Azure Control Panel User's Manual

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Welcome To A New Dimension In Spa Control Systems.

Quick Start Guide - You can use your Smart Control two ways:

(1) Single Button Touch in the **Shortcut Mode** to turn a function On or Off, like a Pump, Blower, or Light, without any navigation or additional steps. (2) **Navigation Mode** where you utilize the full opportunities on the Full Color Screen. In the Navigation Mode, you can immediately return to the Shortcut Mode by Touching the **Back** Button, or automatically return to Shortcut Mode if you don't touch a button for 15 seconds.

This Section of the **Control Panel User's Manual** is intended to be a **Quick Start Guide** to get you started in Navigating the Newport Controls Control Panel Menu System. Although this Guide illustrates the **Azure i400** Control Panel, the principles are the same for the **Azure i600** and **Azure i200** Control Panels.

Shortcut Mode System Control

The Key to the **Button Functions** is on Screen.



When the Shortcut Button Icons with the Button Functions are displayed on screen, the System is in **Shortcut Mode**, and All of the buttons Except the **Select** Button and the **Back** Button can be used to Directly Control the System equipment and other functions. A Yellow Icon on the Screen indicates that the Function is turned On.

The Button is the Jet Pump 1 Control Button.

The Button is the Spa Light Control Button.

The Button is the Water **Temp**erature Control Button.

The Button is the Invert Display Screen Button.

The **2**, **3**, **4**, and **5** Buttons are the Option 2, 3, 4, and 5 Control Buttons as defined on the Screen, which may be the Air **Blower**, Jet **Pump 2**, Jet **Pump 3**, another **Light**, or other Option. The **Azure i600** Control Panel also has an Option **6** Button for additional Control Options.

The Button is the **Select** Button, and it is used to Change from the Shortcut Mode to the Navigation Mode.

The Button is the **Back** Button, and it is not used in the Shortcut Mode.

In the Navigation Mode, the **Back** Button can be used to immediately return to the Shortcut Mode. If you're not at the Home Screen, use the **Back** Button to navigate back to it, and then Touch **Back** again to return to the Shortcut Mode.

Navigation Mode System Control

The **Settings** Icon on the Home Screen is Highlighted.



When the Navigation Icons and the Company Logo are on screen with Highlighting, the System is in the Navigation Mode, and All of the Buttons Except the Option (2), (3), (4), and (5) Buttons can be used to Navigate and Select from the Menu System.

The Button is the Move Left Navigation Button.

The Button is the Move Right Navigation Button.

The Button is the Scroll **Down** or Move **Down** Navigation Button.


The Button is the Scroll **Up** or Move **Up** Navigation Button.

The Button is the **Select** Button, and it is used to Select a Menu Item, or turn a Menu Item On or Off.

The Button is the **Back** Button, and it is used to go back one level in the Menu System. From the Navigation Mode Home Screen, the Back Button is also used to immediately Change to Shortcut Mode.

The **2**, **3**, **4**, and **5** Buttons continue to operate as the Option 2, 3, 4, and 5 Control Buttons in the Navigation Mode. The **Azure i600** Control Panel also has a **6** Button which is another Option Button in the Navigation Mode.

When Navigating the Menus, if the Yellow Highlighted Menu Bar you are on has an Arrow at the Right End of the Menu Bar, use the **Right** Button to Navigate to the Next Menu, and use the **Back** Button to Return to the Previous Menu.



Use the **Up** Button to Scroll Up to the next Menu Bar Above, or use the **Down** Button to Scroll Down to the next Menu Bar Below.

If the Blue Area at the Bottom of the Menu says **More** and has Arrows pointing Down and/or Up, as indicated, use the **Down** Button to Scroll from the Bottom Menu Bar to the



Next Menu, or the **Up** Button to Scroll from the Top Menu Bar to the Previous Menu.

Setting Up Your Spa Control System

This Section of the **Control Panel User's Manual** provides more Detailed Instructions for properly Setting Up and Configuring your Spa Control System. Although this Guide illustrates the **Azure i400** Control Panel, the principles are the same for the **Azure i600** and **Azure i200** Control Panels.

All of the initial Spa Control System Options and Settings, like Time and Date, Filter Cycles, Heating Mode, and Language, are located in the **Settings** Menu.

The **Settings** Icon on the Home Screen is Highlighted.



In the **Navigation Mode**, with the Navigation Icons on Screen and **Settings**Highlighted, Touch the **Select** Button to open the **Settings** Menu.

The **Invert Screen**Menu Bar
is **Highlighted**.



Invert the Screen - To Invert the Screen in Navigation Mode, Touch Select when the Invert Screen Menu Bar is Highlighted. When the Screen is Inverted, the Navigation Buttons are also Inverted, so that the Up and Down Buttons are switched with each other and the Left and Right Buttons are switched with each other. The Back Button does not change position. The Screen and Navigation Buttons are Uninverted the same way as they are Inverted.

Invert (Continued)

The Screen and Buttons are **Inverted**.



Set the Heating Mode - The Heating Mode determines when the Heater will heat and how the Water Temperature will be maintained. The Details are on the Set Menu.

The Heating Mode Menu Bar is Highlighted.



From the **Heating Mode** Menu Bar, Move **Right** to the **Heating Mode** Menu.

The **Economy**Menu Bar
is **Highlighted**.



The Default Heating Mode is the **Standard** Mode. To change Heating Modes, from the **Heating Mode** Menu Bar, Move **Right** to the **Heating Mode** Set Menu.

The **Economy** Heating Mode is turned On.



To change to this Heating Mode, Touch Select (2), or to Exit back, Touch Back (6).

Set the Filter Cycles - The Filter Cycles determine when the Filter Pump will turn On to Filter the Water. The Default is two 2 hour Filter Cycles every day of the week, 12 hours apart. You can Set up to four Filter Cycles on any days of the week, and with any Start Time and End Time you want.

The Filter Cycle Days and Time also determine when the Heating will take place in the **Economy** and **Vacation** Heating Modes. In these Modes, the Heater will only operate during the Filter Cycle Filtration times, and will not operate between Filter Cycles.



From the Filter Cycles Menu Bar, Move Right to the Set Filter Cycles Menu.



By Default, **Filter Cycle 1** is On and Preset. To Change the Days and Time for **Filter Cycle 1** or to Set or Modify other Filter Cycles, scroll to **Highlight** the Filter Cycle, then Move **Right** to the **Filter Cycles** Set Menu.



To turn On (Enable) or turn Off (Disable) a Filter Cycle, with **Filter Cycle 1** Highlighted, Touch **Select** . If the Filter Cycle is Set to Off, the System ignores the Days and Times Set, and the Filter Cycle is Disabled.

Filter Cycles (Continued)

The Timer Days Menu Bar is Highlighted.



To Set the Days for the Filter Timer to Operate, from the **Timer Days** Menu Bar, Move **Right** () to the **Timer Days** Menu.

The **S** For **Sunday** is **Highlighted**.



By Default, all days of the week are turned On. To turn a day Off or On, Move Left or Right to that day and Touch Select . Touch Back to the previous Menu.

The **Start Time** Menu Bar is Highlighted.



To Set the Filter Timer Start Time, from the **Start Time** Menu Bar, Move **Right** (**) to the **Start Time** Menu.

The **Hour** is **Highlighted**.



To change the Filter Timer Start Time, Move Left or Right to Hours or Minutes, and then Touch Up or Down to change the Time. Touch Back to the previous Menu.

Filter Cycles (Continued)

The **End Time** Menu Bar is **Highlighted**.



To Set the Filter Timer **End Time**, from the **End** Menu Bar, Move **Right (*)** to the **End Time** Menu.



