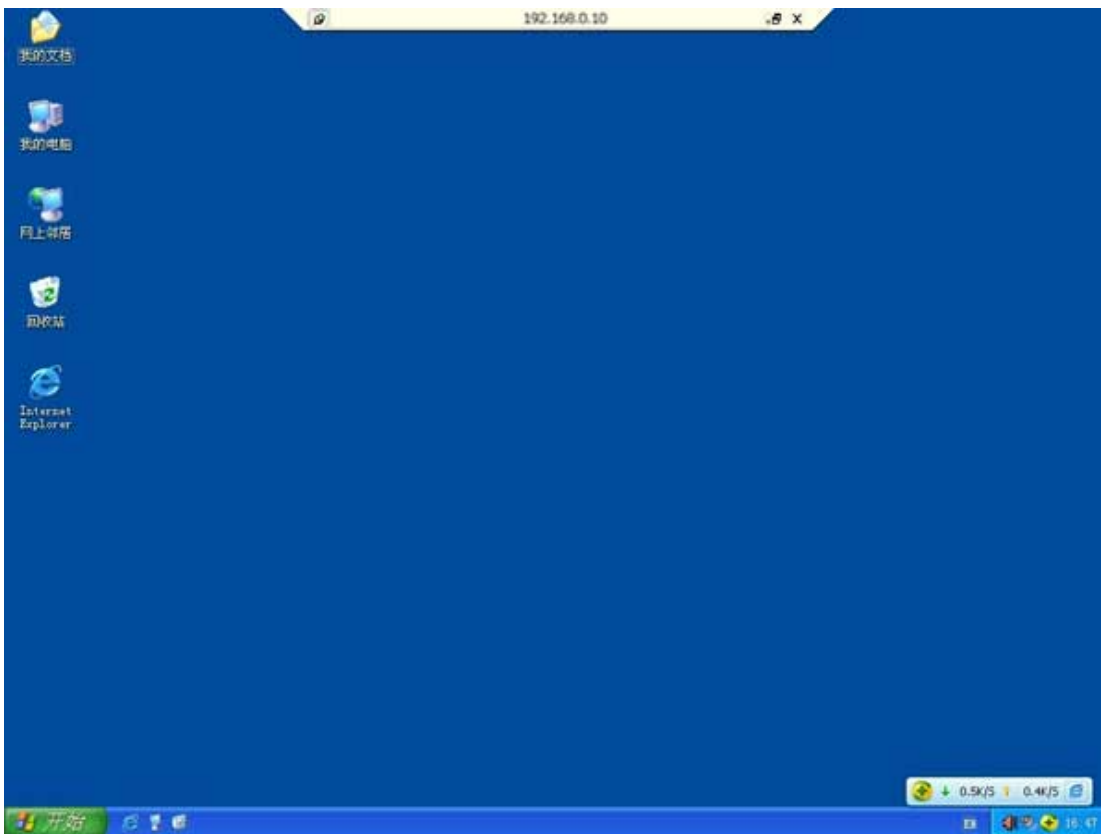

## System Settings

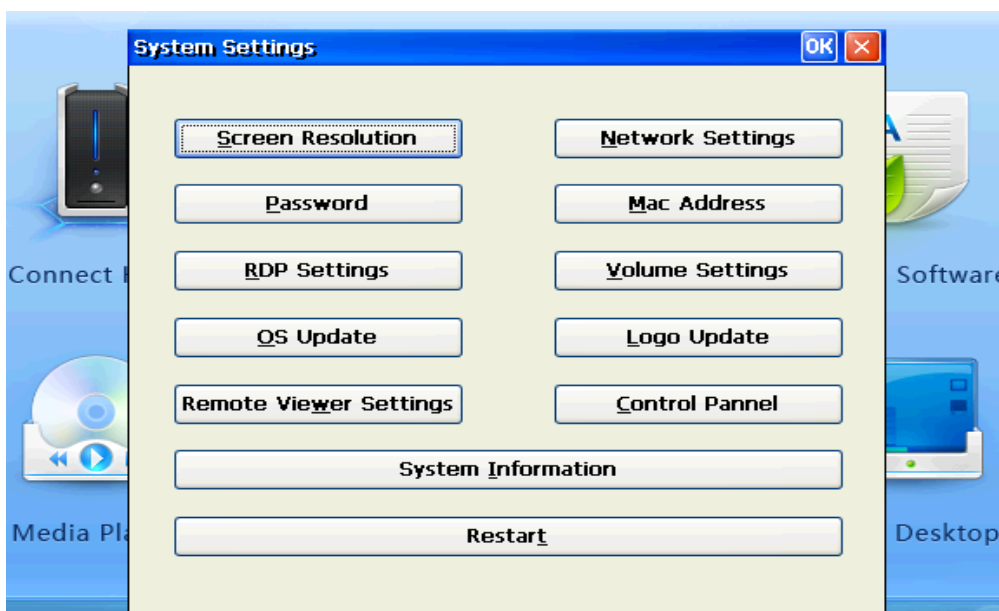


Click the button **System Settings** in Pic 11 to enter password validation(super password 123):

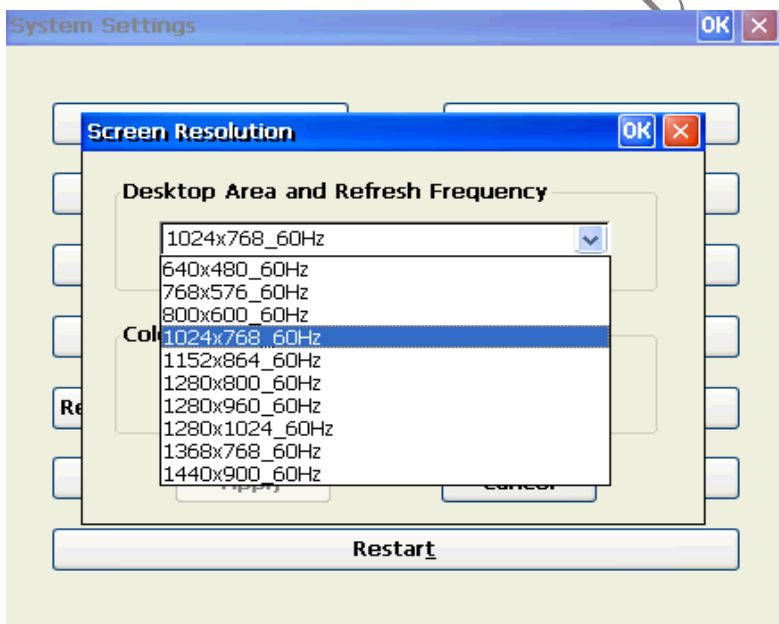
Entering the system setting interface after the password been validated:

**1. Obtain an IP address Automatically**

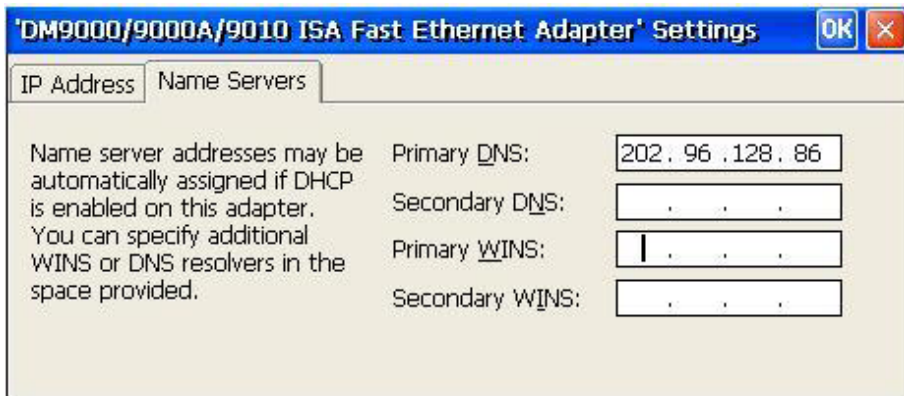
Click  Obtain an IP address via DHCP to obtain an IP address automatically, then click “ok” button.

