




















Image 17 List view in Foxit Reader for Windows.








Image 20 Sorting of PDF's files in Foxit Mobile PDF for Android.








Image 24 History view in Foxit Mobile PDF for Android.




Image 25 View of file properties in Foxit Mobile PDF for Android.






















