To change the Filter Timer **End Time**, Move **Left** or **Right** to Hours or Minutes, and then Touch **Up** or **Down** to change the Time. To Exit back, Touch **Back** .

Turn On The Information Slideshow - The Information Slideshow can be turned On to display a Slideshow that has been provided by the Spa Manufacturer or Dealer. If the Information Slideshow is turned On, it will stay On until the **Back** Button is Touched or until the Display turns Off.



To turn the **Information Slideshow** On, from the **Info Slideshow** Menu Bar, Touch **Select 2**. The **Information Slideshow** will Start.

Info Slideshow (Continued)

The **Info Slideshow**is Displayed on the Screen.



Touch **Back** to End the **Information Slideshow** and Exit back to the previous Menu.

Set Fahrenheit or Celsius - Your Water Temperature can be Set to display in either Degrees Fahrenheit or Degrees Celsius. The Default is Degrees Fahrenheit.



To toggle back and forth between °F and °C Temperature display, from the °F/°C Menu Bar, Touch Select ②. Fahrenheit will be displayed in one degree increments, and Celsius will be displayed in one half degree increments.

Set Reminder Messages - The Reminder Messages Pop-Up periodically to Remind you to perform the Normal Maintenance required for your Spa. They are all set to Pop-Up at various intervals from 7 Days to 1 Year, but you can change any of them.



From the **Reminders** Menu Bar, Move **Right (*)** to the **Set Reminders** Menu.



To Set a Reminder Message, Scroll to the desired Message you want to change or turn off, then Move **Right** to the **Set Reminders** Menu.



To turn the Pop-Up Reminder Message interval Off or On, Touch **Select** (a). To change to a different interval, scroll to the desired interval and Touch **Select** (b) to turn it On. If there are no intervals Set to On, the Message will never Pop-Up.

When a Pop-Up Reminder Message appears on your Screen, you can Touch any Button to return to the previous Screen.

Set the Language - The Default Language is English, but you may have other Languages available on your Spa. If your desired Language is not Listed on the Language Menu, it may be available from your Spa Manufacturer.



To Set your desired Language, from the **Language** Menu Bar, Move **Right** to the **Language** Menu. All Installed Languages will be shown on the **Language** Menu.

Language (Continued)

The **English**Menu Bar
is **Highlighted**.



Scroll down through the **Language** Menu to see which Languages are available on your Spa. To change to a different **Language**, Scroll to the desired Language, then Touch **Select** to turn it On.

The **Change Language**Message is on the Screen.



To Change to the new **Language**, turn Off the Power to the Spa, and then turn the Power back On. After the Software is loaded, the new **Language** will be displayed for all Text on the Screen.

Lock the Control Panel - You can Lock the Control Panel so that none of the Panel Buttons operate. When the Panel is Locked, the only User Input the System will recognise is the Unlock Code Sequence.



To Lock the Control Panel, From the **Panel Lock** Menu Bar, Touch **Select ②**.



The **Panel Lock** Message appears on the Screen for a few seconds after the Panel is Locked, and then it goes back to the Home Screen. To Unlock the Control Panel, you Must Touch **Select - Select - Up** while the **Panel Lock** Message is Displayed on the Screen. Touch a **Shortcut Button** to Display the Message again.

Lock the Water Temperature - You can Lock the Temperature Adjustment so that the Water Set Temperature cannot be changed. When the Temperature is Locked, you cannot change the Temperature with the **Temp** Button, and you cannot change the Temperature on the Water Temperature Screen in Navigation Mode.



To Lock the Water Temperature, From the **Temp Lock** Menu Bar, Touch **Select** ②.





The **Temp Lock** Message appears on the Screen after the Temperature is Locked. To Exit the Message, Touch **Back** or **Select**. To Unlock the Control Panel, you Must Return to the **Temp Lock** Menu Bar, and Touch **Select** to turn it Off.

