
## TOUCH CONTROL CLIPPER QUICK START GUIDE



#### STEP 2

Achieving Your Desired Length

Length comb guards

- Select comb and set the selection switch to A, B, or C to correspond with desired setting.
- 2. Install comb: Line up comb rails with the slot on each side of the clipper. Press down until comb clicks into place.



#### STEP 3

Cutting Hair

Ready to Begin Cutting

- 1. When ready to cut hair, slide the lock switch from  $\cong$  to  $\cong/\&$

#### Helpful Hints

- 1. Charge for 12 to 18 hours before first use
- 2. Put 1 to 2 drops of oil on blade before first use, and every 1 to 2 uses thereafter

- 3. To switch between "mm" and "barber shop" # mode, press and hold power button for 2 seconds until screen blinks
- 4. To turn off clipper let the product sit for 10 seconds with motor off

#### Troubleshooting

- 1. Clipper will not turn on
  - a. Slide lock switch from  $\cong$  to  $\mathbb{A}/\mathbb{X}$
  - b. Ensure pull tab is removed
  - c. Charge for 12 to 18 hours
- 2. Display shows wrong length
  - a. 3-23mm and 22-42mm combs: Ensure switch matches letter printed on comb.
  - b. 1.5mm comb: Note display not designed to update 1.5mm comb



- 3. Comb does not move when pressing up/down
  - a. Slide lock switch to 🧎
  - b. If comb adjustment still does not work, follow system reset procedure found in user manual
- 4. Up/Down, turbo, or battery buttons activate without touching them a. Slide lock switch from a to a/ ★
  - b. Then slide lock switch back to
  - c. If buttons still activate by themselves, follow system reset procedure found in user manual
