

How to Access WEBDISK on Faculty of Education lab computers

Introduction

- Webdisk is a system that allows you to **store your files on an IT server so that they are easily accessible from any internet connected computer.**
- Webdisk is perfect for saving files (pdf, images, etc.) too large to fit on a floppy disk.
- Webdisk files are automatically backed up every day, so they can be recovered.

Here's How to Use Webdisk





Double Click on U of C Web Disk icon on computer desktop

The following window will open:


- Fill in your IT Username and email password
- A drive will be automatically selected
- Your web space location will appear in the Address (URL) box
- Click on Run Windows Explorer after successful connection




- Click Connect button



- Once you are connected to the webdisk, you should see this window.



- If you selected “Run Windows Explorer after successful connection” (selected by default), you will see a window similar to this one
- You can also see your webspace by double clicking My Computer. eg.: ~miller on ‘webdisk” (U:)



- When you are ready to disconnect the webdisk, simply click on the “Disconnect” button. You will then see a popup window similar to the following window asking for confirmation: If you are “sure”, then click on the “Yes” button. You will be disconnected from your webspace