Set Over Temperature - If you want a temporary Water Set Temperature higher than 104°F, you Must Set it in the Over Temp Menu. Underwriters Laboratory requires this type of Control because the Consumer Product Safety Commission has determined that soaking in Water Temperatures above 104°F can sometimes be Dangerous.



To Increase the Water Set Temperature to 105°F or 106°F, From the **Over Temp** Menu Bar, Move Right to the **Over Temp** Menu.



You must confirm your intention to temporarily Set a Water Temperature higher than 104°F. Touch **Select** to continue to the **Over Temp** Menu to raise the Water Temperature above 104°F.



Scroll to the desired Water Set Temperature and Touch **Select** to Set that Water Temperature. The Water will be Heated to the selected Set Temperature one time. You will have to come back to the **Over Temp** Menu to raise it above 104°F again.

Over Temp (Continued)

You must confirm your intention to temporarily Set the Water Temperature to 105°F or 106°F. Touch **Select** (2) to continue to raise the Water Temperature to 105°F or 106°F.





You must confirm that you understand that the Water is being Heated to a Temperature higher than 104°F. Touch **Select** (2) to turn Off the Warning Message.

Set Time and Date - Once you Set the Current Time of Day, Day of the Week, and Calendar Date, it will be maintained in System Memory, and it should not have to be Set again except for Daylight Savings Time changes. The Calendar Date is only used for the **Event Log** which is maintained in the **Service** Menu. Only the Time of Day and Day of the Week are used for Setting Filter Cycles and other Timers.

You also have a choice of regular 12 Hour Time Display with AM and PM, or 24 Hour Military Time.

The **Set Time** & **Date**Menu Bar is Highlighted.



From the **Set Time & Date** Menu Bar, Move **Right** to the **Set Time & Date** Menu.

Time & Date (Continued)

The **Set Time** Menu Bar is **Highlighted**.



To Set the Time of Day, from the **Set Time** Menu Bar, Move **Right** to the **Set Time** Menu.

The **Hour** is **Highlighted**.



To change the Time of Day, Move **Left** or **Right** to Hours or Minutes, and then Touch **Up** or **Down** to change the Time. To Exit back, Touch **Back** .

The **Set Day** Menu Bar is **Highlighted**.



To Set the Day of the Week, from the **Set Day** Menu Bar, Move **Right** to the **Set Day** Menu.

The **S** For **Sunday** is **Highlighted**.



To change the Current Day of the Week to a different Day, Move Left or Right to that day and Touch Select . Touch Back to Exit back and Set the Date.

Time & Date (Continued)

The **Set Date**Menu Bar
is **Highlighted**.



To Set the Calendar Date, from the **Set Date** Menu Bar, Move **Right (** to the **Set Date** Menu.



To Set the Calendar Date, Move Left or Right to Month, Day, or Year, and then Touch Up or Down to Set the Date. To Exit back, Touch Back .

The **24 Hour** Menu Bar is Highlighted.



To turn **24 Hour** Clock Time Display On or Off, from the **24 Hour** Menu Bar, Touch **Select** . When 24 Hour Clock Display is turned On, the Clock will read 1 - 24 Hours rather than 1 - 12 Hours with AM and PM.

Read the Event Log - The Spa **Event Log** has a List of any significant incidents the Spa has experienced, along with the Month, Day, and Hour the incident occured.



From the **Event Log** Menu Bar, Move **Right** (to the **Event Log** Menu.



Scroll **Up** or **Down** to the other **Event Log** Pages to View other Spa Events. Then Touch **Back** to Exit back to the **Settings** Menu.

Change Shortcut Mode Screens - There two different **Shortcut Mode Screens** available. The first Screen is the **Button Legend** Screen which is a full Display with Time, Water Temperature, Information Icons, and a Legend to identify the Function of all of the Shortcut Buttons, and to show if the Spa Equipment is turned On or Off. The Second Screen is the **Time & Temp** Screen which is a simplified Display that only displays a Large Time and Water Temperature.



From the Shortcut Screen Menu Bar, Move Right to the Shortcut Screen Menu.

