GETTING STARTED WITH IT SERVICES AT QATAR UNIVERSITY

Information Technology Services is committed to providing the best tools and support available to assist faculty in pursuing their academic mission at Qatar University. Here are some basics for getting started with technology at the university.

Introducing your Qatar University Login Username

The keys to accessing IT services provided by Qatar University are your institutional login username and password.

In addition to the username, you will receive a personal email address from the Qatar University email systems, which by default is in the format [username]@qu.edu.qa.

If you have not already received your login username and email address, please drop by the ITS Helpdesk and get it as soon as you can. You'll need your username to login in any of the online University services. Remember, you are responsible for everything that happens with your username. So don't put your online identity at risk; never share your password.

Setting Up Your Computer

QU provides all faculty with a state of the art laptop. This laptop is preloaded with the latest software that faculty usually require. Additionally, ITS maintains licenses for specialized software used by faculty across campus for research or instructional purposes. Faculty who intend to use additional software are encouraged to consult the ITS Helpdesk before purchasing the software.

Computer equipment provided by ITS is preconfigured for optimum performance and security and for any problems need to be taken to the Helpdesk for evaluation and repair. Software and Hardware specifications for the laptop provided by ITS can be found in Appendix A.

Connect to the University

New Employee Mobile Internet Service

We understand that this might be your first time in Qatar and we are also aware that you might not have direct access to the internet immediately. In an effort to continuously improve our services and to provide you with everything you deserve, Information Technology Services is pleased to lend you a Mobile Internet USB Stick from Vodafone, preloaded with 4GBs service time, for an

entire month!

Using this device, you will be able to access the internet from anywhere in Qatar! Available on a first come, first served basis from the ITS Helpdesk, this service aims to reduce barriers to information and your surroundings during your initial transition period.

The Qatar University Wireless Network

ITS supports one of the largest wireless networks at any institution in Qatar, and setting up your personal computer, smartphone or mobile device to join the Qatar University wireless network couldn't be easier.

The wireless network at Qatar University is "hidden" and unencrypted (no password required). This means you cannot see it on your computer's wireless networks list, and need to add it directly. Choose to set up a new wireless connection manually, and under "network SSID" or "network name", enter the following (case sensitive):

myQU Campus Portal

myQU is the University's web portal and our primary method of online service delivery.

It is web-based tool that provides centralized access to email, calendars, administrative services and classroom tools, and information. With a single username and password, you will gain access to all these services and more. In addition, nearly every screen of information



is fully customizable. You choose what you want to see and where you want to see it, making myQU a personalized portal to your unique needs at QU.

Learning Management Services	Blackboard Learn is the course management system at QU that provides students and faculty with an online portal to their courses.
Audio/Visual Services	We supply academic departments with smart podiums with embedded multimedia support. Users can chose multiple sources (laptops, DVD, VCR, Document camera) with user-friendly touch panel/button operations.
Lecture Capture Services	Lecture capture services allow instructors to record lectures in their classrooms and make them available to students for future viewing. Special events, training sessions, workshops, and other such events may also be captured using this system.
Video Conferencing Services	We help setting up video conference sessions and provide operational support during these session as well.

Wired Network	We supply high speed LAN connections with speeds ranging from 100 Mbps to 1000 Mbps to connect Desktop PC's, Printers, Scanners, Plotters & all other Ethernet enabled devices.
Wireless Network	Our wireless network provides users with convenient, high speed access to the QU IT infrastructure and to the Internet. The service is available across all of our campus buildings and in most open areas.
Remote Access (VPN)	Remote access to the QU campus is provided through a Virtual Private Network (VPN) connection.
	The VPN connection allows users to access QU systems and networks that are not otherwise available through the Internet. This includes some aspects of the Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) system that is managed by ITS.
Internet Access	High speed internet link ensures faster access to websites and minimal time for downloading files from internet. URL filtering ensures that websites that are not in conformity to QU Policies are blocked.
IP Telephony	VolP uses the existing network infrastructure to digitize voice, providing high call quality along with features like privileged calling (mobile / international), voice messaging, call forwarding, billing and mobility to desk phones and smartphones.

Mobile Internet Service



Terms and Conditions

This service is available only to new employees that have not yet been issued Resident Permits in Qatar.

The user is responsible for the USB Stick during the entire lending period. As a result, users may not lend the device to third parties or leave it unattended at any time.

The time limit for lending out the USB Stick is 30 days for all users. If there is no waiting list, the USB Stick may be lent out 1 more time to the user. In any case, the USB Stick must be returned to the ITS Helpdesk.

The Mobile Internet USB Stick will be loaned out in perfect working order. Each device has a pre-paid SIM, a cable and a USB connection (all contained in a box).

Information Technology Services management will send request to the Finance Department to recover the cost of the device if the following situations occur:

cost of the device if the following shouldness occur:
\square Returning the device late (more than 15 days outside the allocated period of time).
\square Returning the device after changing the system configuration.
\square Damaging the device through misuse.
\square Failing to return the device.
This action can be avoided by replacement with an identical device, or payment of the value of the unreturned device (199 QAR), as determined for the current academic year, within a maximum of 30 days.


2. You will then see the message below while the software is being installed:
