Designed with the needs of researchers in mind, our library contains scans of original articles going as far back as 1823. Our collection strives to include everything published in the


Middle East in any language as well as anything published in Arabic worldwide.




3- The <u>Home Page</u> is divided into specific sections to help our visitors find what they are searching for easily and speedily, and it includes the following sections:





2.1.2 <u>Login</u>




1- The "Log in" button enables our users to log in to their account using their username and password as shown below:




2.1.3 Search




1- Before searching begins, users can click on "Select Service" to choose from the services we provide for a faster and more accurate search


3- The user can enter "Search Details" in the previous fields: All words or a whole sentence.




4- User can also utilize the Search Criteria option in the above figure, such as "Book

Title, keywords, author, specialty, etc....


4.1 Returning to the normal search, we find that user can browse any book on **AskZad**. When clicking on the book title, it displays as below:





4.4 **Adding** a book to your favorites is done as follows, (you can add to a preexisting favorites or create a new favorites




4.5 The user can send a copy of a book or a dissertation or any other type of content to a friend using the "Send" option.