Shortcut Screens (Continued)

The **Button Legend**Menu Bar is **Highlighted**.



Scroll to the desired **Shortcut Screen** and Touch **Select** to turn On that Shortcut Mode Screen. Then Touch **Back** a couple of times to Exit back to the new Shortcut Mode Screen.

Set Water Temperature - The Water Set Temperature is the Water Temperature that the Spa Heater will maintain in your Spa. It can be Set in either **Shortcut Mode**, directly with a Button Touch, or in the **Navigation Mode** from the **Controls** Menu.

Shortcut Mode - Set by using the **Temperature Control B** Button.

The Key to the **Button Functions** is on screen.



In the **Shortcut Mode**, with the Key to the Button Functions on Screen, Touch the **Temperature Control** Button to open the **Set Temperature** Menu.

The Water
Temperature
is now Set
to 100°F.



On the **Set Temperature** Menu, Touch the **Up** and **Down** Buttons to Raise or Lower the Water Set Temperature 1°F. Touch **Left** to go to the Lowest Set Temp of 70°F, or Touch **Right** to go to the Highest Set Temp of 104°F. Then Touch **Back** to Exit. To Set a Temperature higher than 104°F, see "**Set Over Temperature**".

Navigation Mode - Set by Navigating to the Controls Menu.

The **Controls** Icon on the Home Screen is Highlighted.



In the **Navigation Mode**, with the Navigation Icons on Screen and **Controls**Highlighted, Touch the **Select**
Button to open the **Controls** Menu.



To Set the Water Temperature, Move Left and Up to the Temp Icon.

The **Temp** Icon is Highlighted.



With the **Temp** Icon Highlighted , Touch **Select** (2) to open the **Set Temperature** Menu.

The Water Temperature is now Set to 100°F.



Touch the Up (a), Down (b), Left (c), and Right (c) Buttons to Raise or Lower the Water Set Temperature. Then Touch Back (c) to Exit.

Help with Messages and Maintenance - Help is available for various Pop-Up Messages you may see on the Screen, and for day to day Spa Maintenance.

The **Help**Icon on the
Home Screen
is **Highlighted**.



With the Navigation Icons on Screen and **Help Highlighted**, Touch **Select (2)** to open the **Help** Menu.

The **Messages** Menu Bar is **Highlighted**.



For Help with the **Messages**, from the **Messages** Menu Bar, Move **Right** to the **Messages** Menu.

The **Heater May Be Dry**Menu Bar is **Highlighted**.



From the desired **Messages** Menu Bar, Move **Right (*)** to View that Pop-Up Message.

The **Heater May Be Dry**Help is on the Screen.



For More Help on that Message, Move Right (1), or Touch Back (1) to Exit Back.

Touch **Back** to Exit Back to the Previous Menus.





For Help with **Maintenance**, from the **Maintenance** Menu Bar, Move **Right (*)** to the **How To** Menu.

The Check pH Level Menu Bar is Highlighted.



From the desired **How To** Menu Bar, Move **Right (*)** to View that **How To** Message.

Check pH Level Help is on the Screen.



Touch **Back** to Exit Back to the Previous Menus.

Control Your LED Spa Light (Optional Equipment) - If you have an Optional LED Spa Light that is Controllable, then you can select from five different LED Light Colors or three different LED Light Shows. Whatever Light Color or Light Show you have selected last will be turned On the next time you turn On the LED Spa Light.

The Key to the **Button Functions** is on Screen.



In **Spa Shortcut Mode** with the Shortcut Button Icons and the Button Functions on the Screen, Touch the **Light** Button to turn On the LED Spa Light and open the **LED Light Control** Menu.

The White Light Color Menu Bar is Highlighted.



The Default LED Spa Light selection is **White Light** the first time it is turned On after the Spa has been Powered On, and the **White Light** Menu Bar is Highlighted. Scroll **Up** to Move to and select a different LED Light Color.