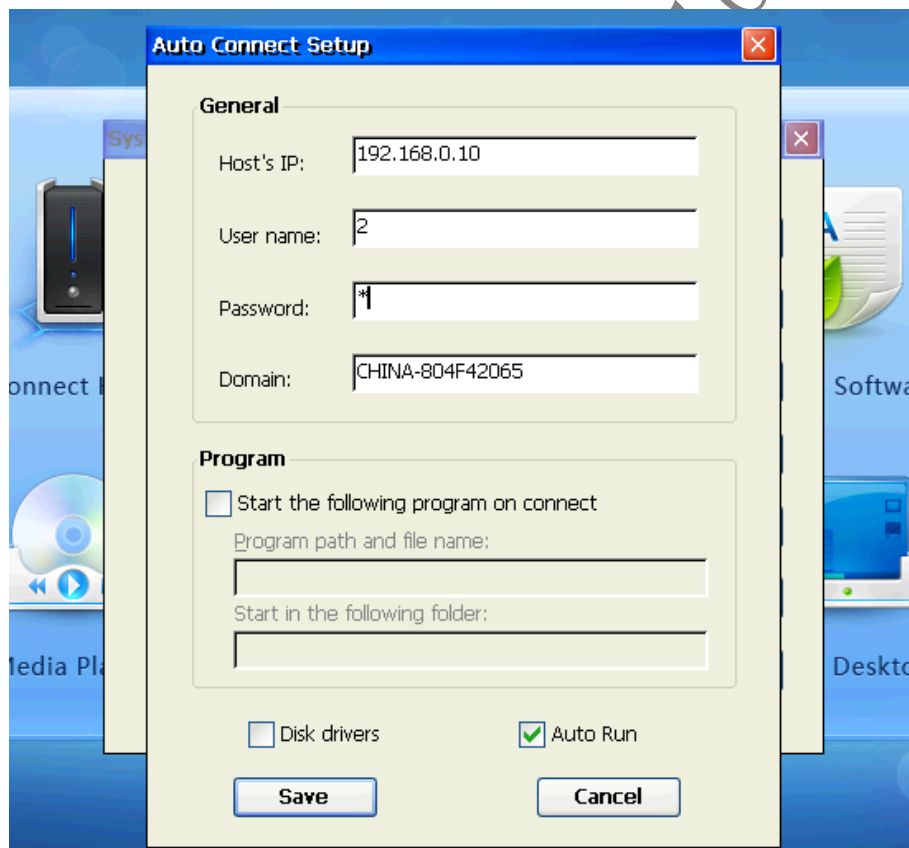

Click **RDP Settings** in Pic 17 to enter the automatic settings interface.



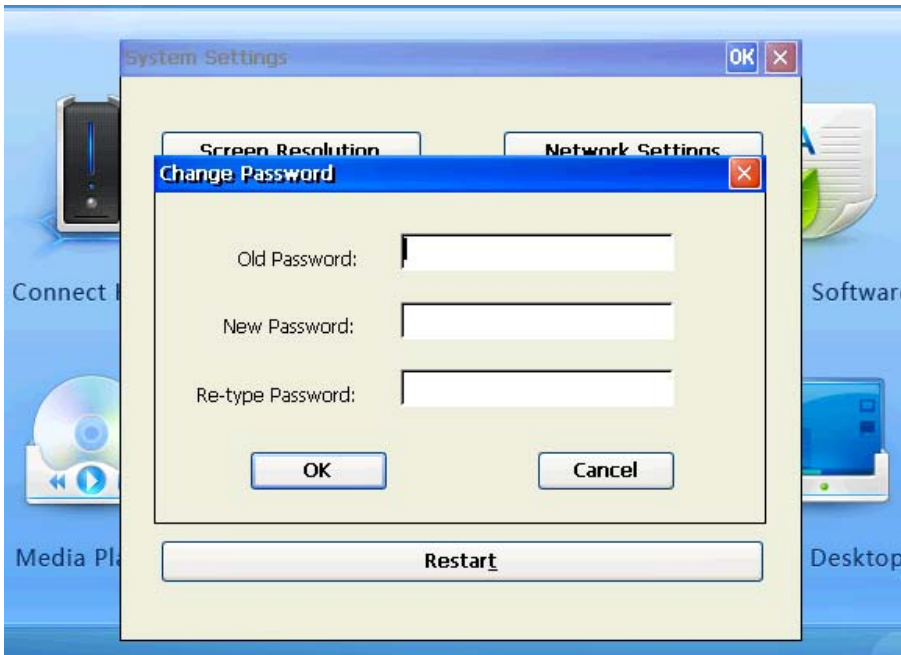

Changing Password on Setting Interface  in Pic 17 to enter password changing interface:

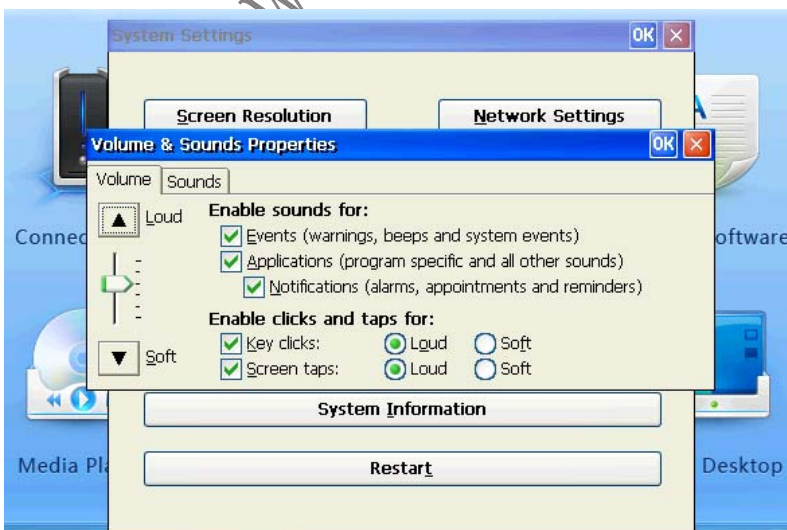

## Local Internet



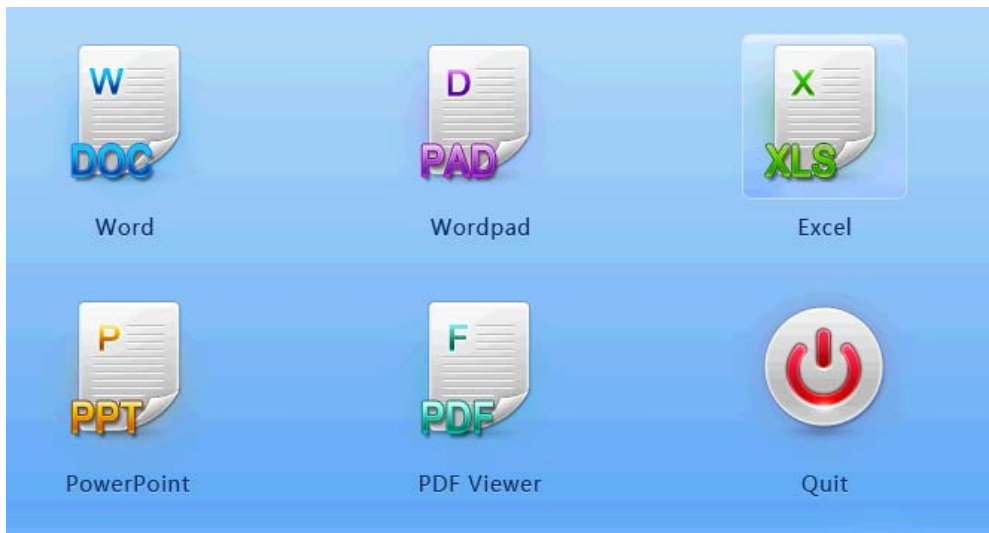
Click the button **Internet Explorer** in Pic 11 to open the terminal browser, can stat to browse web pages.

Click the button **Office Software** in Pic 11 to enter office file browsing as follows:

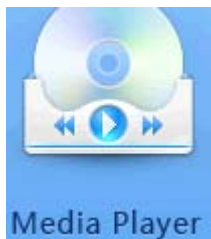

to picture 25.

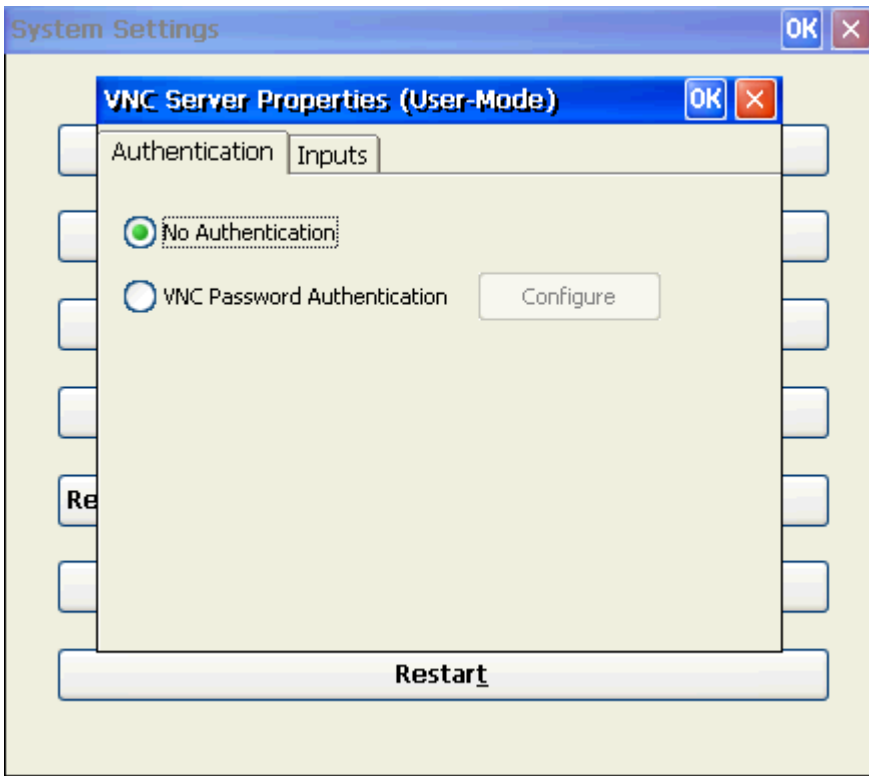


Picture 25. Enter terminal's IP address here and click OK. Then you will see the terminal's screen, you can control it directly or just see what terminal is doing now.
