





Assemble the tool holder

1. Attach the tool holder to the power board using 5 screws provided.




2. Thread the power cable behind the tool holder.




Mounting

- 1. Find a suitable location to mount the power board. Use the included wood screws.
- 2. Measure holes for 4 wood screws using a spirit level, with 100mm spacing. Fit the supplied wood screws.




Note: Mounting the powerboard onto plaster or masonry may require additional screws and components.

3. Line up the mounting holes on the back of the power board and place on to the screws. Gently push down.




Using the LED Work Lights

1. Use your hand to rotate the LED lights to the desired position.




Tip: Attach the power board to the wall above your workbench, and position the lights to provide work lighting for small tasks.

2. Switch the LED work lights on using the switch marked "LIGHTS".




Using the Power sockets

- 1. Ensure the switch above the socket is switched off.
- 2. Plug in your device.
- 3. Switch the socket on, using the switch above it.
- 4. When you have finished using the appliance, switch the socket off.




Tip: Keep your cables out of the way by threading them behind the tool holder.



FAQ'S

Questions	Answers		
Is this product compatible with 15A sockets?	No. The maximum current of 10A applies to this product. This current output applies to most household electrical items.		
What are wide spaced outlets?	Wide spaced outlets allow you to use larger power sockets without blocking the others on the power board. This ensures you can have up to 6 sockets connected at one time.		
Can I plug the Wall Mounted Power Board into extension leads or other power boards?	No. The Wall Mounted Power Board should not be plugged into an extension lead or another power board.		
Can I use the tool holder to carry heavy power or hand tools?	The tool holder is only designed to carry small tools – such as a screwdrivers etc. Please do not overload with excessive weight.		
Can the Wall Mounted Power Board be mounted outdoors?	No. The Wall Mounted Power Board is for indoor use only. It should only be mounted in an area where it is protected from any moisture.		
Can I replace the LED's?	No. The long-life LED's in this product are not replaceable.		
What is the expected lifespan of the fitted LED lights?	30,000 hours.		
How far can the LED lights be rotated?	The LED lights can be rotated up to 90° which can provide work lighting for small tasks.		
How bright are the LED's	The LED's have a total output of 720 lumens.		
What is a lumen?	Lumens are a unit of measure total output of visible light emitted – in this case by LED's.