The **Green Light** Color
Menu Bar is
Highlighted.



For example, with the **Green Light** Menu Bar Highlighted, you can Touch **Select** to change to the **Green Light** Color.

LED Light (Continued)

The **Slow Color** Show
Menu Bar is
Highlighted.



Scroll **Down** to Move to and select one of the three LED Light Shows. For example, with the **Slow Color** Light Show Menu Bar Highlighted, you can Touch **Select** to change to the **Slow Color** Show. Touch **Back** to Exit Back to the **Spa Shortcut Mode** Screen, or the **LED Light Control** Menu will Auto Exit in a few seconds.

Control Your Audio Volume (Optional Equipment) - If you have an Optional Entertainment Audio **Volume Control**, then you can Raise or Lower your Entertainment Audio Volume. Whatever Volume Level you selected last will be selected the next time you Open the Audio **Volume** Control Menu.

The Key to the **Button Functions** is on Screen.



In **Spa Shortcut Mode** with the Shortcut Button Icons and the Button Functions on the Screen, Touch the Audio **Volume** Button to open the **Volume** Control Menu.

The Audio
Volume Level
Bars are in the
Green area.



The Audio **Volume** Level Menu is Open, indicating the Volume Level. The **Green** Volume Level Bars indicate a **Medium** Audio Volume Level.

The Audio
Volume Level
Bars are in the
Red area.



Touch the Up Button to Raise the Audio Volume Level. The Red Volume Level Bars indicate a **High** Audio Volume Level.





Touch the **Down** Button to Lower the Audio Volume Level. The Yellow Volume Level Bars indicate a **Low** Audio Volume Level. Touch **Back** to Exit Back to the **Spa Shortcut Mode** Screen, or Audio **Volume** Control Menu will Auto Exit in a few seconds.

Set Your Moods (Azure i600 Panel Only) - Unique preset Moods can be Modified any way you want them. You can preset Pumps and Speeds, Lights and Levels, and which Device you want playing Music in the Various Moods. Most Spas will have a Single Button assigned to Instantly turn On the Preset Mood.

The **Moods** Icon on the Home Screen is Highlighted.



In Navigation Mode, from the Highlighted Settings Icon, Touch Left and Up to Highlight the Moods Icon. Then Touch Select to enter the Moods Menu.

Moods Setup (Continued)

The **Relax Setup** Menu Bar is Highlighted.



To Setup the Relax Mood, from the Relax Setup Menu Bar, Move Right (1) to the Re-

lax Setup Menu.

The **Relax Mood** Menu Bar is Highlighted.



To assign Relax to the Mood Button, on the Relax Mood Menu Bar, Touch Select .



The **Select Devices** Menu Bar is Highlighted.



To Setup the **Devices**, Speeds, and Levels you want to operate in the **Relax Mood**, from the **Select Devices** Menu Bar, Move **Right** to the **Mood Devices** Menu.

Moods Setup (Continued)

The **Pump 1**Menu Bar
is **Highlighted**.



Scroll through the several pages of available **Devices**, and turn them On or Off, set the Pump and Blower Speeds, set the Spa Light Level, and set the Music Player for the **Relax Mood** by Touching the **Select** Button as required for each **Device**. Touch the **Back** Button to go back to the previous Menu.

The **Set Time Duration**Menu Bar is **Highlighted**.



To change the **Duration** of the **Relax Mood** before it turns Off, from the **Set Time Duration** Menu Bar, Move **Right** to the **Time Duration** Menu.

The **Time Duration Hours** is **Highlighted**.



To Set the **Time Duration** of the Mood, Move **Left** or **Right** to Hours or Minutes, and then Touch **Up** or **Down** to change the Time. Touch **Back** to the Previous Menu.

Set Your Wellness Timers (Azure i600 Panel Only) - The Timers Feature has three different functions. There's a Timer that starts at 0:00 and counts up, three **Countdown Timers** that count down to 0:00, and an **Alarm** that Flashes the Spa Light at the Set time.

The **Timers** Icon on the Home Screen is Highlighted.



In Navigation Mode, from the Highlighted Settings Icon, Touch Right and Up to Highlight the Timers Icon. Then Touch Select to enter the Wellness Timers Menu.

The **Timer**Menu Bar
is **Highlighted**.



To Set the **Timer**, from the **Timer** Menu Bar, Move **Right (*)** to the **Timer** Set Menu.



To Start or Reset the **Timer**, Move **Right** or **Left** to the **Start** and **Reset** Icons, and Touch **Select**. Touch **Back** to the Previous Menu.

Timers Setup (Continued)

The **Countdown** Menu Bar is **Highlighted**.



To Set the **Countdown** Timers, from the **Countdown** Menu Bar, Move **Right (*)** to the **Set Countdown** Menu.

The **Start Countdown**Menu Bar
is **Highlighted**.



To Start all three **Countdown** Timers, from the **Start Countdown** Menu Bar, Touch the **Select** Button to turn them On.

The **Sound Alarm**Menu Bar
is **Highlighted**.



At the end of the **Countdown**, you can Sound an Alarm (Flash the Spa Light), turn Off all the Pumps that are running, and/or turn Off everything that is On except the Spa Light. To Set the **Countdown** Time, from any of the three **Countdown** Timer Menu Bars, **Sound Alarm** for example, Move **Right** to the **Sound Alarm** Set Menu.



To Set the **Sound Alarm** Countdown Time, Move **Left** or **Right** to Hours or Minutes, and then Touch **Up** or **Down** to change the Time. Touch **Back** to Exit Back and Set another Countdown Timer.



The Countdown Timer Message appears on the Screen at the end of the Countdown Alarm time. To Exit the Message, Touch the Back Button to return to the previous Screen.



To Set the **Alarm**, from the **Alarm** Menu Bar, Move **Right (*)** to the **Set Alarm** Menu.

Timers Setup (Continued)

The **Alarm**Menu Bar is
Highlighted.

SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

MARNING – Risk of Accidental Drowning. Extreme caution must be exercised to prevent unauthorized access by children. To avoid accidents, ensure that children cannot use a spa or hot tub unless they are closely supervised at all times.

PANGER – To reduce the risk of drowning from hair and body entrapment, install a suction fitting(s) with a marked flow rate that equals or exceeds the flow rate marked on the equipment assembly.

DANGER – To reduce the risk of injury, do not remove the suction fittings. Never operate a spa or hot tub if the suction fittings are broken or missing. Never replace a suction fitting with one rated less than the flow rate marked on the equipment assembly.

DANGER – Risk of Electric Shock. Do not permit any electric appliance, such as a light, telephone, radio, or television, within 5 feet (1.5 m) of a spa or hot tub.

WARNING – Risk of Electric Shock. Install at least 5 feet (1.5 m) from the inside wall of spa or hot tub using nonmetallic plumbing.



WARNING – To reduce the risk of injury:

The water in a spa should never exceed 40°C (104°F). Water tempertures between 38°C (100°F) and 40°C (104°F) are considered safe for a healthy adult. Lower water temperatures are recommended for young children and when spa use exceeds 10 minutes.

Since excessive water temperatures have a high potential for causing fetal damage during the early months of pregnancy, pregnant or possibly pregnant women should limit spa water temperatures to 38°C (100°F).

Before entering a spa or hot tub, the user should measure the water temperature since the tolerance of water temperature-regulating devices varies.

The use of alcohol, drugs, or medication before or during spa or hot tub use may lead to unconsciousness with the possibility of drowning.

Obese persons and persons with a history of heart disease, low or high blood pressure, circulatory system problems, or diabetes should consult a physician before using a spa.

Persons using medication should consult a physician before using a spa or hot tub since some medication may induce drowsiness while other medication may affect heart rate, blood pressure, and circulation.
